To: The Allied Force Headquarters

I, the undersigned, Ester Buffone, daughter of Giovanni, born on 22 December 1902 at Brooklyn (New York), am applying to your Command in the hope that you will take into consideration the following:

My fiance Wolfgang Ableiter, No 762/6A is presently being held as a P.O.W. at the 370th P.O.W. Camp C.M.F. located at Rimini. Because of his imprisonment I am spending the most lonely and sorrowful days which have caused on me a serious nervous breakdown.

My fiance being my only material support I am presently living in the most dire conditions and my situation is heavily bearing on my health conditions. Some time ago the partisans, taking advantage from my loneliness, pillaged all my property. In 1944 and in 1945 a brother of mine, an American citizen, fought with the U.S. Army in the French and Belgian campaigns though I never had any connections with politics, I am enduring the most severe hardships now.

My fiance has always behaved like a perfect gentleman. He was an honest worker and he never gave any annoyance to anybody. Nobody more than myself knows his goodness, politeness and generosity. He cannot be charged with any offense; his only guilt was that of having fought for his country and of having faithfully served it. Please, I beg you to take into consideration my situation and to urge his release.

Please, let me have an evidence of your humanity and justice, by releasing him or at least by granting him a 20 days leave, so that I may see him once again. I assure you that he will return to the Concentration-camp upon the expiration of his furlough.

My critical health conditions did not permit me to make a trip to Rimini. Herewith inclosed is a medical certificate proving my present health-conditions.

In the hope that you will take into benevolent consideration my request, I thank you in advance. Accept my best regards.

In the above mentioned camp there is held as a prisoner, the u/m prisoner of war born in the Province of Bolzano. He was obliged to enroll in the German Army by the Nazi authorities when they occupied said province. His compulsory service was based upon his belonging to the ethnical minority speaking the German tongue.

TAPPNER John of John and Magdalen Kaufmann, born in Lasa on the 31st of December, 1912, peasant, a resident therein.

An accurate investigation has been made as to the moral and political status of the same both as a civilian and as a soldier. Nothing has been found against him to justify his being further detained as a prisoner of war.

The Italian authorities realize that the enrollment of the German minority amongst the Alto Atesini had been declared compulsory by the Nazi Authorities who had taken possession of the Province after the armistice of the 8th of September 1943.

Each single case has been examined and where, as in the case of the a/m, nothing appears against him politically, it is deemed advisable to suggest their being allowed to return to civil life and that they be sent back to their families. This point of view appears advisable in order also to further the good feeling amongst the two distinct ethnical groups of the Alto Adige and thus bring about a better understanding and co-operation in a democratic and brotherly spirit.

We, therefore, beg the Officer Commanding to take into kind consideration the particular situation of the above prisoner and grant his release.

Dear Mr. Congressman:

I am approaching you with a special problem. Recently I received a letter from the wife of a good friend I have in Germany. She tells me her husband had been in the German army and that she has had no word from him since April 1945. He was then stationed in Italy. Apparently then he was living as late as April last year just before hostilities ended. Not having heard from him since his wife, of course, is greatly puzzled fearing that something might have happened to him in the last days of fighting or whatever it may be.

I have been wondering, therefore, whether you could place me in contact with our proper military authorities or such officials who would have charge of records of enemy military personnel.

What I would like to know is whether the man in question is on any record of either the American or British or Russian authorities as having been either killed, captured or otherwise listed as missing. Of course, in the confusion of the closing weeks or days of hostilities undoubtedly many a man was lost in some way so that no record may ever be available of the person. If prisoners of war are still being held in Italy under what government are they being held? Were any prisoners of war (German) taken in Italy at any time transferred to other countries? These, of course, are questions which may have a bearing on the matter.

In case it would expedite matters regarding my question and the information which I would like to have, I am giving you herewith the name and pre-war address of the man in question:

Ludwig Merkel
Giesestrasse 36
Hamburg (Grossflottbek), Germany

I know, of course, nothing about his military connections as to regiment or division or the like.

I have known this man for almost 40 years from 1453
early boyhood. Since hostilities have ended and humanitarian consideration may again prevail I would very much like to find out something definite about Merkel as it would be a satisfaction to his wife and children as well as to me personally.

I regret to bother you with this now that the Congress has recessed, but I was sure that you could more readily place me in touch with the proper authorities or persons informed in such matters as I have taken the liberty to present.
