The Secretariat of State of His Holiness takes the liberty to request that you transmit to the competent Allied Authorities the petition of Sofia Di Croce, Nepezzano Varano (Teramo) for the liberation of her husband Fiorindo Di Croce, N.A.T. 35696, 211 POW, Algiers, Algeria.

Sofia Di Croce states that her husband, an Italian soldier, attempted to flee from the island of Rodi but was captured by the Germans and sentenced to forced labor. Now he is considered by the Allied Authorities as a collaborator with the Germans and is being held in the concentration camp at Algiers.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE ALLIED COMMISSION

Subject: Repatriation from Egypt of Italian p.o.w. Italo GRASSI.

1. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs warmly recommends to the competent Allied Authorities the case of Lt. Italo GRASSI, Italian prisoner of war, now interned in Egypt (n. 325006; camp n. 304, c/o Chief P.O.W. Postal Centre MEF, Egypt), for early repatriation.

2. Lt. Grasse's presence in Italy is earnestly requested by the "Istituto Previdenza Sociale", Via Marco Minichetti, Rome, to the staff of which he has belonged for several years. Furthermore family reasons make his repatriation as particularly urgent.

3. It would be much appreciated if Lt. Grasse's case could be favourably examined by the competent Allied Authorities.

4. An early note of assurance will be greatly appreciated; in the meantime this Ministry will submit to the Allied Commission a document on the subject, as soon as received from the Istituto Previdenza Sociale.

SUBJECT: Request for repatriation of TOTI Vittorio

TO : UNRRA Italian Mission, Via Umbria, ROME
(Civilian Repatriation Office)

1. This Division has received a request from the Sub-Commission for Monuments, Fine Arts and Archives, Allied Commission, recommending favorable consideration for the repatriation of TOTI Vittorio.

2. The Sub-Commission states that its request is based upon a similar one from the Direction General of Antiquities and Fine Arts, Ministry of Public Instruction.

3. TOTI was a skilled artisan in the R. Opificio delle Pietre Dure of FLORENCE. He was sent temporarily to assist the Superintendent of Antiquities at RHODES in May 1938, and was blocked there by the war.

4. It is stated that TOTI's services are badly needed by the Director of the Opificio, which is having to undertake a greatly increased program despite shortage of competent personnel.

5. This Division has no previous correspondence concerning TOTI, and AFHQ advises that he is NOT a prisoner of war. It is probable, therefore, that TOTI went to RHODES as a civilian and was detained as a civilian.

6. May we be advised, please, whether he is registered as a civilian internee or detainee in your files, and if so, may the necessary action be taken to effect his repatriation, and this Division advised?

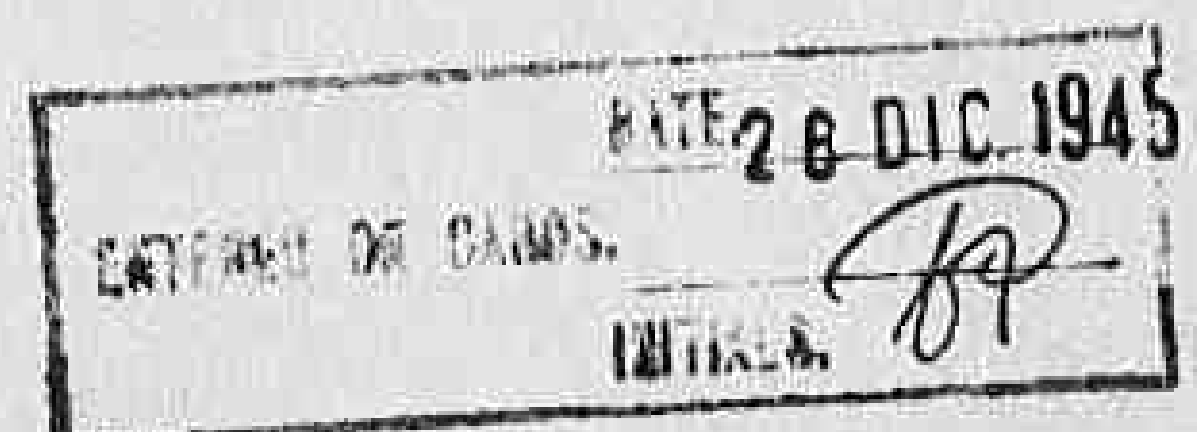

I as mother of the POW 2nd Lt. Cesare Galiena, No 373609 - Camp 304 Egypt, wish to appeal to you that my son be allowed to return home, and am giving you the details of what has been done so far with this aim.

