During the last reunion of the Mixed Medical Commission about a year ago, some few hundred prisoners were recommended for repatriation. About a half of this number had the luck to leave in December because they were classified as being able to travel on ordinary troop ships, the remaining number, in greater part mental cases, were judged as stretcher cases and are therefore still awaiting a hospital ship. For motives unknown to me, the local medical Authorities, in the aim of facilitating these repatriations, in March made another medical examination of these persons and decided that they could be transported on ordinary troop ships around about the latter part of March, which decision was revoked while they were making preparations to leave. This produced great resentment on the part of the prisoners, also because places that had been reserved for sick persons had been given to a group of people who had been recommended. I must add that due to various errors, the sick personnel did not receive the usual bi-monthly visit which would have listed them as having the right to be repatriated since last year. The disposals published in the March of last year stated that the sick did not need particular care during the trip and that they could be transported with normal transport, those that could have been sent with normal transport were those classified as stretcher cases and who have been awaiting months for transportation. For that which regards me personally I inform you that I was captured on the 20-6-1940 and I am therefore one of the oldest POW of the world and as such, it seems to be a paradox, if I had not been ill with a nervous illness I want already have been repatriated months ago.

I turn to you in the hopes that you will intervene on behalf of these 350 sick POW in Yol, with the Competent Authorities in order to salve this sad situation once and for all.

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT : Repatriation of sick POW on Hospital ship -

Since Sept. 1945 no POW who should have been repatriated on a hospital ship, has left India. The VII Mixed Medical Commission completed their examination begun in June, in the month of September and in October gave a list of the prisoners who were seriously ill and declared as being fit for repatriation on the grounds of illness. During these months many times it seemed they were to have been repatriated but the repatriations did not take place due to the lack of hospital ships. Amongst these people is a group of men effected with mental disturbances, due in great part to their long imprisonment and if freed would regain their health, while if remaining behind the barbed wire, will most certainly become worse and probably come to a tragic end.

The Direction of the Hospital at Yol (India) proposed to the English Command that these people be examined in view of establishing the possibility of letting them travel on ordinary troop ships. At first this proposal was accepted but on the day the prisoners were leaving the camp to return to Italy, the order was revoked.

This naturally produced a very bad reaction on the part of the prisoners and an increase of their psichical depression, was the out-come. The seriousness of the situation is easily understood, when you consider that for many months they have been listed for repatriation, on the grounds of serious illness and they have had to wait longer than the others on the pretext of receiving better attention aboard a hospital ship.

We supplicate the Holy Father to intervene on the behalf of these people and give disposals to have at least one hospital ship sent for them.

