- 1/. Allied Force Headquarters now advises that only 120 Italian PW from French custody instead of the proposed 300 will be repatriated.
- 2/. The withdrawals will be replaced by an additional 146 from U.S. custody.
- 3/. You are accordingly advised that a group of approximately 404 PW will be disembarked at Palermo on or about 3 Sept. 1944 from U.S. Hospital Ship "Meany".
- 4/. Nominal rolls and case histories will accompany all repatriates from U.S. custody.

SUBJECT: Harbour workmen.

1. At the moment of the occupation of Tunisia, there were various specialised harbour workmen squads at Biserta and Tunis, whose components came from the principal Italian ports. These workmen, captured by American troops, have been considered PW and the biggest part of them have been ceded to the French authorities.

As we have been informed in the Camp of Bogari (South-Algeria) only, there are more than 500 Italian harbour workmen.

2. The French Authorities employ these workmen for every other job except the one they are specialised in (they have been distributed as labourers in the industries and as farmers in the private farms). They are being treated very badly.

In consideration of the above-mentioned, I beg the A.C.C. to get the Italian harbour workmen retransferred to the British or American authorities and to be afterwards repatriated.

The same men would be employed according to their specialisation by the British and American authorities in a much more profitable way in the Italian ports during the actual fighting phase.

The five (5) children of PW MASULLO Giuseppe di Luigi are respectively 16, 15, 13, 12 and 6. Furthermore, inquiries made result in finding that the grandfather is very advanced in age and has need of assistance. The children are taken care of in so much as is possible by an uncle of theirs whom it must be observed has a family of his own to look out for. There are no other close relatives who could assume charge of the children. We comment that the case in question is of an especially pitiable nature and petition that your Sub-Commission recommend the repatriation of MASULLO Giuseppe di Luigi. His presence being so necessary to his children. We find that MASULLO Giuseppe is also called Francesco.

3. If those proposed in our L-30095 are not acceptable they will be withdrawn from proposed shipment but it is strongly urged that acceptance for them be procured if at all possible.

4. ETA at Taranto will be furnished to you upon sailing of vessel from Oran.

I thank you for your letter ASC/1/63 in date of 29th June 1944.

1. With regards to the proposal to repatriate 6 officers nominatively indicated, I pray you to observe that when the Italian authorities proffer a request for repatriation for determined officers, there should be kept present the criterion of equity with regards to the mass of the prisoners. These in fact, when it isn't the question of exceptional cases like officers, who have particular notes or special technical abilities, wish to be kept present above all the period of the captivity already endured. Unfortunately during the first period the Supreme Command has been obliged to recur, because of the urgency and the slowness of the first repatriations, with a certain frequency to the PW stationed in North Africa. But complaints are already arriving from Egypt, India, Kenya and America and the Royal Italian Government is obliged to take very much notice of these.

2. To come to a conclusion: if the P.B.S. needs 6 officers, the Italian Military authorities can appoint them at once picking them among officers stationed in Italy. It is enough if the P.B.S. indicates the task it needs them for or if either states the requisites it wants them to have. The Allied authorities are requested in their turn to give solicitous course to the demands of repatriation which formulated by the Supreme Command, must be presented exclusively through me to avoid confusion and disorder. I repeat again that the demands should consider the equity deserved by PW.