Since last February the Institute "Le Assicurazioni d' Italia", 14 Via San Basilio, Rome, where my son was employed, sent in a request through the Ministry of Industry, Commerce & Agriculture for the return of this POW to take up his post again.

The procedure was carried out by the Ministry, and after submitting the request to the Cabinet and all required control effected, his name was included in List No 6 and transmitted to the High Commissariat for the POWs.

On May 30th last the High Commissariat sent in these papers to the Allied Military Command of Rome who forwarded them to Headquarters at Caserta. Nothing has been known so far on the issue.

As I am seriously ill I venture to appeal to you that my son be allowed to return home as soon as possible so that I may see him still during my life. The A. C. authorities can control the gravity of my health. I do not believe that I am asking for anything absolutely contrary to regulations but perhaps my son might be allowed to return home a little sooner if my appeal were accepted.

I faithfully trust that it will not be in vain, and I beg to be pardoned if I have ventured to make it with the only justification of the serious conditions of my health.

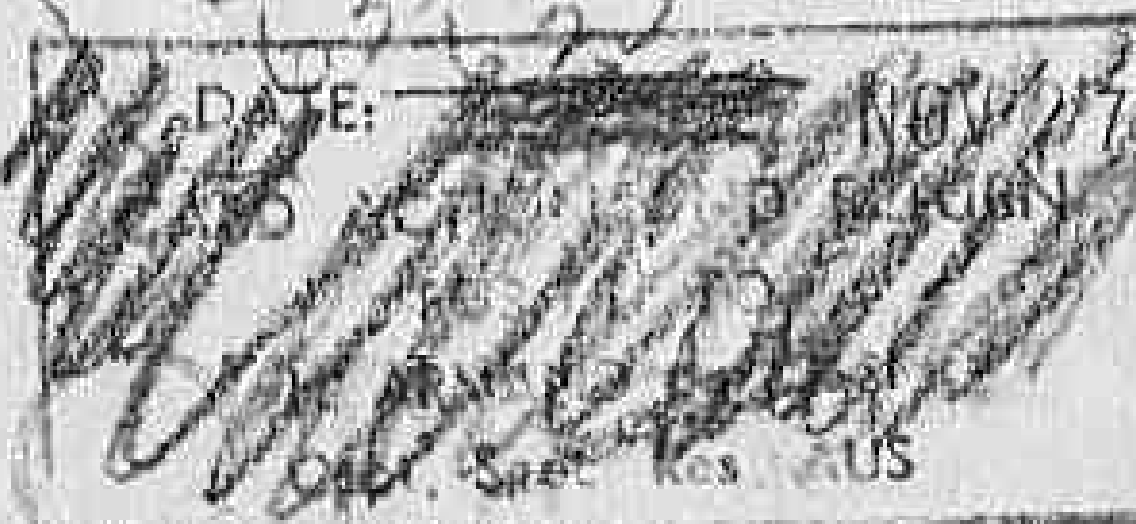

1. Ref. your 28/118/45 of 14 Nov 45, you are advised that latest information we have on subject PW was received from GHQ, CMF, under date of 6 Nov 45, stating that GHQ, INDIA, had cabled that Lt. OTTAVIANI was still at Delhi due to non-availability of shipping.

2. According to our files, the last communication to you in this case was dated 11 Jan 45 (our ref. 1/1A/482A), advising you that the matter had been taken up "again" with the Italian High Commissioner, a previous letter (our ref. 1/1A/148 of 27 Sept. 44) advising that the matter had been referred to IHC.

3. However, I find no correspondence on this subject either to or from IHC up to January, 1945, although, of course, the matter may have been taken up by telephone or in person, and also there is a possibility that through clerical errors the filing of such correspondence may not have been done.