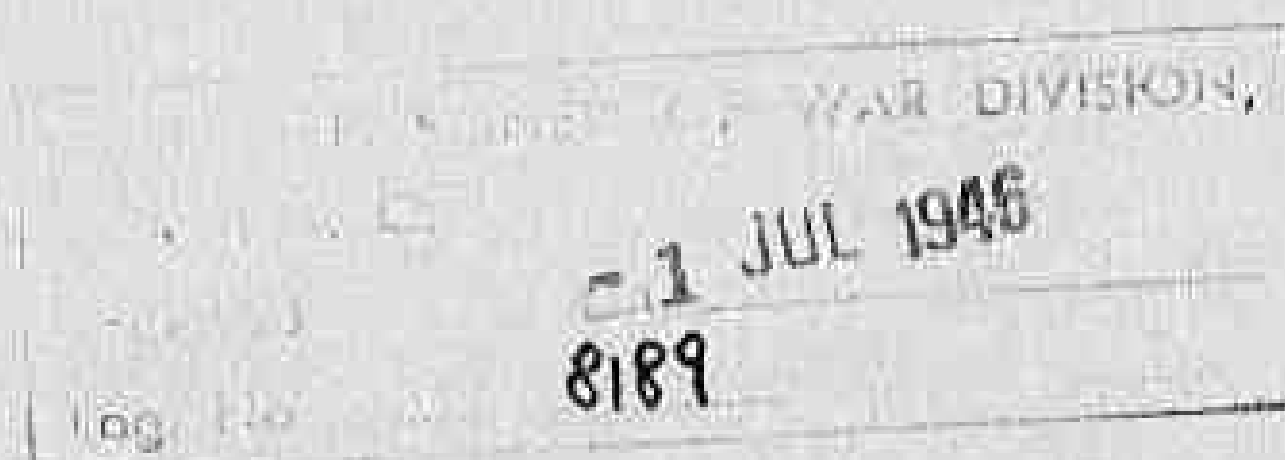

The undersigned Lt. SCAMBATI Mario who was stationed at the English Command of Camp 28 V Group, Yol in quality of Interpreter to the Adjutant Capt. R. Andrews from October 1944 up to March 1946 the day he was repatriated, and 2nd Lt. Cardinali Giovanni who was stationed at the Analysis Laboratory at the C.M. and POW Hospital of the V Group, Yol in quality of assistant Doctor from March 1944 up to 24 March 1946, date of his repatriation, both of whom arrived in Naples on the 21st April 1946, made the following statement regarding the patients in the Hospital at Yol of the V Group.

The patients passed the mixed Medical Commission and were divided into 2 groups for repatriation.

The first group composed of not too serious cases were declared to be fit to travel on a troop ship, they therefore are repatriated as ordinary PWs.

The second group organical troubles and mental cases are declared to be in a condition that requires a Hospital Ship to repatriate them. It is this latter group that should be called to the attention of your Office taking into consideration that they have been waiting over a year and others have died while waiting the Hospital ship. To all this must be added the Climatic Conditions which are of the worst especially now due to the coming season which is not good for sick people (rains season) and the food is very scarce due to the reduced rations of Dec 1945. Regarding this matter of the rations Capt Mendicini Dr. director of the Hospital at Yol sent a protest in Jan 1946 to the English Command informing them of the insufficiency of the rations.

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Repatriation of POW patients on Hospital Ship.

Since Sept 45 no POW who should have traveled on a Hospital ship, have left India.

The VII Mixed Medical Commission finished their inspection, begun in June, in the months of September and October, and gave the names of PWs whom they recognized as having the right to be repatriated on the grounds of illness. It seems that during these months they had many opportunities to be repatriated, but due to the lack of hospital ships they remained behind the barbed wire. Amongst these people there is a group of nerve cases that is due to their long imprisonment and if they could be repatriated they would probably get well, while on the other hand if they remain there, they will become permanent mental cases.

The Direction of the Prisoners Hospital of Yod, India, proposed that the British Command examine the possibility of having them examined with the view of finding out if it is possible, to have them travel on a regular troop ship. The proposal at first was accepted but on the day the prisoners were leaving the Camp the permission was revoked. This very naturally had a very psychic effect on the prisoners who realized that more long months of imprisonment were ahead of them. The seriousness of their situation is increased when you consider that for many months they have been judged as very ill and therefore have a big priority in repatriation which could not forth-come,, due to the lack of suitable transport.

We beg the Holy Father, to intervene on their behalf and with his great charity, have a hospital ship put at the disposal of these unfortunate people who more than others, due to their infirmities have the right to be protected by the father of the faithful.

