

Reference your CR/3836/G1(B) dated 9 February 1945.

1. The question of the repatriation of 2/Lt. OTTAVIANI has again been referred to me by the Vatican.
2. As it is now nearly three months since the C-in-C India was asked for the release of this PW, I shall be pleased if you can let me know by return if you have any information as to his ETA, and if not, if a signal can be sent to C-in-C India, requesting that steps be taken to have him repatriated by the quickest means possible.
3. The repatriation was requested by His Holiness the Pope, through his Secretary of State by the British Minister to the Holy See and Monsignor O'Flaherty of the Vatican State.
4. As is well known, Mon. O'Flaherty was responsible for the safe-being of many British officers in Rome, who escaped from the Germans. This he did at great personal risk - one instance being, when an immediate operation for appendicitis was necessary, he took the officer from the Vatican in an ambulance to a hospital, had the operation performed while he attended at the hospital, and returned his patient safely back to the Vatican, under the eyes of the Germans.
5. Mon. O'Flaherty has not referred to the assistance he gave to our officers, but has made a special request to me that <sup>1</sup> ~~1~~ everything possible for the prompt return of Ottaviani to Italy.
6. I take this opportunity of pointing out that delay in the repatriation of Italian PW from India and Mideast is the cause of daily complaint by the Italian Government - who point out that certain PW who have not been requested have returned from India, while those they have made special application for - do not.

7. It becomes increasingly difficult to know how best to answer the pleas of the Italian Government and the Vatican State regarding the cases which have been submitted for repatriation of Italian PW, and on which no information has been received.

8. It is strongly recommended that steps be taken to arrange the repatriation of Ottaviani - even by air, owing to the level from which the request comes, and because of Mon. O'Flaherty's action with regard to our own PW.

In thanking your Sub-Commission for the interest shown for the repatriation of the personnel of this Court for the revision of accounts on list sent with letter 22/Sgr.Gen. dated the 28th. of December 1944, are in the meantime inform you that the judge Relleva Mario No. 381095 Camp 304 Postal Center M.E. has been repatriated, and should therefore be cancelled from above mentioned list.

Relative to the information transmitted in letter 1/11/797, dated the 6th. April 1945, we answer as follows:

The following civil servants of the court for the revision of accounts are not P.O.Ws. but civil servants on duty at the Court for the revision of accounts in Asmara (Eritrea) where they are residing at the address herewith underwritten alongside their names.

MAZZAROTTA ARTURO residing in Asmara at Amba Galliano, block n.180 A. No. 38.

ROSSI MARCELLI GUGLIELMO, residing in Asmara and RISSONE AUGUSTO residing in Asmara, both in zona Paradiso. They are therefore found at above mentioned addresses.

The repatriation referred to of S/T Caruso Claudio (E 11332) does not concern this court as the civil servant requested is CARESSA (not Caruso) Claudio and he is not a P.O.W. but a civil servant residing in Asmara, Via Luigi Santucci No. 12 awaiting repatriation.

The last address received at this Court of Mario Rossi is Via Pellegrino Matteucci No. c/o Comm. Liberati - Asmara and is also where PANICONI Mario resides in Asmara.

The two individuals are also not P.O.W. but always civil servants not called to arms and when Asmara was occupied by the Allies, had no military status.

As they have been liberated for Civil work, as would seem by the communication received from your Sub-Commission, we beg you to dispose for their repatriation.

The reference to Capt. AMATO Gennaro, does not interest this Court. It is evidently a case of identical names, because the person whose repatriation was requested by this Court is AMATO Gennaro, very old and could have no military status or cannot be in the category of P.O.W. Said individual is a civil servant of this Court and resides in Asmara at Via Luigi Santucci 12.

All the above mentioned individuals and those on the attached list form a part of the Administration of this court and when repatriated will have their former employment on roles of this administration.

The repatriation of this personnel is very urgent due to the fact that many of the personnel of this Court were transported to the north of Italy during the Nazi-Facist occupation and they are therefore needed for the re-organization of said court.

As it results that this personnel are living under very difficult financial conditions, we beg you to call this matter to the attention of the Allied Authorities that they may give the permission to this Court to forward them money as a discount on their salaries due to them. We would, if the answer is in the affirmative, appreciate the information regarding the procedure in the sending of this money.

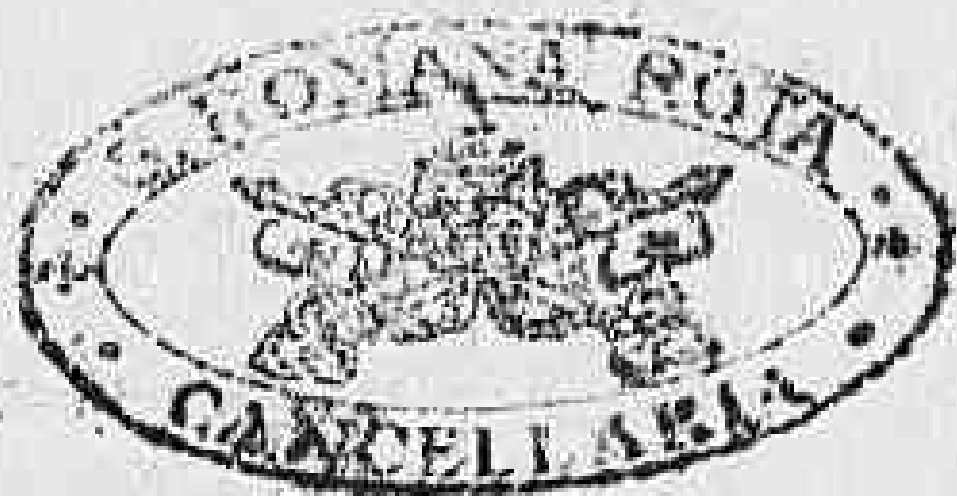
