3. The whole question of repatriation from East Africa is dependent up transport and shipping facilities and all such Prisoners of War and Civilian internees as desire to return to Italy on their release are being sent back as and when these facilities are available.
4. The fact that his family are without news from Dr. VOLPI for an unusually long period is probably explained by the fact that he may be moving from place to place, in the process of being repatriated and that therefore mails have become erratic.

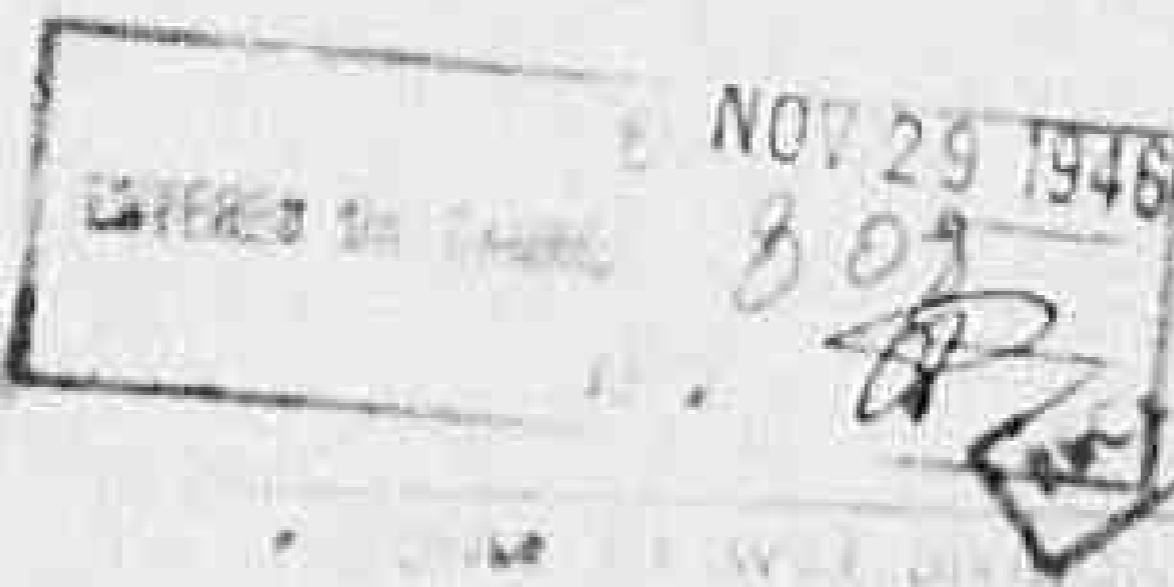

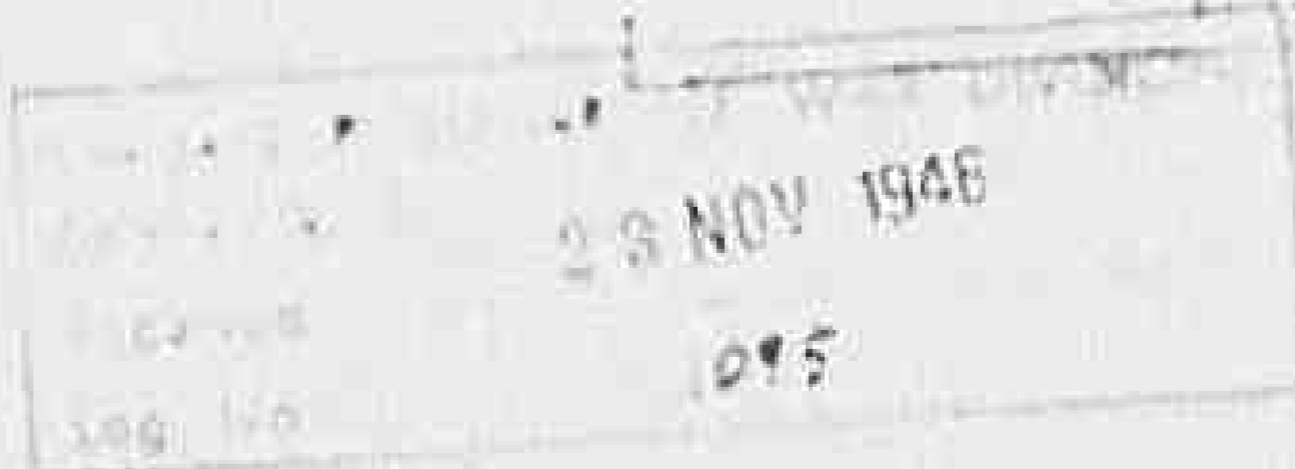

this evening returning from work I found your dear letters of the 15 and the one from mother of the 8th Oct. I am glad that you are well as I am also as I told mother I received the photos of your children which are lovely.

I hope to come home soon because as the Radio says. at the end of the year we will all be home: here in Batavia we are a group of 15 from the submarine who belonged to the big group at Singapore. We have tried to repatriate but up to date we have been able to do nothing we hoped to be able to join up with our companions at Singapore, who were repatriated on the 23rd of June. at first here we were under the English Military Command but now they have washed their hands of us and we are now under the Dutch Command who have no reason or right to father about us only two days ago I went around to all the offices and the English tells me, "here we have no prisoners non ex enemies, for us all are friends and if you want to be repatriated you must go to the Dutch.

The Dutch can do nothing and only say it is very difficult and they will us what can be done perhaps by payment, they can not and they do not want to do anything.

The Swiss Consul says that he has no orders from the It. Government and therefore can do nothing for us but if the Italian citizens will request that he takes the matter up he will repatriate us immediately.

I shall write in these days to the Consul at Colombo, who amongst other things is one of my ex Commanding officers and a very good man.

In the meantime, by letters or other channels, being pressure to bear on the Ministry of Marine, asking for information as to when we will be repatriated and convince them that if they do not interest themselves in us no one will.

Doct. Ing. Giovanni Togni, born at Campospinoso (Pavia) on the 11th October 1909, married and with a little girl, was taken prisoner, together with all his comrades, at Soddu (Abyssinia) on the 24th May 1941.

Since then he is in a concentration camp in Kenia, far from his family; his mother is ill with angina pectoris; the wife has practically no means of living. Having lost her house during the war (partly because she had to leave GIMMA where her husband worked before the war, partly because the Germans stole all what she had managed to take with her when she was repatriated, she is now living with relatives of hers in Genoa (Via Cafferio, 5). Her only income consists of the monthly cheque the Italian Government sends her of Lire 6645 which should cover her expenses and those of her daughter.

She therefore asks from the Allied Commission to kindly see that her husband is sent home as early as possible in order to assist with his work the old mother, the wife and the daughter.
