TO : G.H.Q. 2nd Echelon C.M.F.

1. This office receives repeated inquiries from families of Italian PW quatin instances in which no word from the PW has been received by relatives from months. Because often as much as six months or a year has elapsed since news was last received, these families repeatedly write to the "Ministero di Assistenza Post-Bellica" and to every possible Allied Agency asking for information about the PW.

2. To avoid having several Headquarters working on each case, this office is, with the consent of Allied Force Headquarters, writing directly to your office (Attention: Italian Prisoners of War Section) asking that you forward a letter in each case to the PW, and that you obtain a receipt from him. Letters with attached receipts are enclosed. The receipt will then be returned to the family, assuring that he is alive, thus discontinuing the flow of excited correspondence in regard to the prisoner's existence. The problem of his not corresponding in future then becomes a personal one instead of a matter for official attention.

1. This office receives repeated inquiries from families of Italian PW-instances in which no word from the PW has been received by relatives for months. Because often as much as six months or a year has elapsed since news was last received, these families repeatedly write to the "Ministero per l'Assistenza Post-Bellica" and to every possible Allied Agency asking for information about the PW.

2. To avoid having several Headquarters working on each case, this office is, with the consent of Allied Force Headquarters, writing directly to your office (Attention: Italian Prisoners of War Section) asking that you forward a letter in each case to the PW, and that you obtain a receipt from him. Letters with attached receipts are enclosed. The receipt will then be returned to the family, assuring that he is alive, thus discontinuing the flow of excited correspondence in regard to the prisoner's existence. The problem of his not corresponding in future then becomes a personal one instead of a matter for official attention.

2. To avoid having several Headquarters working on each case, this office is, with the consent of Allied Force Headquarters, writing directly to your office (Attention: Italian Prisoners of War Section) asking that you forward a letter in each case to the PW, and that you obtain a receipt from him. Letters with attached receipts are enclosed. The receipt will then be returned to the family, assuring that he is alive, thus discontinuing the flow of excited correspondence in regard to the prisoner's existence. The problem of his not corresponding in future then becomes a personal one instead of a matter for official attention.

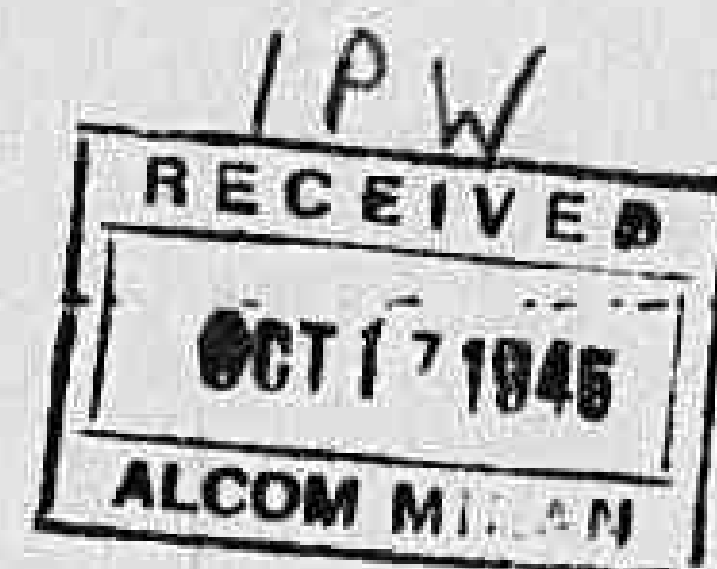
