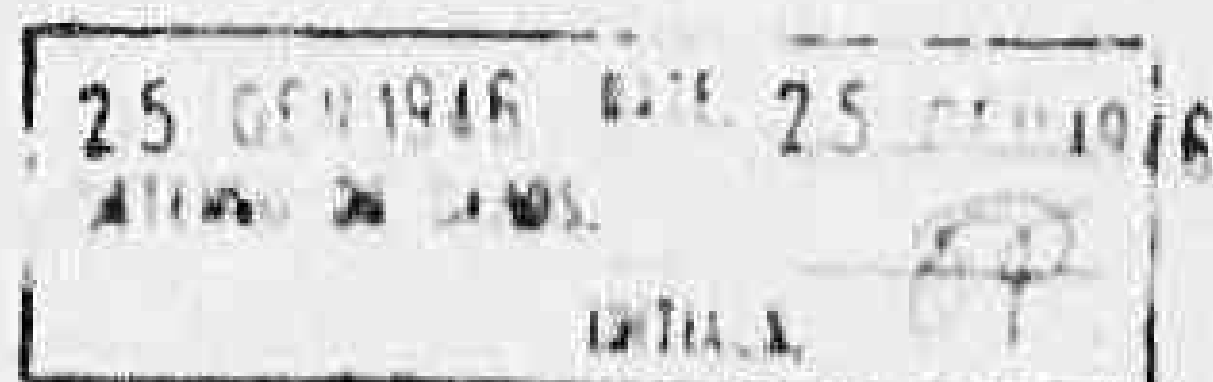
The corporal in question was accompanying a group of invalids.

From further information it was disclosed that they were badly treated and were also forced to heavy work.

From a Lieutenant Vices Vindi, recently come back from POW Camp in Yugoslavia the following information was obtained: The 21 Officers made prisoners in 1945 were assembled in the Camp of VRSAC in the Banate, located at 15 Kilometers from the Roumanian border and about 80 kilos from Belgrade.

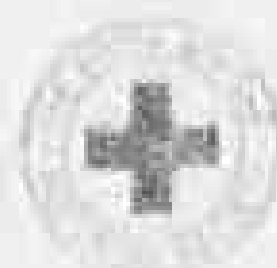

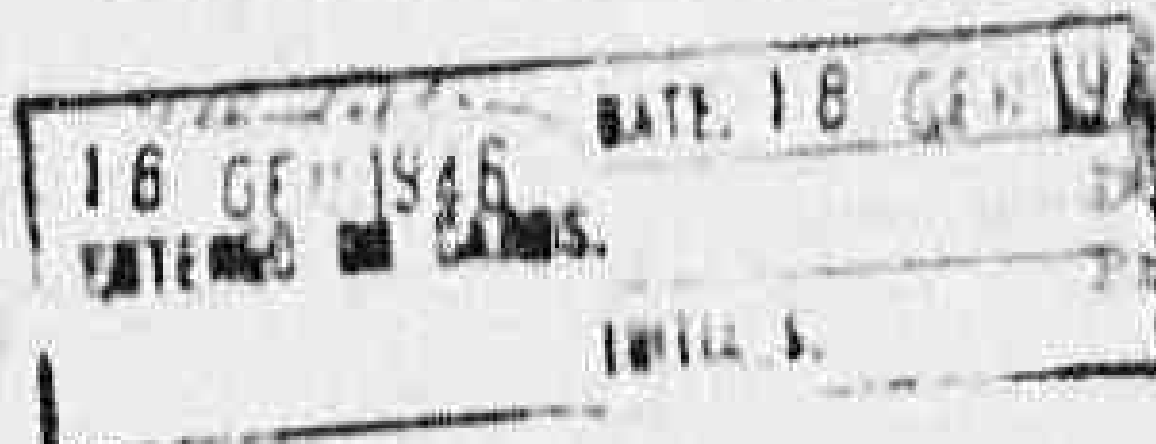

My dear Admiral,

The anxious and exasperating waiting, which already lasts for 10 years, for the return of my husband prisoner in South Africa, urges me to appeal to your paternal heart, precisely in these days when all Christianity celebrates Christmas, a feast of the family and of concord.

From my home there are two dear ones who for long years languish in distant lands, innocent victims of terrible war: my husband and my brother.

My husband, MITROTTA Francesco, to whom I was married by means of a procurator six years ago, is an African soldier since the first Ethiopian campaign of 1939; discharged and ready to leave for Italy the war of 1940 began and he participated as a first lieutenant in the Armed Forces; at the surrender of Gima, in June 1941, he was taken prisoner and is at the present an interned civilian in Camp no. 5 - Extension of the South Rhodesia - serial No. 31436.

My loving brother - First Lieutenant MOSTARDI Attilio, engineer officer in the Armed Forces of the Tripolitania since 1935, participated at the out-break of the war (June 1940) in military operations in the Bengasi zone, becoming a prisoner on Jan. 1, 1941. At the present he is situated in Camp No. 27 - wing 2 - C/o - G.P.O. - Bombay (India) serial No. 20776. During his imprisonment my mother passed away, as a consequence of the suffering and anxiety for her fighting son. My father who has passed the age of 60 years is affected by a grievous stomach ailment.

I realize to find myself, like many others, in a sorrowful condition, but if it be in your power, dear Admiral, to answer the prayer of a woman who for years feel wounded by the presence of two dearest affections, please do help her and I shall invoke, upon you and your dear ones, every grace and blessing.

In expressing my deepest sense of gratitude for all you shall do for me in the name of justice and of human solidarity, I desire to extend to you my best wishes for the coming holidays and to your dear ones happy and prosperous days.
