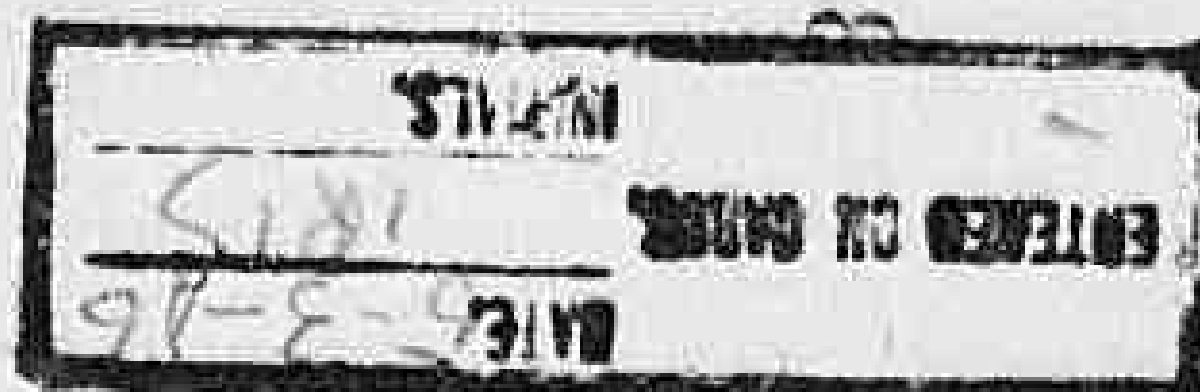

Sir,

I have to report that at ROME on 5 February 1946, about 1100 Hours, I was on duty at this Office when Signora MARIA MONICA CATINA, No. 79 Via Monterone, accompanied by her daughter, called in connection with the case of her husband CATERINA CARLO, being killed by an Allied vehicle on 22nd.12. 1945 in ROME.

The case is in the hands of the ROYAL NAVY AUTHORITIES but this Office had rendered her assistance as regards the repatriation of her son who is a P.O.W. in England, and she was also directed to Claims and Hirings for any possible compensation.

Sir, you saw the lady concerned on the 14th January 1946 and upon your instruction she was directed to A.C. and also informed to go to Claims and Hirings.

This lady has received no further information from any source as to how the case is proceeding and as she and her family are in rather poor circumstances, she respectfully requested that the matter may be looked into.

Attached is a letter from this lady stating exactly what she has done up to the present date.

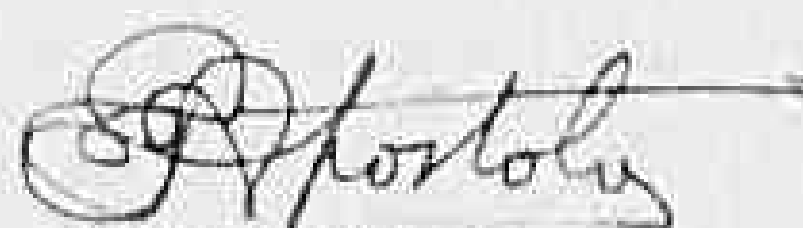

I, the undersigned, Margherita Artuffo, take the liberty to apply to your Command in the hope of receiving help and assistance.

I am the mother of a missing soldier and I have not heard from him for four long years.

In addition my husband, Nicola Artuffo born in 1892 and a former Master-sergeant of the Italian Army, after the Armistice-Day, which took place on 8 September 1943, was forced to enlist in the Fascist Republican Army and assigned to a Unit located at Fossano (Cuneo). Because of his serving in the Republican Army, he is presently held as P.O.W. at the Italian Camp No. 3, located at Rimini.

Many prisoners, held in other camps, have already been released and I don't understand why my husband is still held at that camp.

Because of my critical health conditions, I am unable to perform any gainful work and to support myself.

The Committee of National Liberation, the Town-Hall of Cuneo and the other competent Authorities can certify that my husband has never participated to any war-event.

In the hope you will accede to my request I wholeheartedly thank you.
