Excellency, .

Di PW1

A poor old mother who is gradually dying on account of her only son, begs you on her knees to let her have some certain consolatory news, seeing that your subordinates will take no pity on me, nor even reply to 5 pleading letters and written in English.

On the 1st December 1942 my poor son was embarked for Tunis, but during that night there was a naval battle with your fleet and since then I had no news of my poor boy. After 26 months of painful waiting the International Red Cross of Geneva in their letter of the 18th January 1945, transmitted through Palermo, gave me the glad tidings that my son was alive and a prisoner in the hands of the English and at this address: Di Mauro Francesco di Antonio P.O.W. No 273760 8th Pioneer Co. c/o Delegation of the Committee of the International Red Cross, 107 bis Rue Michelet, Algiers. I wrote at once to the Commandant of the prisoners to know why my son had never written to me in 26 months: I wrote to the English Command in Algiers, to the Red Cross, but never had a reply. After a further 6 months from the first communication, I got a letter from the High Commissioner for the P.O.W. at Rome, also, telling me that my son Francesco was a prisoner of war of the English, No. 273760 Camp 208 P.O.W. at Naples (Italy) I wrote at once again to the Commandant of this Camp three further pleading letters but had no reply whatever, and the Office that gave me the above information says that it has requested the Allied Authorities to interest themselves in the matter and to give a detailed reply. However 8 months are gone and I can never learn anything definite and therefore I decided to disturb Y.E. feeling certain that you will be able to tell me if they have confused him with

others or that he is perhaps mutilated, blind or mad or something, seeing that he never writes.

Excellency, take pity on my distress - it is not possible ²⁸⁵⁶ go on living in this way. Do an act of charity and at least let me die knowing whether I leave my son behind me alive and in what condition. You who are of the best race from a humanitarian standpoint and who carry comfort and well-being everywhere in the whole world, comfort also this afflicted heart of mine by giving me a reply, and accept my very humble thanks.

On August 1st 1940, the plane, under command of General CAGNA at the head of a formation entered into action against a certain number of English ships, amongst whom, was the air-plane carrier Ark Royal, south of Formentera, the plane in question hit immediately by the anti aircraft, abandoned the formation and flew south.

Around about 19 hrs (about 15 minutes after the bombardment) two Spanish planes coming from the Baleari Islands, commanded by Capt. Sancho, saw at Lat & Long. 4°00' E. 37°32'N. about 35 miles north of Dalys, between Oran and Algiers, a plane S.79 in flames: the Spaniard flew down to 50 meters and saw a man standing up on the right wing and two others holding on to the same wing. One of the Spanish planes threw three life belts, that fell near them, while the other plane asked for help by radio from the Baleari Islands - how ever when the help arrived there was nothing to be seen except a submarine at Lat. & Long. 2°45 E and 36°00 N. From the Air Ministry at Madrid, from our information service we were informed, (which information was afterwards confirmed by the English) that the Ark Royal on the 3rd of August, on her return from the above mentioned military operation, landed 15 or 20 Italian prisoners at Gibraltar, who were imprisoned in the prison of Wind Mill Hill, being all Italian military personnel.

They remained at Wind Mill Hill untill the 5th of August, after which date they were put on a cruiser and sent North.

G-5 : A.F.H.Q. has drawn attention (by telephone) to your I.P.W./1/3/1119 of 6th September to P.M.G. A.F.H.Q.

1. In this Sub-Commission's P.43.33/CS of 5th July (copy to you) the problem of establishing a limited parcel post service to Italian P.W. in North Africa was fully dealt with and the suggestion was made that the I.M.C.C. should discuss the matter with the competent Italian Ministries including the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications.

2. It will be seen that in that letter it was stated that there ~~was~~^{is} no reason why the Italian Government should not make bids for the necessary shipping tonnage in the normal way, but that the availability of shipping from Naples to Algiers is very infrequent.

3. Postal communications in Italy have improved considerably since July although they are still not adequate for a normal parcel post service in all parts of the country.

4. So far as Military Government territory is concerned it is considered that there would not be insuperable difficulty in arranging for Post Offices to accept from the public the limited number of parcels involved under this scheme and in forwarding the parcels to a convenient centre (say Genoa) for the preparation of despatches. The letter mails from Italy to France are addressed to Marseilles and are conveyed by a French road service working to and from Ventimiglia but this would be inadequate to provide for the conveyance of large quantities of parcels and unless disposal by sea from Genoa is possible, arrangements would be necessary for a special road service from Genoa or railhead to Marseilles, or the railhead on the French side. The I.M.C.C. might be able to help in this respect.

5. In Italian Government territory the parcels could also probably be collected to a convenient centre or centres through ordinary postal channels but the question would arise whether they should be concentrated at Naples and await despatch by sea when shipping became available, or sent overland to Genoa. Probably the Italian Red Cross at Naples could undertake the accommodation of the parcels until shipping could be arranged through the usual bidding procedure.

