1. Attached is a letter from Signor Ignazio Gualtieri, Florence whose son, Second Lieutenant Gualtiero Gualtieri, prisoner of war No. 4745 at Camp No. 5 Myrtleford in Australia, has been a prisoner of war since February 1941.

2. Signor Gualtieri and his wife request that the boy's repatriation be executed as soon as possible in order that he may enroll at the Florence University for the coming semester to continue his long interrupted studies.

3. Their plea is that as each month goes by with their son still in a prisoner of war camp it means an additional month's delay in his returning to his studies and a greater danger of his being too old to continue his Chemistry studies.

4. May this letter please be forwarded to proper Australian authorities for action.

Last May, this Ministry requested the attention of the Commission in question on compassionate grounds. His wife is afflicted with chronic malaria and arthritis and his son Alberto aged 5, afflicted with malaria and acute loss of weight.

Furthermore, the family lost two children, their house and all their personal effects during an air raid, and their financial condition is very bad.

As their situation is becoming steadily worse, we beg your Commission to examine his case with benevolence and have it fully repatriated if possible.

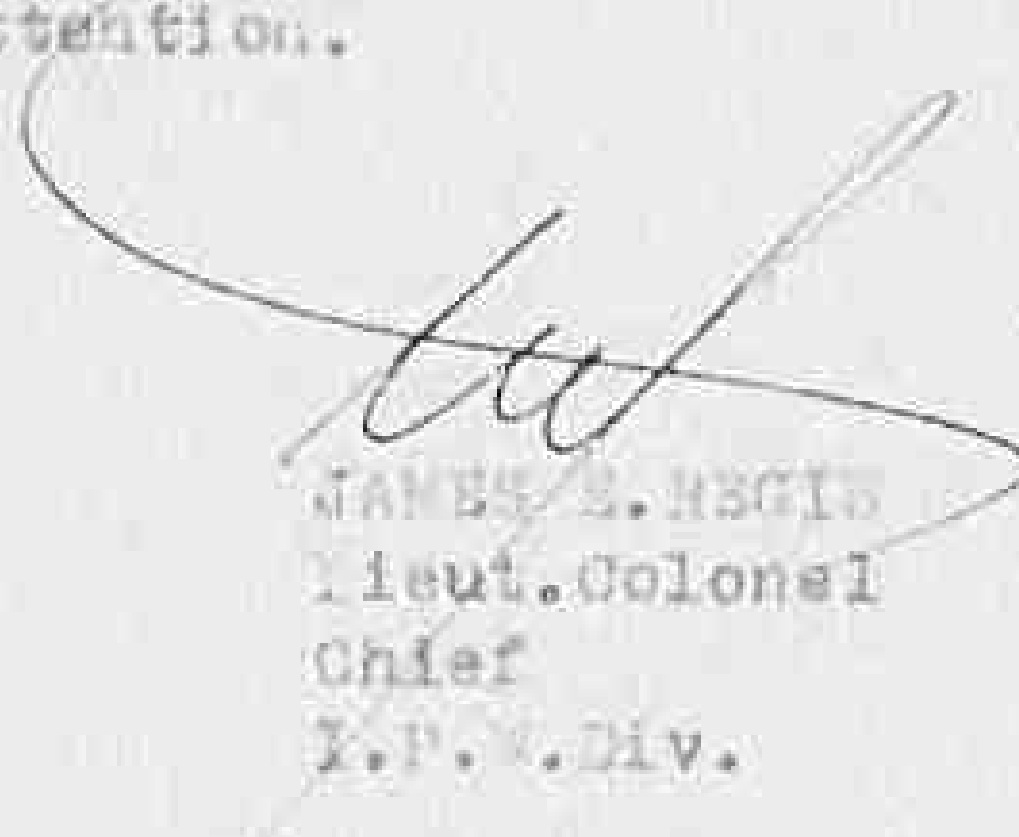

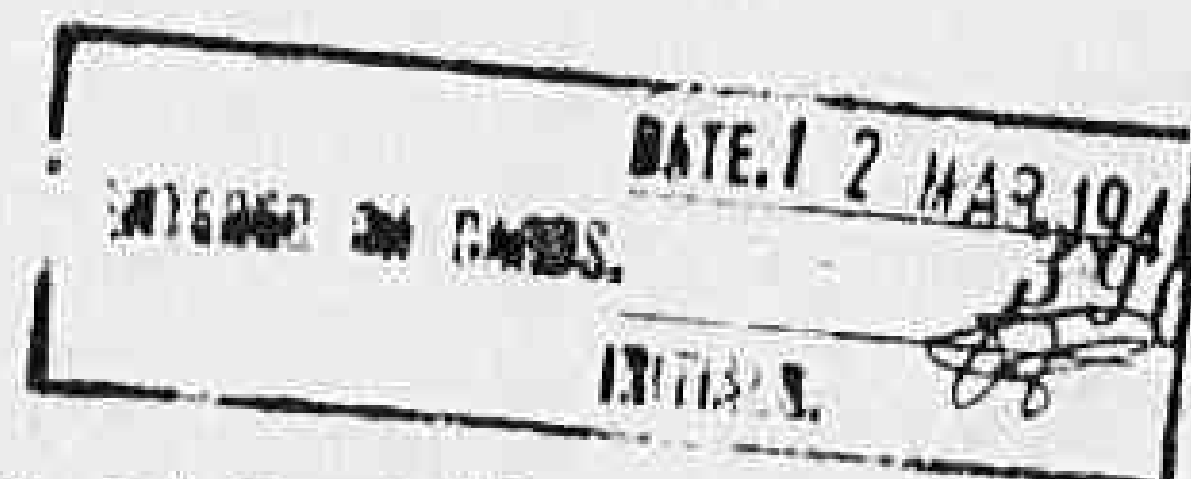

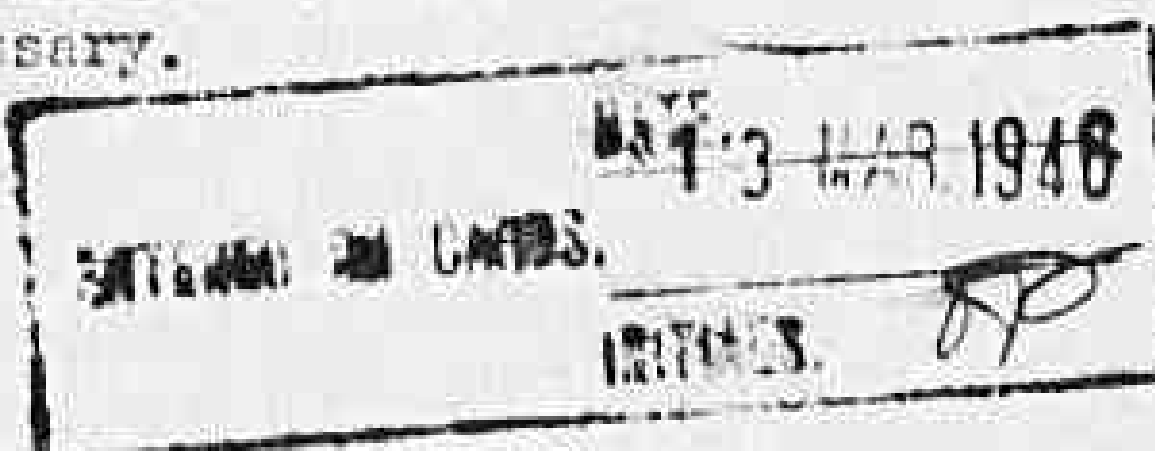