4. Under date of 6 Jan 45, this office received a letter from IHC forwarding a request from the suprema Sacra Congregazione and the Sacra Romana Rota for Ottaviani's repatriation, and on 14 Jan 45 this was forwarded, together with recommendation for repatriation, to G-1 (British), AFHQ. On 9 Feb 45, AFHQ forwarded to INDIA the request for his release.

5. On 9 Apr 45, Allied Screening Commission requested latest developments, and on 1 May 45, this office sent a further strong recommendation to AFHQ for Ottaviani, followed by a cable on 26 June 45. 4587

6. Following another letter from the Screening Commission dated 22 Oct 45, we sent a new urgent plea to G-1 (British) on 27 Oct 45, to which, on 31 Oct 45, GHQ, CMF, replied as follows:

"As requested in your letter IPW/1/11/391 of 14 Jan (45), wherein OTTAVIANI was described as being required by the Supreme Court of Justice, INDIA was asked to release this P.W. on 9 Feb. 2209

"It will be noted that the governing factor in assessing the request was the need for the P.W. services and not the

-- not the influence or status of the Italian making the request. In view of the then acute shortage of legal personnel in Italy, INDIA was asked to effect repatriation.

"Expedites were sent to India on 5 May and 28 June. INDIA replied on 19 July that every effort was being made to repatriate OTTAVIANI. A further reminder, copy attached, has now been dispatched to INDIA Command, which it is pointed out is not under AFHQ control.

"It is noted that it is now stated that OTTAVIANI is not required to fill a legal position but as a private secretary to a Prelate. It is also noted that it is now considered that he should be repatriated by air.

"With the present transportation difficulties in the repatriation of British and US military personnel, this Headquarters is not prepared to recommend air priority travel for an Italian Prisoner of War."

7. The foregoing gives you a complete summarized history of the efforts made to repatriate Lt. Ottaviani. It is pointed out that all our efforts to effect repatriations from India are met with the same reply, regardless of the importance of the person to be repatriated or of the one or ones making the original request, and that reply has always been: "when shipping is available."

8. As stated in paragraph 1 above, latest word regarding Ottaviani (dated 6 Nov and received by us 9 Nov 45) was that he is still at Delhi "delayed by the non-availability of shipping."

Dear Colonel,

I refer to your letter D/O LPW/1/1A/148 of 27th September of last year, on the subject of Second Lieutenant Renato Ottaviani No. 16787, Camp 27, Bombay. This Italian Officer has been a prisoner since January 1941. I understand that the case for his repatriation was referred to the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War, by your sub-Commission as long ago as September 1944.

Colonel Campbell also informed me that he would let me know in due course what action had been taken. So far I have received no further communication on the subject, and I should be very grateful if the case could be submitted again to the High Commissioner, and for anything that you may be able to do to expedite this officer's repatriation.

I am the more anxious to do so as Monsignor Ottaviani, his uncle, was one of our warmest supporters in Vatican circles during the war. I have been trying for over two years to get his nephew released, but without any success hitherto.

1. As requested in your letter IPW/1/11/391 of 14 Jan, wherein OTTAVIANI was described as being required by the Supreme Court of Justice, INDIA was asked to release this P.W. on 9 Feb. (Our letter CR/3836/G1(Br) to INDIA, copy to IPW Commission refers).
2. It will be noted that the governing factor in assessing the request was the need for the P.W. Services and not the influence or status of the Italian making the request. In view of the then acute shortage of legal personnel in ITALY, INDIA was asked to effect repatriation.
3. Expedites were sent to INDIA on 5 May and 26 June. INDIA replied on 19 July that every effort was being made to repatriate OTTAVIANI. A further reminder, copy attached, has now been dispatched to INDIA Command, which it is pointed out is not under AFHQ control.
4. It is noted that it is now stated that OTTAVIANI is not required to fill a legal position but as a private secretary to a Prelate. It is also noted that it is now considered that he should be repatriated by air.
5. With the present transportation difficulties in the repatriation of British and US military personnel, this Headquarters is not prepared to recommend air priority travel for an Italian Prisoner of War.

Considering that the undersigned was persecuted for six years, he asks the ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT that-for justice and humanity's sake- his ONLY son ALBERT, 30 years old, sergeant and war prisoner in Egypt since the 5th of November 1942 and without his news since the 11th August 1944, could be allowed to return to his native country as soon as possible.