If, however, the prospects of shipping the parcels direct from Naples to Algiers or to Marseilles is so remote as to rule out this arrangement, it might be necessary to consider special arrangements for the transport of the parcels in bulk by rail from Rome northwards as the postal vehicles attached to civil trains on this route are already congested with existing traffic.

6. In the absence of a normal parcel service it is still considered that the formulation of definite proposals for the special service is a matter for consideration by the Italian Ministries concerned and the Red Cross organisations and you may wish to advise the Ministry of Post War Assistance accordingly. It might be advisable first to obtain the views of the Transportation Sub-Commission on the points mentioned in paras 4 and 5 concerning sea and rail transportation.

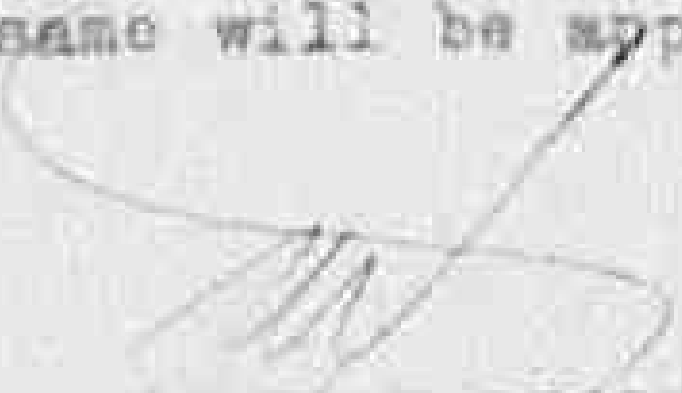

Lt. Sciacca was of the regular army stationed at the airport of Rodi (Egean). On the 5th July he went as commander of an air raid and was afterwards reported missing together with warrant officer (pilot) Edoardo Pesaresi over the Suez Canal.

A Radio transmission, from where it was impossible to trace the source, announced that the aeroplane commanded by the officer in question had been brought down and the equipage taken prisoner but the names were given as SACCHI (instead of SCIACCA) and PEVERESI (instead of PESARESİ).

We would greatly appreciate if you could obtain further information regarding this matter.

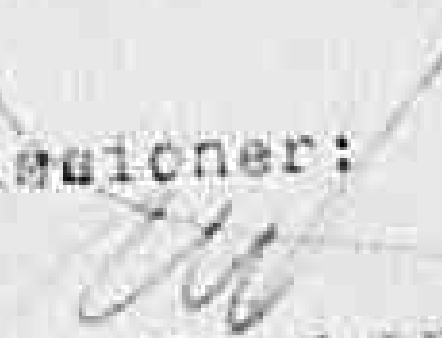

1. It is reported that continually increased demands are being submitted for the release of Italian PW in all parts of the British Empire because they are needed urgently for the rehabilitation of Italy.
2. Up to the present it has been the policy to release special PW cases provided that they were required to fill a post calling for specialist qualifications and that they were screened secure.
3. With the conclusion of the war and the repatriation to Italy by overland route some 400,000 Italians from North-west Europe it would seem that there is very little justification for the majority of these requests. The shipping ~~subsidies~~ involved might well be used for purposes of more direct assistance to the Allies.
4. It is suggested that the time has come to inform the Italian Government that except in medical or extreme compassionate cases no further Italians will be repatriated by sea route except as they are repatriated in conformity with the release schemes of the holding Governments. Unless you can set forth some other legitimate exceptions or overriding reasons which may not be known at AFHQ it is requested that you inform the Italian Government of the impracticability of continuing to act on individual cases except as noted above.

I have been informed that your Office can help me locate my only son, of whom I have been waiting to hear from for over two years.

His name and last address are the following:

BIANCHI PORRO ELIO Sottotenente - 88 Regg. Fanteria " Friuli"
Compagnia Comando 2° Battaglione - P.M. 79

I have already tried to locate my son through the Santa Sede, the Italian Red Cross and through many other organizations, without any satisfying answer.

Following is a translation of a letter written to me by a soldier named Consigli Camillo (Via Ribois 12 - Monte Oriolo - Firenze), who was under his command when I last heard from my son.

" Your son Sottotenente Bianchi Porro Elio was at September 43 in Corsica together with me at the days of the capture.

As I have already informed the Command of Regiment after my return to my native country, I tell you that at 25th of September 1943, during the fight against the Germans in Corsica (near Valle Cal-le - Bastia) the Sott. Bianchi Porro, commander of my report, was wounded by a bullet under the left side and, if I am correct, where he carried his pistol, which also was damaged, so we were captured and transported together to a place near Bastia - Corsica.

Then he was immediately sent by a truck to the German hospital of Bastia and I did not see him after that as I was a prisoner able to work and I was transferred to another place.

His wound was very grave, however I cannot say what could have happened to him after I left him. "

Now I think it is necessary to know if the Germans at the moment of their withdrawal carried with them all the wounded prisoners recuperating in the only large hospital of Bastia, or whether they were given further treatment by the occupation forces - which I presume to have been French - military units.

If the anxious waiting and the unexplainable anxiety of a mother whose son has been wounded and has not been heard from
