SUBJECT:- Repatriation of wounded, sick and invalid POW

We have received information that the prisoners in the Italian POW camps in India were told last April that the Italian government was not in a position to receive the invalid POW that the mixed medical Commission had declared "for repatriation" and that consequently they would still be retained in India.

We do not know how such news, so harmful to the morale of the POW, both ill and well, so injurious to the prestige of the Italian government, could have reached the Authorities of detention in India (and perhaps in other places as well).

I would be grateful if the ACC would kindly inform the Allied authorities of every country where POW are being held, that the Royal Italian government will never fail to welcome its sons who, wounded, sick or invalid, are repatriated. The entire Italian population will always be glad to make even the most serious privations, and the greatest sacrifices, in order to dedicate the best possible care to its soldiers who, after doing their duty in war now have need of assistance and the environments of their own country.

As I have said in preceding letters, the Royal government begs that the Italian soldiers whom the mixed medical commission has pronounced for repatriation, be repatriated with all possible speed, and to be informed in time to indicate the most points for disembarkation before their arrival and to be able to supply the necessary shelter.

This High Commissariate has been informed that several Officers POW interned in India, who had been proposed for repatriation by the Mixed Medical Commission since April 1943, have been transferred from the Camp of Yoi to Camp n.26, where in December 1943 they were still awaiting for repatriation.

The invalids complain of this new Camp for its lower height its dampness the accommodation in cabins, and the general organization which are far less favorable than those of the Camp of Yoi for soldiers who are not in good conditions of health.

The state of their health has therefore become worse.

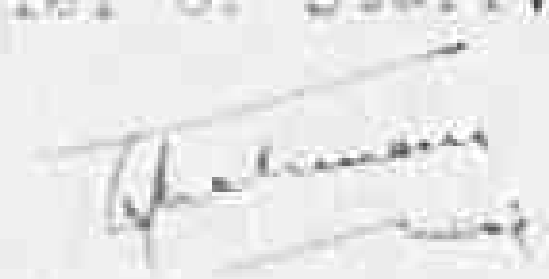

2. H.Q., Allied Union in Italy informs us that No. 1 District can find no trace in the registry of P.O. held in Sicily of SPINA Mario or CAMPANELLO Giovanni.

3. One of the Chaplains mentioned MESSIO Luigi has been traced and he is at present working as a Chaplain at SANTA MARIA (CIVIL) Hospital, CATANIA.

Although he was an Army Chaplain, he has never been registered as a P.O. He appears to be hard working at his present employment, and is highly recommended by the hospital authorities.

4. Should you wish to take any action with regard to MESSIO Luigi, you will no doubt do it direct with your own H.Q. in Sicily.

Eligibility of sick and wounded German PW and Italian PW, screened insecure, for repatriation will be determined in accordance with the Annex of the Geneva Convention, except that they will not have to be passed by a Mixed Medical Commission and eligibility may be certified for purposes of these reports by any examining board of medical officers appointed for this purpose.

b. Eligibility of sick and wounded Italian PW who are screened secure will be determined by the provisions of the Annex to the Geneva Convention except that they will not have to be passed by a Mixed Medical Commission and eligibility may be certified for purposes of these reports by any examining board of medical officers appointed for this purpose. In addition thereto PW who are so old and infirm as to be of no value to the war effort and PW who, although not specifically within the provisions of the Annex to the Convention, are in a condition where recovery is not probable within a period of 12 months, may be considered eligible.

However, such PW, as well as all others, may be proposed for repatriation in accordance with provisions of the Geneva Convention. No repatriation board is in existence in this Theater.

Reception includes transport to destination and this is also difficult to arrange at NAPLES. Intimation has been received of an outbreak of smallpox both in NAPLES and TARANTO and it is requested that PALERMO and BRINDISI be used as Ports of disembarkation. This will also fit in with the reception arrangements being made by the Italians.

