3. The other 18 PWs for whom no previous request for repatriation had been made by this Division, also present in most cases compassionate reasons.

4. If there are no security objections, it would be appreciated if the various commands concerned could be asked to expedite the repatriation of the above-listed PWs.



2. GHQ, CMF, quotes AFHQ letter G-5, 383.6 of 11 Oct 45, as the reason for returning List 14-B, and Hq, PBS, quotes letter AG 383.6 PMG-0 of AFHQ, dated 10 Oct 45.
3. AFHQ G-5's letter of 11 Oct 45 states: "Application made prior to 27 Sept 45 for the release of Italian Prisoners of War with specialist qualifications will be considered by this Headquarters."
4. This letter does not state that applications had to reach either of the responsible British or American commands prior to 27 Sept 45.
5. The lists were sent to this Division by the Ministry of Post-War Assistance under date of 25 Sept 45, but, because of their volume - the British list containing 1638 names and the American list 419 names - they could not possibly be processed out of our office in time to reach G1(Br) or the PMG by or before 27 Sept 45.
6. The work entailed in this Division by the lists in question, as with all previous lists, included the preparation of individual card indexes for each one of the grand total of 2057 names involved, and a considerable amount of checking up to avoid duplications.
7. Attention also is invited to the fact that AFHQ G-5's letter stating that applications made prior to 27 Sept 45 would be considered, was dated 11 Oct 45 - two weeks after the time limit for applications, which in itself indicates that if the applications were filed prior to 27 Sept 45, they would be considered. These applications were submitted by the Ministry of Post-War Assistance two days prior to that limit.



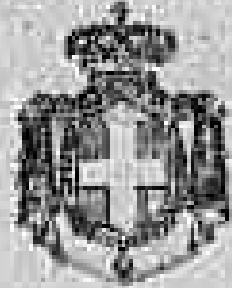

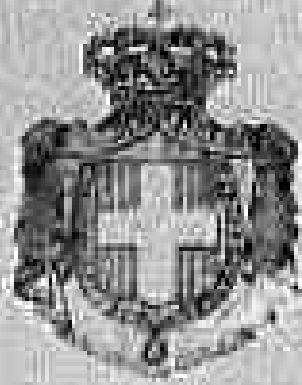

2. This information comes from Lt. Col. GRANDE of the Italian General Staff.

3. Following FAA DI BRUNO's transfer by us on 23 June 45, to the Distretto Militare, ROME, the subject PW was subsequently, on 19 Aug 45, transferred to the Reparto Autonomo, Information Office, General Staff, Italian Army, and on 20 Aug 45, to the Reparto Autonomo Ministeriale, Caserma Macao, ROME, on which latter date he was also sent on to his present assignment.

1. Ref. your 3899/A2 of 23 Oct 45 and our 1/11/1837 of 7 Sept 45, regarding the irregular repatriation of Italian PW 259989 Ten. FAA DI BRUNO (NOT FARDIBRUNO) Antonio from India, inquiries have been made of the Italian authorities as to the present whereabouts of this PW, and as to whether he is being employed by the Italian Government.
2. As soon as available, this information will be forwarded to you.
3. In the meantime, it is desired to point out that, so far as our records showed at the time of receipt of your communication, the subject PW was still supposed to be detained at 209 PW Camp, Afragola (Naples).
4. Your G-1(Br)/3899/A2 of 18 June 45, addressed to Commandant, 209 PW Camp, states (para. 3): "No authority has yet been traced for the release of ARANGIO and FARDIBRUNO and enquiries are now being made in INDIA and MIDEAST regarding these two PW. Will you please hold these men until disposal instructions are received from this Headquarters."
5. Also your signal PX-92169 of 12 June 45 to 56 Area says: "Hold PW until authority for release received from this Headquarters."
6. However, in a footnote to this office on your even ref. to C.-in-C. MEF, of 12 Aug 45, it appears the Italian Repatriation Center at Vomero (Naples) advised 209 Camp on 13 June 45 that they were expecting these two officers, and that we, by telephone to you on 19 June and NMIA by telephone on 20 June, asked that they be sent to us.
7. This office, though, has no record of any authority by you releasing these PW from 209 Camp, except, in the case of ARANGIO RUIZ, of your GR/3835/1/61(Br) dated 13 Nov 44 to C.in-C. INDIA, recommending the latter's repatriation.
8. In view of this situation, this office, on 2 Nov 45, sent an urgent signal to 209 Camp, asking if the PW FAA DI BRUNO was still there, and if not, when, to whom and on what authority he was released.

