

 - a) The repatriation of sick PW is putting a further call on the already overtaxed civilian doctors.
 - b) In some cases civilian doctors have had to be called into military hospitals to care for these sick prisoners to the detriment of the civilian population.
 - c) Salaries and other expenses have to be paid to any new medical personnel employed. At the same time allowances and subsidies have to be paid to medical PW. The Italian High Commissioner for PW complains that this puts another strain on the financial resources of the Nation.
 - d) The employment of repatriated medical personnel, who will be at the disposal of the Italian Authorities, will assist the sick soldiers returned from imprisonment and speed their recovery. Thus helping the reconstruction of the Nation.