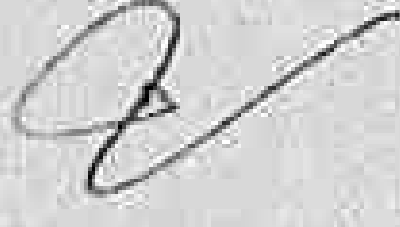

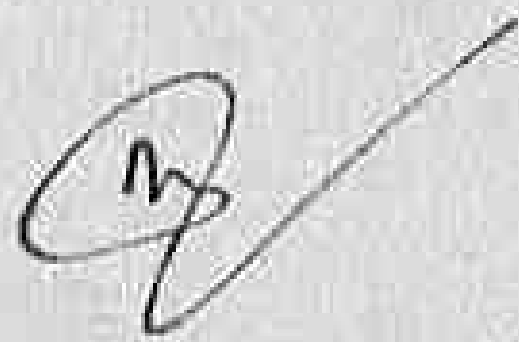

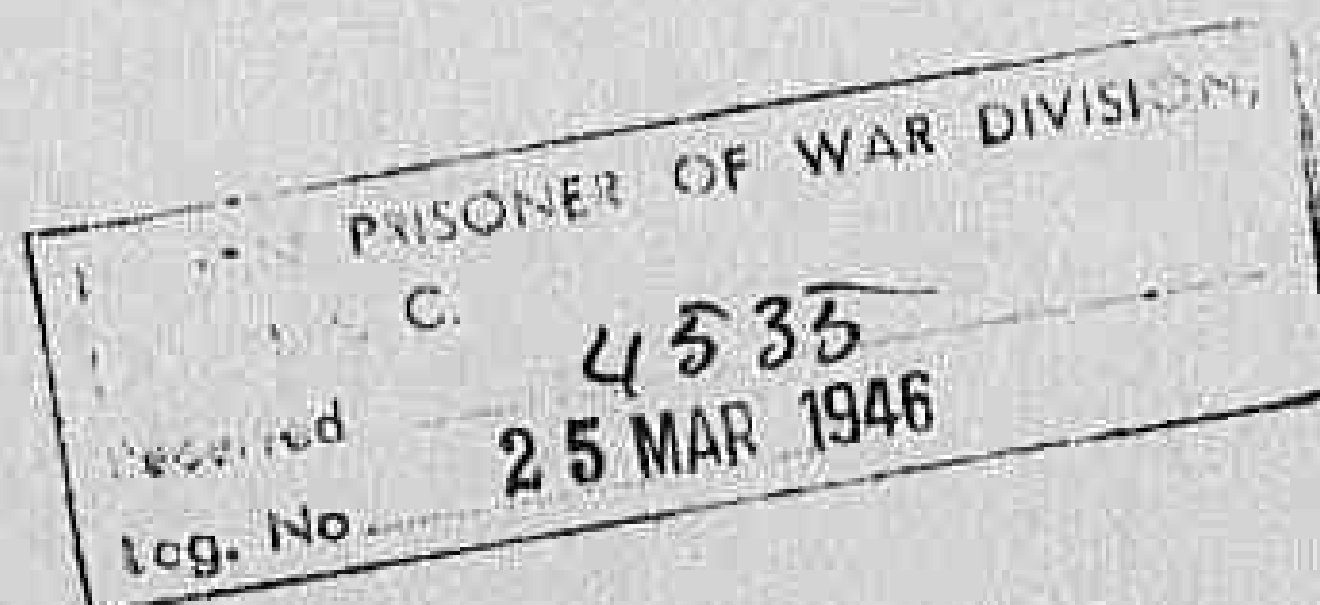

The undersigned informs this Command of what fol-

lows:

1°) From witness of some prisoners of war reentered from India he has known that his brother E. Tenente Mario Tarantino fu Giuseppe, n. 1733, c. mp N. 28 wing I India, prisoner since October 1940, is at present down with a nervous sickness and suicidal mania. In fact he has already tried to kill himself and being his attempt unsuccessful he grew worse than before. He wrote his relations some letters from which it is easy to understand that he is sick without any doubt and that in case he could not come back home at once he might repeat his attempt at his life.

2°) That his brother's financial position is good and whenever he repatriated his family can meet all expenses for his living. Therefore he would not be of any charge on the National budget. The undersigned himself, surgeon and manager of a private Hospital and assistant surgeon at the Institut of Surgical Pathology of the R. University in Naples, wishes to provide to the expenses of his brother's repatriation by paying with English money for his transportation to Italy with civilian means by sea or air.

