TO : Provost Marshal General, MPOUSA

1. On 30 May 45, this Division forwarded to G-5 (American), AFHQ, list 5-A of Italian PWs recommended for repatriation, in which list, on page 5, appeared the name of subject PW.
2. This office is now in receipt of a letter from the Italian Ministry of Post-war Assistance stating that Lt NIGRO was released from the PW camp at Oran on a repatriation order, taken to Marseilles, then to Liege, and finally back to Marseilles.
3. At that port, however, he was not returned with other repatriates because he had lost his documents.
4. The Ministry of Post-war Assistance requests that Lt. NIGRO be repatriated despite the loss of his documents, and this Division concurs.
5. It is requested that this office be advised of your action.

1. I refer to our conversation of some days ago, in which you kindly said you would take action in the following case.
2. Several urgent requests have come to me from Sig. Gino Salocchi (Pistoia, Commune of Mantaletto) and particularly from Signora Salocchi asking for assistance in obtaining the release from POW status of their son. The family is an eminently respectable one. Sig. Salocchi was chosen by AMG to be Commissario of the leading savings bank in Pistoia Province and has done a superior job. He has recently informed me that his wife's health has been impaired by worry over the son's protracted confinement to a POW camp in Africa. Letters from the son indicate that living conditions in the camp have been deteriorating. The young man is a Medical Lieutenant and this may have been a factor in delaying his release. The family have heard, however, that other Italian officers, including doctors, have been returned to their families in Italy, and this has caused them additional distress.
3. It would be greatly appreciated if steps could be taken to expedite the young man's release to return to his family. The POW's name and address is:

This Ministry, following a request put forward in G-5:014.33 of 4th inst. from A.F.H.Q. and informed verbally by Italian P.W. Sub-Commission U.S. Army, has given its approval to the proposed repatriation of 14 in No. I.R.N. Officers at present P.O.W. in N. Africa in American hands.

An examination of these Officers' names shows that amongst them are all the Officers in Sub. "ARGENTO", which was sunk in Western Med. in August 1943, with the exception of her C.O., Lt. MASINA, Leo who was taken prisoner at the same time as the others.

To avoid a differentiation in treatment which would undoubtedly effect the morale of an excellent Officer, we shall be glad if your Command will authorize Italian P.W. Sub-Commission U. S. Army to add the name of Lt. MASINA, Leo to those it has been agreed upon to release.

Should his non-inclusion originate, as it would appear, from the fact of his being employed in some working establishment, it is requested that the possibility be examined of his replacement in such duties to allow him to reassume his appointment with I.R.N. as Commander of Underwater Craft.


