If you agree please pass following to Italian Foreign Minister from Italian Legation here as follows

"ref previous communications about repatriation of Italian military internees. 2 NGOs returning from SEDZEK (WHITE RUSSIA) report a group of internees sent from ROUMANIA has arrived there and await transport. Though Russian attitude friendly living conditions are not very good and it is advisable to effect repatriation before cold season begins. It is reported there are many thousands of Italians soldiers and civilians in SEDZEK and there are also Italian Army units wearing Russian uniforms and Italian badges."

Subject: Italians living in Romania.

To : Col. Campbell - Head of PW and War Material
Sub-Commission - ROME

We have been informed that the Russian authorities intend to deport the numerous Italian soldiers and civilians, who are at present in Rumania.

I deem it necessary that such measure should not be realised because it has never been possible to get any informations from the PW in Russian hands.

I beg you therefore to take an interest in the fate of the Italians in Rumania and to do everything possible in order to get them repatriated by sea, in the same way as has been arranged for the Italians in Greece.