As the existence of a Repatriation Board has not been hitherto known in this office, it would be appreciated if details could be given plus a statement of the terms of reference which governs its action. Applications are constantly being received in this office for repatriation of PW from Allied and French hands in NORTH AFRICA and from the Allies in other parts of the world. Certain applications have already been submitted by the A.C.C. direct to A.F.H.Q.

To avoid duplication it is requested that we be informed from what sources the North African Theatre of Operations, U.S. Army Board obtains its candidates.

With regard to ii, it is assumed that these men too have now passed the Repatriation Board.

E. Roster at your 2b is returned as these men are not to be repatriated to ITALY or the Islands. 4. All of those named on the attached rosters are ambulatory and do not require further hospitalization.

5. The following procedure is recommended for disposition:

- That the Allied Control Commission be requested to secure acceptance of the Italian Government for return of all listed on rosters referred to in par. 2a and 2b to Sicily.
- That the Allied Control Commission be requested to secure acceptance for the return of all listed on roster referred to in par. 2c and 2d to Italy, acceptance to be made by Italians at Naples.
- That all PW listed on roster referred to in par. 2e be transferred to SIC for release.

6. It is further recommended that prior to return, security clearance be secured from G-2, G-3 with respect to all PW and from G-2(U) and G-3 with respect to civilians to be repatriated.

7. To aid A.C.C. in securing acceptance, the next of kin and home address is specified so that if acceptance of total listed is not possible, those who can be called for by relatives may at least be disposed of.

8. Additional rosters with respect to repatriables requiring hospitalization are being prepared for submission to effect transfer to Italian custody as soon as possible.

MEMORANDUM TO: Chief Commissioner, Allied Control Commission

1. This is in reference to your memorandum (ref. CC/6/527) to JAG, Attention G-5, dated 23 May, above subject, copy attached as Incl #1.
2. The Public Safety Sub-Commission has, in conjunction with the Italian authorities, prepared lists of CC.M. & CC.FF. officers who are believed to be Prisoners of War in India and Africa, and for whom application is made for release, in order of priority as shown on attached lists (Inclosures #2 and #3).
3. With respect to the name of General Taddai Leonetto, Incl #2, CC.M. list; on 14 April 1944 you made a special representation by letter (ref. 302/101/CA) to HQ AHC relative to the release of General Taddai.
4. Note that the name of Capt. CASAR Profrio, shown on Incl #2, CC.M. list, 1st priority, was previously included on second Commando release priority list of 25 names sent to AHC by you on 23 April 1944 (ref. CC/6/222).
5. In view of AHC letter (HQS 614.12) dated 11 May 1944 (copy attached as Incl #4) and your memorandum referred to in para 1 above, it is suggested that you might want to send the enclosed lists to AHC for information of G-5 and for such use as G-5 can make of them.

2. I am sorry that the response to my request for repatriation of Carabinieri P.W. looks like being so small.
3. I would again emphasize the fact that the value of these men in Italy is infinitely greater than it can be elsewhere. They are practically irreplaceable here whereas elsewhere their duties could probably be performed equally well by other personnel.
4. I am now endeavouring to arrange for the repatriation of Carabinieri P.W. from East Africa and will keep you informed of developments.

SUBJECT: Repatriation of Carabinieri Personnel

TO : B.G., Allied Control Commission

1. Reference is made to the Chief Commissioner's letter of 23 April enclosing copy of a memorandum from General Piche who commands the Carabinieri.

2. The letter above referred to has been brought to the attention of the Chief Administrative Officer who caused investigation to be made with a view to seeing what officers and men of the Carabinieri held in North Africa could be made available for repatriation. The results of these investigations appear below in paragraphs 3 and 4.

3. So far as Carabinieri officers are concerned it is stated that 6 in all have been handed back by the British and that so far as is known there are no others in British custody. On the American side 16 were originally registered by them but except in the case of two whose repatriation is being arranged it is not possible to repatriate any more either because of the key positions they are holding or because of their pronounced Fascist views.

4. In the case of Carabinieri other ranks it is not possible to spare more than 50 for repatriation as the balance held are being used for essential duties here but the 50 have been assembled and are now awaiting orders to embark to Italy.
