Most strongly protest lack of information regarding sick Italian repatriates to come from Russian occupied Germany also complete neglect shown patients in transit. of 320 so far received without advance notice 86 had severe open tuberculosis and 14 advanced typhoid fever. patients even transported in goods vans with no medical attention or hygienic facilities inadequate bedding and no personal belongings. several deaths occurred en route. request immediate steps be taken to eradicate these abuses. 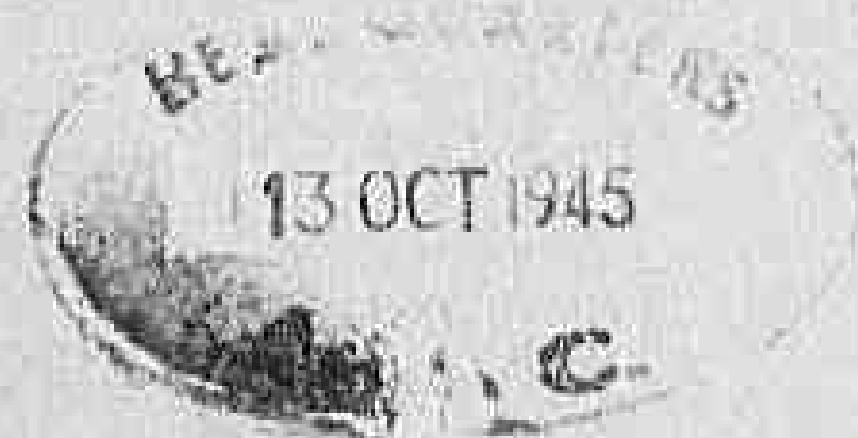

ITALIAN HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR POW

Rome, 8 August 45

TO: The Allied Commission  
S/C for Prisoners of War and  
War Materials Disposal  
Rome

The remaining (little more than 400) now in the camp some of them are better and only 15 are dangerously ill, too ill to go to their country. Thanks to Allied intervention the high mortality under the German regime has diminished.

For the other invalides (not T.B.C.) a new hospital has been opened for the Italians at Meppen.

It results that in other hospitals there are many thousands of these unhappy people, some very ill who are in hospitals and infirmaries in small cities such as Oldenburg, Hannover, Westfalia, Essen, Brunswick and in the provinces of the Rhine.

We beg your Sub-Commission to call this matter to the attention of the British Authorities of those places and have them examine the possibility of getting together all these sick people, scattered here and there who are being taken care of by German sanitary organizations and give them all possible aid, in more, putting them all together will facilitate their transfer, when their repatriation will become possible.
