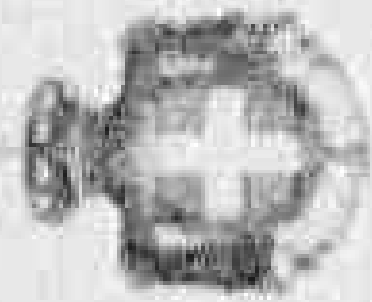

From reliable sources, it has been reported that, after the sinking of the ship he was rescued by an American aircraft, and that he is at present an inmate of a North American military hospital, having completely lost his memory.

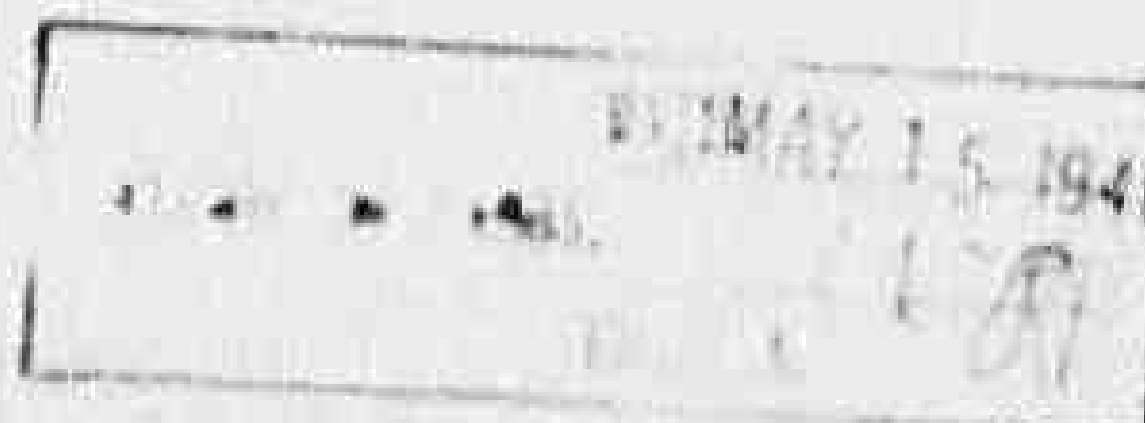

The family ask how they can get in touch with these prisoners.

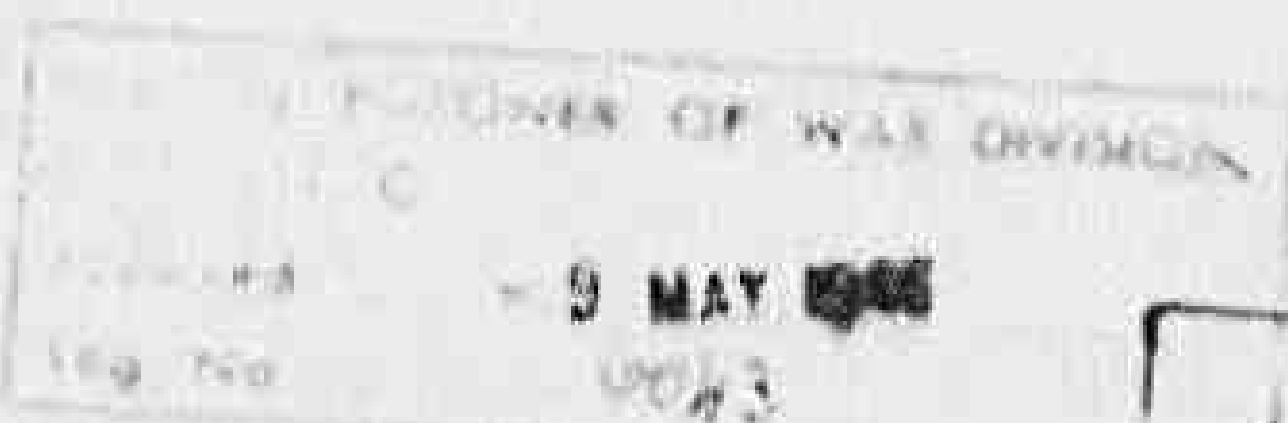

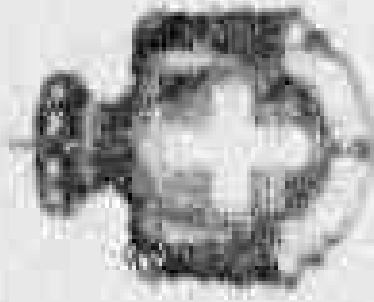
We have requested information from the Local OC,RR. regarding the Military Personnel mentioned in above letter.

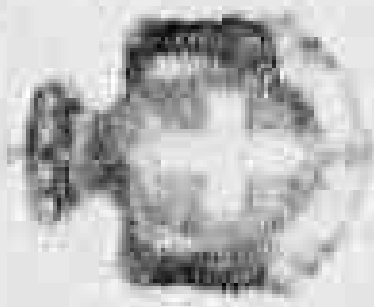

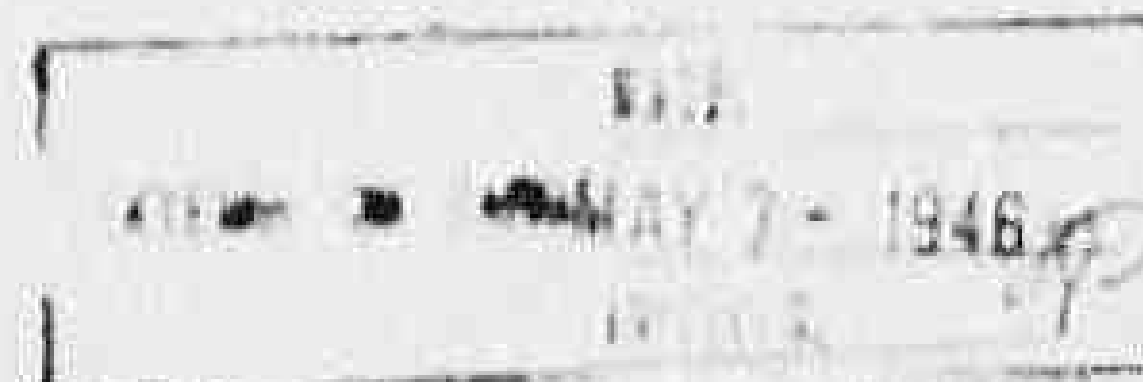
