Inquiries have reached us regarding the fate of the above mentioned Italian Air Force Officer.

He was born in 1917 at BUSSETO and shot down by a beautiful fighter on the 7/7/41 whilst flying in a small formation of Italian single engined fighters between CATANIA and SANT'ELIA-TRANC in Sicily.

It was presumed that he was a British POW and the persons making the inquiry (Tes. Pilota LUZZI FRANCESCO, stationed at TARANTO Airfield) is under the impression that he may be amongst a total of 7,200 Italian POW who (again according to Tes. Pilota LUZZI on information received from the Red Cross) are not allowed to communicate with their families.

It is requested that if possible some information be furnished as to the ultimate fate of the above mentioned officer and if it be considered necessary steps be taken to issue a denial of the dangerous rumour quoted above.
