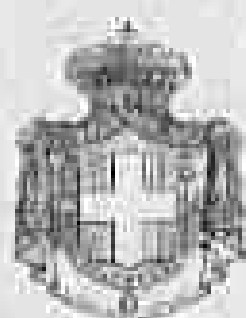

With reference to my conversation with you on 8 December regarding the repatriation of an Italian officer Prisoner of War.

1. The name of the officer is as above, and the particulars with regards to his case are as follows:-

His repatriation was originally asked for by the Comando Supremo on 30 June 1944 (and forwarded to Allied Force Headquarters) to take up an appointment in connection with the re-organising of the Italian Army.

As he did not return, further requests were made to AFHQ on 7th. September and 1st. and 20th. November 1944.

2. Recently the Lieutenant General of the Realm requested that special application be again made for this officer's repatriation to fill a special appointment for which he is specially suited.
3. It would appear that the PW in question was a regular soldier, with little or no political tendencies.

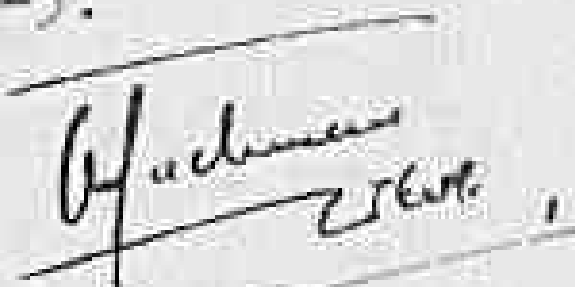

In this manner the repetition of requests which the Allied Powers do not intend to fulfill could be avoided.

Comando Supremo are primarily concerned with Armed Forces but they realise that other State Depts. may have equally important calls on trained officials who are held as officers or other ranks of Army, Navy etc. Thus, while they say their priority lists must have, in view of the active duties now imposed on the Italian Armed Forces, a strong "Services" flavour, they suggest other Depts. might be encouraged to represent their views.

c. This means that Ministries (such as Interior, "Giustizia Militare" etc.) might, through their own Depts. of A.C.C., submit a list of PW they require, supported by location and details of rank etc..

d. All such questions are dealt with executively by the Italian High Commissary for PW (Cava dei Tirreni) who should, of course, correlate lists to see there is no duplication.

e. If you agree, I suggest the Vice President might see what the Chief Commissioner thinks about the matter.

Recently numerous requests have come to Marshal Badoglio from Italian soldiers and officers of all ranks, now Prisoners, who wish to be repatriated and to be assigned to units fighting the Germans.

Due to the high spirit which animates these soldiers and which has spurred them to make the specific request to fight; and because of the moral influence that their repatriation would have on War Prisoners, as well as on the Italian population, I am of the opinion that it would be timely to welcome their requests.

I should therefore be grateful to the Commission if it would arouse the favorable interest of the proper Allied authorities.

For this purpose I am attaching a list of the soldiers and officers to be repatriated, which should be considered besides those that were requested with letter 11113 of 4 Feb 44.

MEMORANDUM:

TO: Chief of Staff,
Allied Force Headquarters.

1. I enclosed herewith a priority list of Italian P.W. Officers the return of whom is urgently requested by the Italian Comando Supremo.
2. This list cancels any previous similar lists which you may have received.
3. Some of the Italian army officer material especially in the higher ranks is extremely weak and Marshal Messe is most anxious to get these officers back to help him to put the Italian army on its legs again. Marshal Messe's request for the return of the officers on this list is strongly supported by Brigadier Duchesne and myself. I am out of touch at the moment with Admiral McGregor but I am reasonably certain that he would be equally in favour of the return of the four Naval officers involved.
4. I would be grateful if you could let me know as early as possible whether there is any prospect of these officers being repatriated at a fairly early date.
