SUBJECT : War Veterans and repatriated POW of Venezia Giulia.

Following the authorized institution in the district of Trieste, Gorizia and Pola, and the disposals given to the Lodging Center at Treviso regarding the treatment to be used for the War Veterans, who are being sent to their place of residence, will receive their complete administrative liquidation of all sums owed to them during their imprisonment or internment and any help regarding clothes or various other assistance, that is possible to furnish them with on the basis of the present situation in Italy.

There is now in existence a large quote of Veterans from those Regions, who having passed the frontier before these ruling, have arrived at their place of residence without having received what was due to them.

This office understands the difficulty of providing for those Veterans who reside in the East of the Morgan Line, but it is thought that a possible remedy may be found to correct this deficiency relative to those Veterans who reside in the cities of Gorizia, Trieste and Pola that are on the West of the demarcation line.

We therefore present this matter to your Sub Commission and beg you to consider with benevolent attention the prospect of establishing in these three cities, Gorizia, Trieste and Pola, an "Liquidation Office" for those who return as War Veterans or from internment, that could be directed by a superior officer and an Administrative officer

Said offices, will proceed in the recognition of the Veterans and their status according to documents furnished by the Civil Authorities, which will enable them to proceed rapidly in the organization of the matriculation and administrative work relative to the Veterans of the respective Regions.

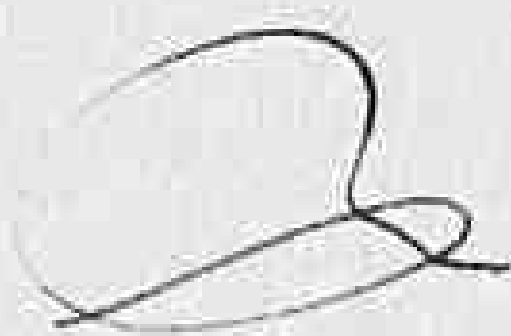