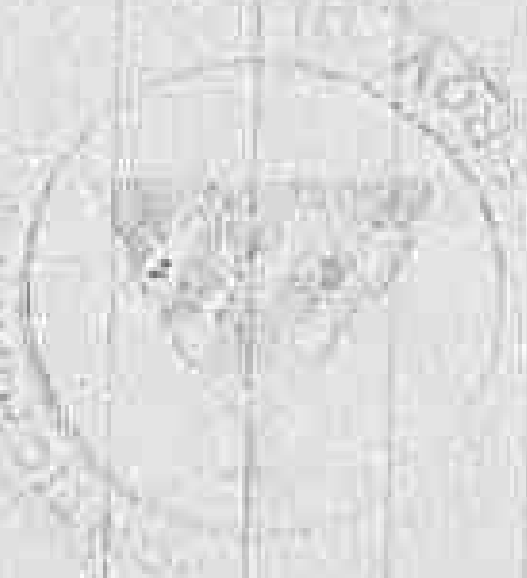

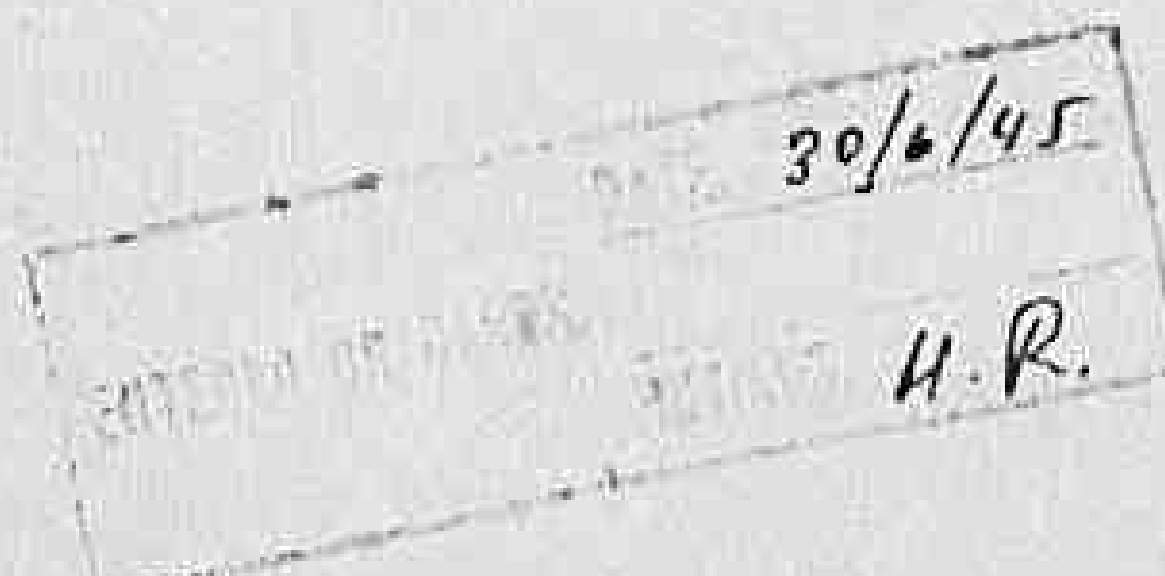

He was captured at Agrigento on July 1943 in a prompt assistance-post in the Catacumbe of Porta Aurea in the sides of Agrigento. He was brought Algeria.

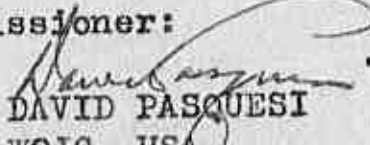

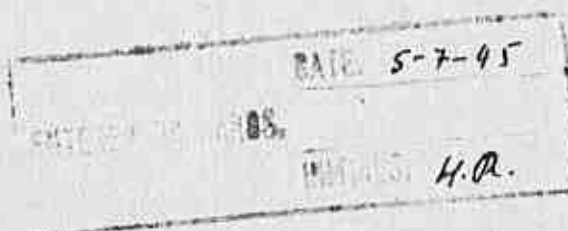