3°) In case all that was not sufficient, the undersigned wishes, if it is possible, to go and take his brother's place as a prisoner of war in India, so that he can repatriate. Being a surgeon he could be useful in these camps of concentration, remaining there at his brother's place as long as he should have.

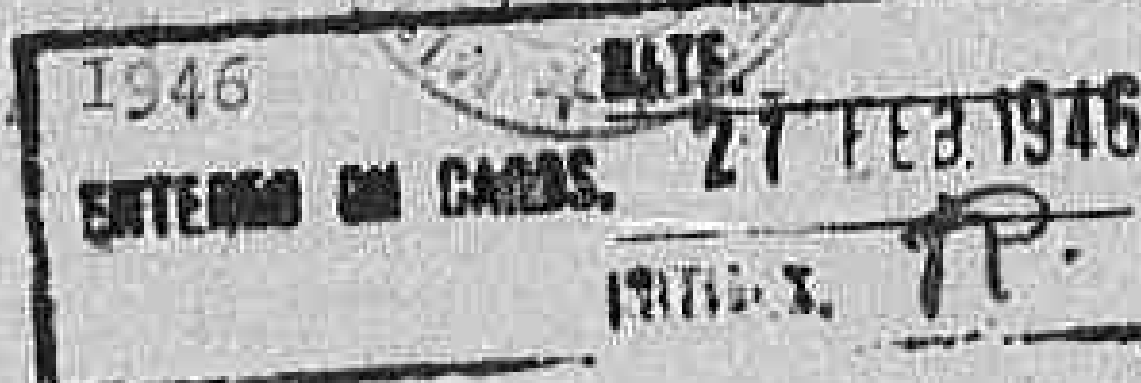
2. Although in normal circumstances no request for priority of repatriation can be entertained - according to the regulations in force - in favour of prisoners of war, it is felt that an exception ought to be made in this case, in the hope that his return home may cure a/m of his suicidal mania.

3. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs should be grateful to the Allied Commission if they would recommend to the competent Authorities to take into benevolent consideration the above request. A

The undersigned Quattrini, Lamberto who was repatriating because sick, from the 5 G.M.M. on the 18 July 1944, was taken to Bombay on the 6 Nov 44 in order to be put onboard a hospital ship.

After a day's waiting near the ship he was sent back to the prison Camp together with other invalides for some unknown reason. This delusion after four years imprisonment, had very bad repercussions on his health; but the assurance from the English Authorities that he would leave very soon on a Hospital ship, served to calm him down. He received this assurance from the International Red Cross in India Dr. Wenger. Ten months have passed and during this time 4 boats have left with the sick and he has always been excluded.

He call your attention to the injustice that has been shown him, and begs to be repatriated. In 1944 his family heard his name over the radio as being in a group of repatriates and awaited his arrival day by day.

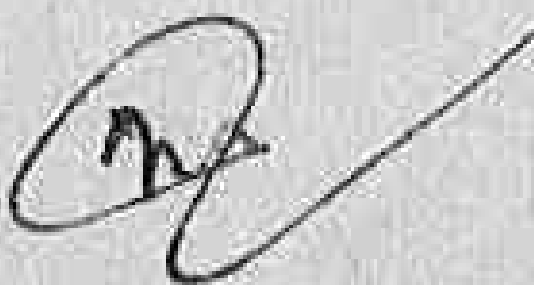

1. Reference is made to Allied Commission's note IPW/1/7 IND/1527 dated 30 October 1945.

2. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs informs that

a) the individuals referred to are all prisoners of war;

b) a nominal roll of the individuals in question cannot be transmitted as the application for repatriation was submitted by a group of relatives of some prisoners, on behalf of all of them;

c) it can be assured nevertheless that all the p.o.w. concerned belong to the well known categories for whom repatriation has been authorized by the Allied Authorities.