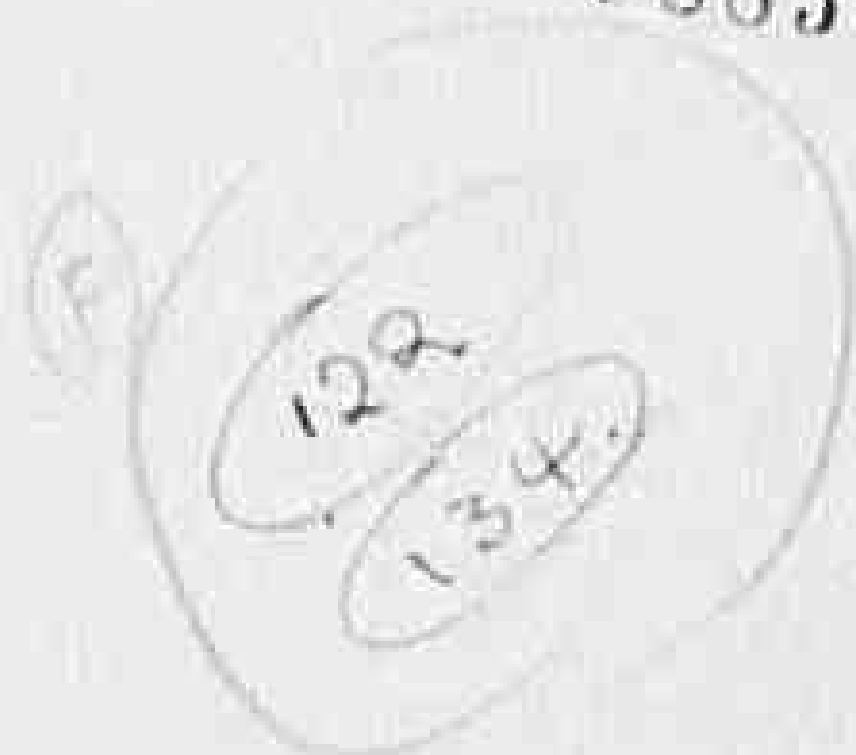

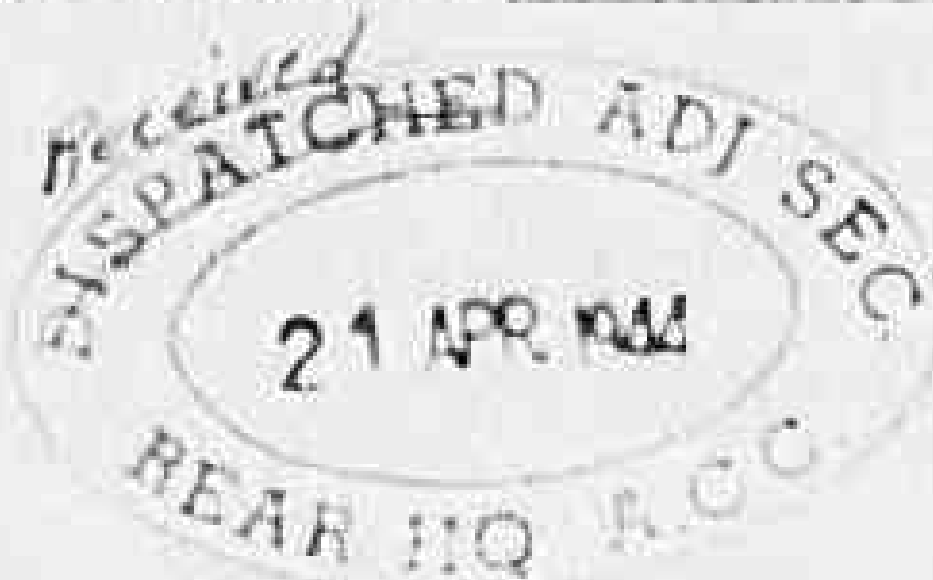

In reference to the benevolent opinions expressed by the A.C.G. in regard to prisoners of war who are in particularly unfortunate family situations, I point out the following four soldiers and beg you to arrange for their repatriation.

1. 2nd Lt. Eugenio Pannoci, POW No 40153, Camp 356 (B) East Africa.

He has been a prisoner for six years, because captured in Abyssinia in December 1937, was held by the rebels and then consigned to the British authorities.

2. Engineer Giuseppe Masullo son of Luigi - POW No 21890, Camp No 360 Section A c/o APC, East Command, Africa.

He has been a prisoner since 1941; his wife died leaving five young children in the care of their grandfather who is very badly off. Residence of family: Passetano di Cava dei Tirreni.

3. Marshal of Royal Carabinieri, Giuseppe Toccia - No 74331, Camp 366 Section D, East Africa Command.

He has been prisoner since 1941 and has been in Africa ever since 1938 without interruption. He has a wife and four children in precarious financial situation. Residence of family: Monopoli (Bari) via Bianchi 13.

4. Lt. Filippo Maria Guerritore No 24617 Camp 36 Wing 1/B POW c/o APC Bombay.

He has been prisoner since 1941. Two of his brothers were killed in action. The father is eighty years old, and the mother, seventy, are invalids.

Dear General,

I continue to concern myself with the facts pertaining to the unfortunate Lt. Guerritore and here are the latest news I can give you.

It appears that the officer reached on the morning of the 15th December, 1940, the regiment, which had been engaged in many operations for several days; he was assigned and immediately sent over to the 7th Coy, situated in the Sella di Coles region, village of Proganat (about 5 km in direct line N.W. from Tepelini).

The Commander of the 2nd Battalion, Major Luigi Pucci was wounded on 14th and was replaced that evening by Captain Ernesto d'Angelo.

On the 15th the companies of the 2nd Battalion including the 7th, all reduced considerably by preceding war incidents, were bitterly engaged. Many were overwhelmed; Lt. Guerritore amongst others, disappeared and no one has been able to give any details. Unfortunately other officers disappeared in the same manner soon after their arrival. On 14 December 1940, Major Luigi Pucci was commanding the 2nd Battalion of the 42nd, who was recently assigned to the Military School at Rome. Pucci was wounded on the 14th and left the command of the battalion on that same day. You could try asking him for particulars of Lt. Guerritore, perhaps he was able to learn something during his stay in hospital or after.

Major Luigi Pucci was replaced by Captain d'Angelo who was also killed on 15 December.

The 2nd Battalion was practically annihilated in the extraordinary hard, bitter fighting of those days. Only three subalterns survived, (2nd Lts. La Cava, Cartarelli and Piaschi), and they know nothing of what has come to Guerritore. They were carrying out respectively the services of victualling, cooking, and pack train.

In December 1940 Colonel Giuseppe Salamandre was Commander of the Regiment, who died in February of 1941 as a result of war events. He was succeeded by the then Lt. Col. Rino Ferroni repatriated the same month for illness.

The administrative of the 42 mobilized unit assigned nothing to the unfortunate Lt. Guerritore; the latter was satisfied with the work which the 23 Infantry unit entrusted him with, even up to 10 December 1940.

It is the duty of the deposit command to provide for the allotment of that amount which is due to the family according to the section of administration regulations here included in copy.

The personal chest of the officer was consigned to the clothes and equipment store at Verona (Intendenza Delegation) on 5th April of this year to be subsequently forwarded to the deposit command of 42 Infantry, Genova-Stula, where it should be still.
