SUBJECT: It.P.O.W's held by rebels in Africa.

An officer recently repatriated has informed us of the existence in Ethiopia at Tukul d'Inghia (Gondar), of a head of a rebel tribe, who has rebelled against all the Authorities and all belligerent parties, and is holding in slavery 8 It.soldiers and two Italian Officers.

One of these officers is Liut. DE PAOLIS Luigi.

We would be very grateful if the Allied Commission will take interest in these unfortunate men, with the aim of having them transferred to British Custody, if not possible to obtain their repatriation.
