

The family of the officer in question are in great anxiety concerning him and requested news of him from the Ministry of the Marine Secretary General - as they have received no news from him.

He was a prisoner in the U.S.A. and boarded the Liberty-Ship no 287 on the 1st of Nov. 1945 - after 24 hrs. navigation due to an accident onboard the prisoners were transferred to another ship and sailed again after a few days. Captain Casawashima was not allowed to leave because his physical condition was judged by the Sanitary Officers, as not being fit to support a long trip and he was put in hospital.

From that time the family has received no more news of him and wish to be informed as to his health.





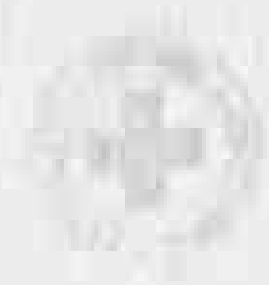

The Bureau has the record of a Serial No. B. No. 20116, T. 23924 Carabinieri Bartoli, Massimo Angelo, who died in hospital in England on the 14th August, 1945, of a fractured base of the skull having been run over by a motor lorry. He was buried in the Bedford Cemetery, Bedford, on the 22nd August, 1945, Grave No. 113, Section "A".

The death of this prisoner of war was notified by proforma to the Italian Authorities on the 25th August, 1945, and was followed by an entry on the Bureau's Official List No. 117 of Deceased Italian Prisoners of War, which gave the formal particulars of death. A copy of this List was forwarded to the Italian Authorities in Rome on the 6th September, 1945.

"POW Esposito Giovanni No. 188506 seriously ill Mitral Stenosis part of his wife Esposito Robert Adelaide Lauraia Avellino".

Subsequently with letter B.24 It (10)3.24464 dtd 18 July 1945 the following communication was received:

"POW Esposito Giovanni No. 188506 died June 20th. 1945 of Mitral Stenosis and Myocarditis".

In consequence of what is written above, this POW Bureau informed the Competent Italian Authorities of his death and requested that the Allied Authorities obtain the death certificate of the POW in question.

Your Commission with letter IPW/1/3/1805 B. dtd 27 December answered as follows:

"It is regretted that there is no record of the registration of Esposito Giovanni and it is pointed out that the Serial Number quoted for him, viz. 188506 is that of an Italian POW CONTI B."
