- 1/. This Headquarters will not take any action until we again hear from you.
- 2/. Our reasons are as follows:
- a) If the information contained is to be forwarded to Mrs. Burroni it should be done through your Headquarters.
 - b) If your letter is forwarded to us with the implication that Medical visit should be payed to the PW by the Mixed Medical Commission, this Headquarters again must refer you to the policy of Allied Force Headquarters. This policy prevents our accepting individual requests for repatriation on medical grounds of Italian Prisoners of War. The policy does not restrict your sending forward to us lists of Italian Prisoners of War whom you desire to appear before a Mixed Medical Commission.

- 3/. It should again be called to your attention that the Medical service received by Italian PW is comparable to that given to Allied Soldiers, and that in the normal course of events individual cases receive both excellent Medical treatment, and are when justified brought before the Mixed Medical Commission.

You have answered to my letter n. 335/Mil/I/C dated August 28th by your n. IPW/I/3A/94 dated October 8th, that Lt. Occhipinti Giovanni, who is interned in n. 371 camp, Certosa di Padula, "is not repatriable because he cannot be included in any of the 4 classes".

I doubt that the misunderstanding on which the officer has been taken and is still kept under arrest have not yet been cleared up.

Lt. Occhipinti, as far as it has been reported to this High Commissioner, was arrested by British Authorities in December 1943 at Battipaglia, Italian territory, and then interned in the Certosa di Padula camp. The reasons of the arrest are unknown, but it was probably due to the fact that the officer had previously escaped from a P. of W. camp in Russia. Anyhow his arrest was not to be followed by internment, unless it was due to any other, actual, reason.

The officer was free and had all his right to remain so, serving under the Italian military authority.

I think, therefore, that he had to be promptly liberated, as soon as it had been made certain that he had done no blaming action and that his arrest was't based on sufficient legal motion.

So we do not request Lt. Occhipinti's repatriation, but his pure and simple return to freedom, as he is not to be considered a P. of W. He is but an Italian officer, in his own country, where he must be able to do, freely, his duty.

I will therefore warmly appreciate if You will kindly take or make any action be taken, as soon as possible, for the justice of the reason we are applying for.

I make clear that if these are the facts and the officer is still under captivity, he has now lost unjustly his freedom for nearly ten months.
