Subject: Italians living in Rumania.To : Col. Campbell - Head of PW and War Material
Sub-Commission - ROME

We have been informed that the Russian authorities intend to deport the numerous Italian soldiers and civilians, who are at present in Rumania.

I deem it necessary that such measure should not be realised because it has never been possible to get any informations from the PW in Russian hands.

I beg you therefore to take an interest in the fate of the Italians in Rumania and to do everything possible in order to get them repatriated by sea, in the same way as has been arranged for the Italians in Greece.
