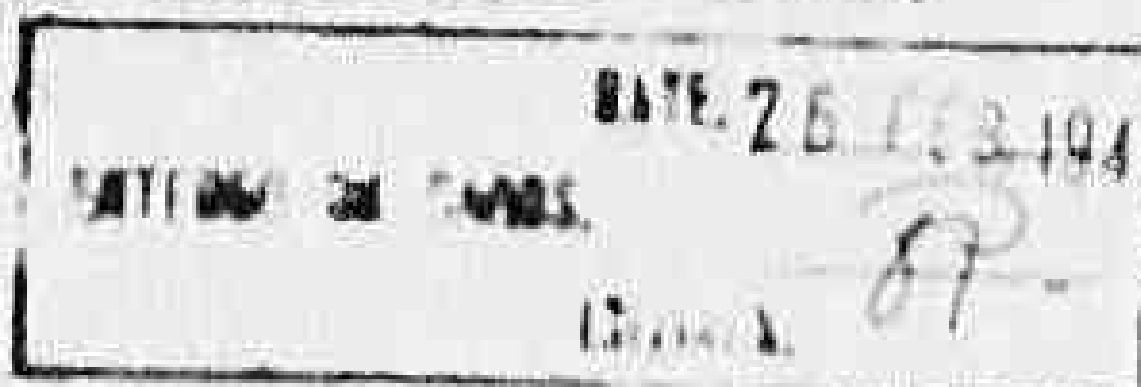

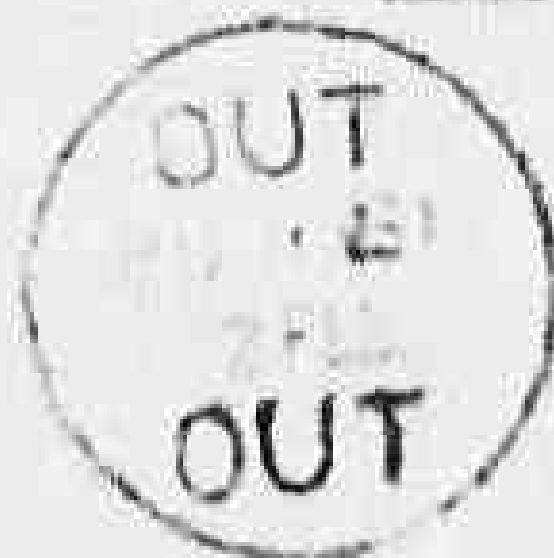

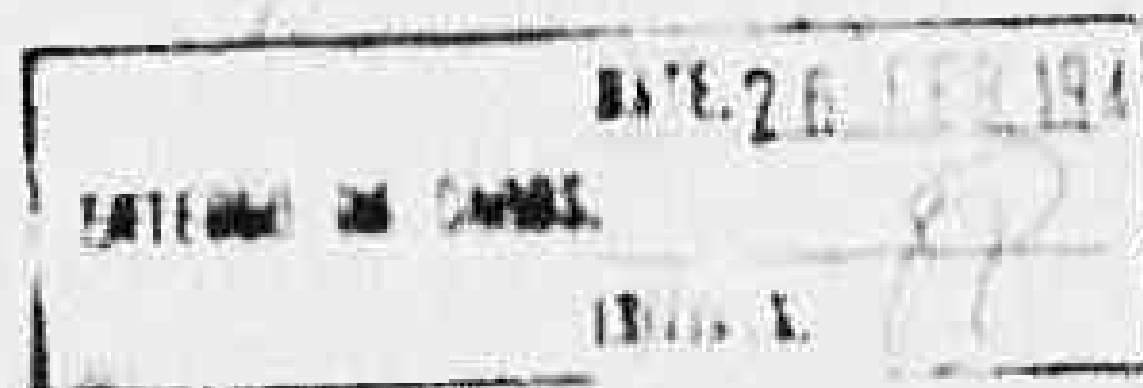

SUBJECT: Lt. Umberto Barbani (Pilot Air Corps) son of Augusto and Milani
Gemma, born at Rovigo, 16 February 1915.

1. The Officer in question belonged to the 279th. Group Aerial Torpedo -
Airport 757 P.M. 3750, Brera and was reported missing on the 22nd of Oct 1941 -
after leaving the Camp at 17.15 hrs.

2. Capt Marini, Giulio Commanding the group, made the following statement:

"On the 22 October 1941, at 17.15 hrs I took off with two couples
of planes, one of which was commanded by Umberto Barbani, for a Military
action. After about an hour, the sun having set, and there being no moon and
clouds were coming up in the East, I turned South and after a few minutes I
went back to west followed by my group. We landed regularly after about an hour
without having sighted any enemy aircraft. Forty five minutes after I landed
2nd. Lt. Strani arrived, a companion of Barbani, who informed me that your son
had gone on flying and had gone out of sight in the cloud bank that I had
noticed in the East. Strani tried to follow him, but at a certain moment lost
last sight of Barbani's plane due to the poor visibility and so he returned at
20.45 hrs. From that moment we have heard nothing more from Barbani or from the
men that were with him (Serg Pilot Bossi; Mechanician Fatorghani and Leone R.F.
and soldier Vanna)."

As we have never been able to trace the lad from that day, we beg you to
help us. It is not to be excluded that he may be in hospital, suffering from
loss of memory.
