Allied Commission replied to us with letter IPW/1/7/854, dated 26 March 1945, but nevertheless nothing yet happened about this matter.

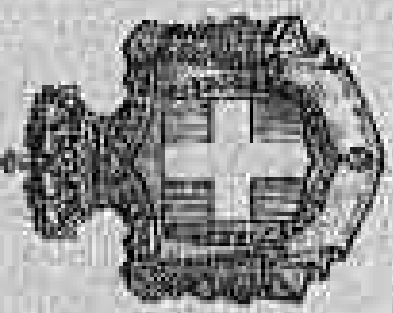

SUBJECT : Procedure for the Reception at Naples of
Repatriated Italian POWs in U.S. Custody.

TO : Provost Marshall, Pensouth, APO 782, U.S. Army.
Attention: Repatriation Officer, Capt. Desmond.

- 1/. It is hereby understood that the Provost Marshall at Pensouth is to hand over to Italian authorities all repatriated Italian POWs, repatriated at the port of Naples.
- 2/. Lt. Col. Salvatore INGHILARDI of the Italian Army, Naples representative of the Autonomous Office of Repatriated POWs and Veterans, is authorized to sign in behalf of this HQ., for all such repatriated POWs.
- 3/. Copies of all nominal rolls, so signed, are to be sent as soon as possible after disembarkation of the POWs concerned, to this HQ.
- 4/. All repatriated Italian POWs requiring hospitalization who arrive at dockside, Naples, are to be received by Italian medical authorities and despatched by them to hospitals in the Naples area, as designated by the representative named in para 2, above.
- 5/. Those not requiring hospitalization are to be sent to Campo San Martino, Naples.
- 6/. Italian vehicles are to be used as and if available. Lacking adequate Italian motor transport, wheel movements dockside to hospital and dockside to camp are to be provided by Pensouth. Transport of Italian POWs beyond camp or hospital is to be the responsibility of the Italian authorities.

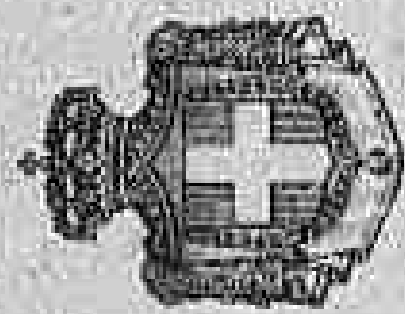

- 1/. The Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War again protests that lists of repatriated Prisoners of War received by him are incomplete and do not contain sufficient details.
- 2/. He requests that the senior officer in the group of repatriated Prisoners of War be instructed to compile, before arrival in Italy, a complete list of names, paternity and maternity and when ill, the nature of the illness.
- 3/. If these lists are available they can be forwarded to the Italian Military Commands at the ports and will obviate mistakes in radio transmissions in names of Prisoners of War not repatriated and will be a check on place of residence of family etc.
- 4/. My previous letters IPW/1/7/311 of 21 November 1944, IPW/1/7/344 of 26 November 1944, and IPW/1/7/637 of 23 January 1945 all refer to this matter.
- 5/. I have to urge that steps be taken to see that the lists as asked for are provided, and to state that the amount of unnecessary work at this Headquarters is increasing daily purely on such matter as the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War complains of, and it makes it quite impossible to compile accurate records from which to furnish information asked for not only from Allied Force Headquarters but for the War Departments and other Commands.

We beg the Allied Commission to call this matter to the attention of the proper Allied Authorities and dispose in manner, that the ranking officer in the group of repatriated P.O.Ws. receive the order to compile before their arrival in Italy, a complete list of names, paternity and maternity and if ill specify the nature of their illness. This list will be forwarded to all Military Commands of the Ports.

What is written above is to avoid the following mistakes; Radio transmissions of names of people not repatriated, control of the names and the place of residence of the family, etc. etc.
