





1. The above two Italian Officers arrived at CERVOLI (Q2648) in the Fifth Army Area on 6 Aug 44.

2. They state that they had been held in the US as PW having been captured by British troops in ETHIOPIA and had been repatriated as the result of a request made by Marshal MUSSE, Chief of Staff, Italian Armed Forces, for the release of Lt. Gen. FRUSCI on the grounds of "ill health". They flew via CASABLANCA, ALGIERS and NAPLES.

3. Their entry into the Army Area was in order in as much as they were in possession of an ACC Pass issued by Lt. Col. NEPHOD, HQ. Fifth Army AMB.

4. Both these officers have been interviewed by CIC and it would appear that it is their intention to remain at CERVOLI at the house of Lt. FRUSCI's family.

5. May this H Q please be informed whether they are to be allowed to remain indefinitely or for a specified period at CERVOLI. From interviews with them, their present status is not clear (i.e. whether they are on leave, permanently discharged etc.).

6. As a matter of interest, it may be stated that the CIC Agents who have interviewed Lt. Gen. FRUSCI have noted no visible symptoms of ill health.
