SUBJECT: Establishment of the Autonomous Office for War Veterans and Repatriated PW.

There has been established in this Ministry the Autonomous Office for War Veterans and repatriated PW.

THE OFFICE:

- is directed by a General of the R. Army who has the right of signing all ordinary correspondence.
- it functions with military and civil personnel taken by the personnel assigned and to be assigned to the Ministry.

FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE:

- General matters and all that concern the organization of reception of War Veterans and repatriated PW, communicates with the Allied Authorities and the High Commissioner for PW and other related Italian Authorities.
- Inform the interested offices each time a party of prisoners arrives.
- Organize the reception at ports and reception centers of PW coming back, and send them to sanitary and logistic units already prepared (Rest and convalescence camps, Hospitals, Convalescence Homes, equipments, etc.)
- Forwarding of War veterans and repatriated PW (on leave) to military units (for those who must serve in the Army) and maintain contact with with civil organization (for retired personnel) through the High Commissioner for Refugees and Ministries eventually interested.
- Clarify the legal status of repatriated PW, with the Ministry of War (collaborators, ex-cobelligerents, prisoners and liberated upon their word, Italian republican soldiers taken prisoners by the Allies, marriages of PW with foreign women, etc.)
- To treat with administrative matter concerning conjunction with the proper administrative office of the repatriated PW.
- The administrative matter of general and legal character concerning expense incurred by this office.
