In^a report recently received from the Director of the hospital and Sanitary service of the 5th Group of It. PW Camps in India (Officers Camps N.25-26-27-28-) we have been informed as follows.

In the medical section of above-mentioned camps there are from 300 to 350 very ill men. The maladies are sprue, anemia and a very severe form of enteric colitis with relative diarrhoea.

The head of the medical section Capt. dr. BRASCHI declares as follows: "the enemy patients, if not sent home in the first six months of the present year, will either die in prison or remain invalides for the rest of their lives, due to the climate and the food, the latter being inadequate to their needs."

We beg this Allied Commission to inform the competent Authorities of this matter that they may examine the possibility of these repatriations.

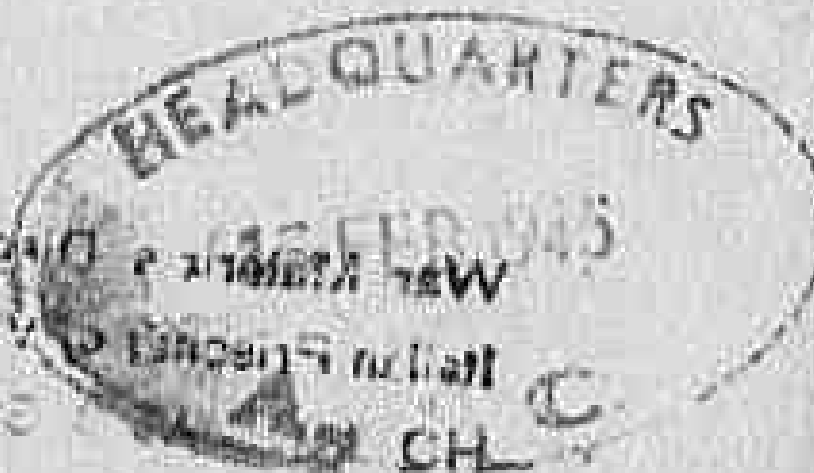

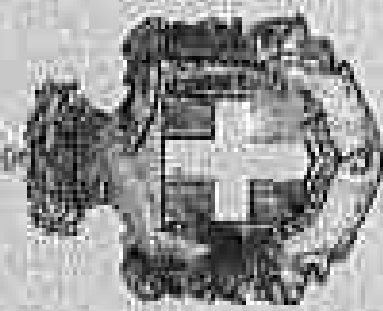
