1. Ref your 20004/4/MFAA of 31 Jan 46, this Division has been informed by GHQ CMF that diligent investigation has failed to reveal any trace of subject as being held by the British authorities.

2. In the belief that TOTI might be a civilian internee, a further inquiry was addressed to UNRRA Italian Mission, which handles the repatriation of civilians. Their reply states they have no record of TOTI.

3. UNRRA Italian Mission suggests, however, that additional inquiries might be made of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

4. As TOTI is apparently a civilian, ~~however~~, and therefore a case which this Division properly should not have handled in the first place, it is suggested that you make any further inquiry you may desire as outlined in the preceding paragraph.

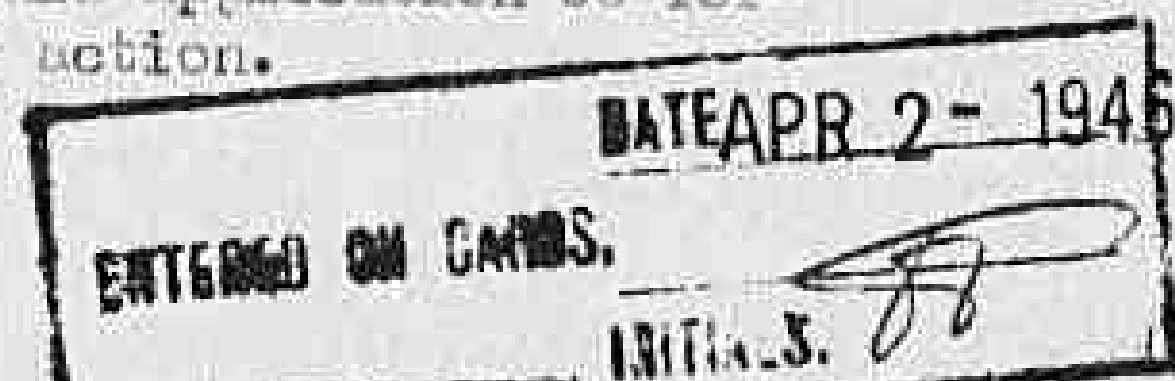

TO : Hq, AMG, 13 Corps, Welfare Division (Attention: Capt. KELLETT)

1. Ref. your ISC/AMG/WEL/18 of 30 Oct 45, it is regretted that this office has no forms of the type you desire.
2. As to the last paragraph of your letter, you are advised that the office of "Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War" no longer exists. Its functions have been taken over by the "Ministry of Post-War Assistance, PW Bureau."
3. You may, of course, submit applications for release or repatriation of Italian PWs directly to that office, or preferably, the interested Italians could send their requests directly there. This would avoid paper work by your office as well as by ours, since this Division acts as a liaison agency between the Italian Government and the Allied Governments.
4. After applications have been approved by the Italian authorities, they are transmitted to us for onward submission to the competent Allied agency - the Provost Marshal General, AFHQ (MPOUSA), in the case of Italian PWs in American hands, and C-1 (British), AFHQ, in the case of those held by the British.
5. The Compagnia Portuale "Gen. Odoardo Hueter" may, if it wishes, send its application directly to the Ministry of Post-War Assistance, PW Bureau, ROME, for consideration in case there should be an eventual change of policy with respect to specialist cases.

1. The Legal Sub-Commission, under date of 17 October 1945, (ref: AC/4083/23/L) has forwarded to this office a letter from the subject Italian PW for necessary action.
2. This letter was addressed to Legal Sub-Commission, AMG, Napoli, and it evidently seeks action by you on some previous letter or application made by the prisoner.
3. Since the documents, as submitted to this office by the Legal Sub-Commission, Hq. Allied Commission, do not contain the previous letter referred to, nor any accompanying or forwarding letter from your office, the entire file is referred back to you with the request that a search by your office be made for the original letter or request submitted by the PW.
4. From the documents submitted, it appears this PW is a deserter from the Italian Army, arrested 14 April 45 by Allied authorities and jailed at Cosenza 16 April, and since held there for Allied disposition. This may therefore be a Public Safety case.
5. For your information, this office is charged only with the cases of Italian prisoners of war taken before the Armistice of 8 September 1943, and not with those captured while serving or after having served with the Fascist Republican forces, or those interned or under detention for political reasons.
6. If CITRO Carmine di N.N. is a prisoner of war captured before 8 September 1943, and if you can trace his original letter, it is requested that such original letter and the file forwarded herewith be returned to this office for action.

