MEMORANDUM FOR THE ALLIED COMMISSION

Subject: Emilio ARISIO - Enquiry as to health conditions.

1. Emilio ARISIO, a Lieutenant in the Italian and later in the so-called republican Army, was wounded and captured in January 1945 by a British Unit on the Adriatic front.

He is at present interned in Algeria, 211 P.C.W. Camp, Cap-Matifou. His number is T/76270.

2. It is reported that he was seriously wounded by machine-gun fire to both his arms, to his face and to the right lung.

3. An application was received by this Ministry from his father Pierino Arisio, residing in Turin, via P. Basetti, who enquires as to the present health conditions of Emilio Arisio. MEMORANDUM FOR THE ALLIED COMMISSION

Subject: Emilio ARISIO - Enquiry as to health conditions.

1. Emilio ARISIO, a Lieutenant in the Italian and later in the so-called republican Army, was wounded and captured in January 1945 by a British Unit on the Adriatic front.

He is at present interned in Algeria, 211 P.O.W. Camp, Cap-Matifou. His number is 776270.

2. It is reported that he was seriously wounded by machine-gun fire to both his arms, to his face and to the right lung.

3. An application was received by this Ministry from his father Pierino Arisio, residing in Turin, via P. Sasetti, who enquires as to the present health conditions of Emilio Arisio. He is very anxious to know whether the son will ever be able to regain the use of his arms and whether special electric treatment could improve his chances of recovery.

4. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs should be grateful to the Allied Commission if they would kindly promote the desired enquiries and ascertain whether e/m health conditions are such as to make an early repatriation advisable. *


