On 3rd February 1943 the destroyer "URAGANO" sank in the Straits of Sicily.

Of the ship's company, 40, including officers and ratings, were saved; the remainder were considered missing by the Ministry of Marine and no news has been received of their fate.

Recently, Mr. Giuseppe Tornetta, an ex sergeant in the Italian Air Force who was made prisoner at the capitulation in Tunisia and who recently returned home after being a prisoner in British hands and later working for the French in Tunisia, presented a report to the Ministry of Marine in which he states that in December 1943 he knew a Naval officer by the name of Salvatore PAGE and a medical officer who was always in his company but whose name he did not know.

When Tornetta returned to Italy, he read a notice in the returned prisoners centre at Naples, requesting news of Prob. Midshipman Salvatore PAGE and he immediately contacted PAGE's family to whom he narrated the following. Then shown a photograph of Midshipman PAGE, Tornetta had no difficulty in recognising the officer whom he had met in Tunisia. Information on the character of the medical officer which he was able to provide also enabled Surg. Sub/Lieut. VESSE to be identified.

The information provided by Tornetta briefly is as follows :

- His first meeting with the above officers was in December 1943 in an Italian field hospital about 5 km. from Biserta on the Biserta-Tunis road. This hospital was then under British jurisdiction.
- There were subsequently further meetings as Tornetta often had the opportunity to stop at the hospital in the lorry on which he was employed.
- Tornetta saw the two officers for the last time on 10th May 1944, when they left for Algiers in a British motor column.

In July 1945 the International Red Cross Committee communicated to the VESSE family that, according to information received from their branch at Algiers, he was a prisoner at the following address :

This news had no result, however, <sup>as</sup> the enquiries made in America directly on behalf of the VERDE family were unsuccessful. As can easily be imagined, the information of Mr. Tornetta, who, although he was contradicted by the above facts, firmly stated that he was giving the true explanation, which he also endorsed in his report to the Ministry of Marine, was very distressing to the families of the two officers and they turned to the Casualties Office of the Ministry of Marine asking for the investigations to be renewed despite their previous negative result.

Owing to the importance of the matter, it is requested that the Navy Sub Commission should approach the Allied Authorities concerned for the renewal of the investigations as it is not out of the question that some of the crew of the "URAGUAY" should have been saved by British ships or have finished up on the coast of Algeria, contrary to the fate of the other group of survivors who were picked up by our own ships and whose names are known.