ROME

The undersigned begs this Command to consent to the repatriation of POW;

2nd Lt. AQUILANO Ugo, born in 1922 no. 180602, Camp 25-Wing 3-Bombay.

He was a volunteer at 17 years old due to bad propaganda, went to Libya where he fought with honour and valour up to the 18th of Dec. 1941. Taken prisoner at Villaggio Berta near Tobruk, was taken to India and put in Camp 24.

Following the events that took place in Italy on the 8th of Sept. 1943, he was asked whether or not he intended to co-operate with the Allies, to which demand he answered no, not because he had a political faith to defend on the interests of a party to save, but because he considered it was a dishonest action of a soldier to abandon the cause for which he had fought and form the enemies camp.

On the other hand when he was asked to co-operate the Nazi Fascist were still in Rome and it can not be excluded that the lad was afraid to co-operate for fear that reprisals would be made on his family who at that time resided in Rome.

Now that the situation is cleared up and all danger of reprisals are over, the POW in question asks to be removed from the camp where he now is as it has the air of being a Political Concentration Camp, where he finds himself ill at ease.

The undersigned, his father, ask your Command not only to take him away from the camp in question, where there is not reason for him to be interned as he has no fascist precedents, but begs you to have him repatriated for family reasons.

The undersigned is one of the Italians whose interest are been badly damaged by the war. His house was completely destroyed at S. Lorenzo Nuovo (Viterbo) and his son-in-law-Lt. of the Air Corps was killed in action in 1941 in East Africa between Agordat and Cheren. All this sad events have seriously aggravated the health of his wife who has heart trouble and the undersigned in view of the disposals regarding compassionate cases, ask, for the repatriation of his son on those grounds. In more his son has need to take up his studies interrupted for many years after which he can be extremely useful in the national

1. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has been interested in obtaining some information on the present position of Major Roberto BRUNELLI, arrested at Ancona last August and detained in the Afragola concentration camp.

2. It is understood that Major BRUNELLI has been arrested as a war criminal for his activity in Montenegro in 1941.

4. As the reports on Major Brunelli's activities which have reached the Ministry of Foreign Affairs would not appear to substantiate such an accusation, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs would be very grateful if the Allied Commission could kindly furnish them with all possible information on the subject.

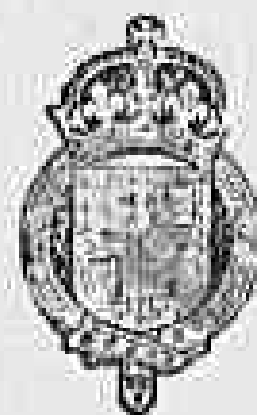

NOTE VERBALE

The British Embassy presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and has the honour to inform that the British Authorities in West Africa are anxious to obtain the services of a maximum of twelve Italian Prisoners of War who have been trained and are employed on the making of artificial limbs for wounded African soldiers.

1. It has been proposed that these men, on volunteering for this work, should be released from Prisoner of War status as civilians. If they were subsequently to fall out of work or to break any other condition which it was found necessary to impose, they could be retaken into custody, but their status would then be that of civil internees and no longer of Prisoners of War.

2. The British Embassy is informed that the Italian subjects in question are agreeable to the above conditions, provided that there is no objection on the part of the Italian Government.

3. In the ordinary course of events these men would become due for repatriation together with their fellow Prisoners of War, but since ^{such} repatriation would interrupt the useful work on which they are engaged it is requested that the Italian Government should release them from the Italian Army and agree to their remaining in West Africa for the duration of the contract envisaged.

4. The British Embassy would be grateful if the Ministry of Foreign Affairs could treat this matter as a communication of the views of the Italian Government to it at their earliest convenience.