9. No reply being received, a second signal requesting action was sent on 6 Nov 45, to which 209 Camp signaled back that the original signal was not received.

10. On 7 Nov 45 our original message was therefore repeated, to which 209 Camp on 8 Nov replied that FAA DI BRUNO was transferred to us on 22 June 45 under authority AFHQ/GI(Br)/3899/A2 dated 18 June 45.

11. This reference is the identical one mentioned in paragraph 4 above, which specifically requested that the subject PW be held at 209 Camp until disposal instructions were received from your Headquarters.

12. Paragraph 2 of that ref. states: "The 30 officers shown on the 304 PW Camp Middle East Forces Nominal Roll Part III of AF W.5169 dated 7 Jun 45 should be despatched to Headquarters, Allied Commission, IPW Sub-Commission, ROME," etc.

13. However, on 22 June 45, the 209 Camp sent to us this note, along with the prisoners: "THIRTY-TWO Italian Officers as per attached Nominal Roll are today being despatched to you under AFHQ Authority G-1(Br)/3899/A-2 dated 18 JUNE 45."

14. Lt. Michael TOR of this office, penned across the bottom of this note: "Received 32 IPW officers, 23/6/45. WMD & IPW S/C (signed) M. TOR, 1st Lt., AC."

15. From the foregoing, it appears that 209 Camp forwarded all of the PWs on the Nominal Roll, including FAA DI BRUNO, and not just thirty (30) as specified in the referred authority.

16. All of these prisoners were turned over by this office to the Distretto Militare, Rome.

17. As soon as received, as stated in para. 2 above, information regarding FAA DI BRUNO's present whereabouts and employment will be forwarded.

3. With respect to Paternostro, you are advised that Italian prisoners of war held in the United States are constantly being returned in great numbers on all possible available shipping. In view of this, it is not considerably practical nor advisable at this time to put forward a request for the repatriation of any individual PW, as he may be already on the way here.



1. Continually increasing demands are being submitted by Allied Commission, ROME for the release from Commands in all parts of the British Empire of Italian PW who are alleged to be urgently needed for the rehabilitation of ITALY.
2. Up to the present it has been the policy to release such PW provided that they are required to fill a post calling for specialist qualifications and that they have been screened secure.
3. With the conclusion of the war and the repatriation to ITALY by overland route of some 400,000 Italians ex-GERMANY however, it is considered that there is very little justification for the majority of these requests and it is thought that the shipping space which these Italians would occupy might well be put to better use.
4. It is suggested that the time has come to inform the Italian Government that except in medical or in extreme compassionate cases no further Italians will be repatriated by sea routes prior to the general return of all Italian PW to ITALY.
5. The British Resident Minister fully concurs in the view set out above.
6. If you agree, it is suggested that either
  - (a) this matter should form the subject of a paper for consideration of SAC at the next possible political meeting or
  - (b) Allied Commission be instructed to notify the Italian Government of the change of policy.

In the Allied Camp No.12 for prisoners of war at Casenatico ( Forli' ) are held several thousands Italian troops, who were in September 1943 captured by the Germans in the Balkans, later handed over to the Yugoslav partisans and finally taken in custody by the Allies.

It seems that among them there are also members of our Corps: untill now only two Carabinieri, Berzanti Guido and Borgna Francesco, have been identified although it has not been possible to talk with them as the Camp C.O. did not allow it. They are being treated as prisoners of war.

The Supreme Command of the prisoners of War at Riccione has informed me that the anticipate release of our personnel will start only when and if requested by this General Command.

Therefore I beg you to examine the opportunity of forwarding such a request and to let me know to whom I shall apply for the release of the members of our Corps.

Meanwhile I am already trying to obtain a quick release of the above mentioned Carabinieri.




