Comments after informal discussion with Italian authorities have been requested.

Your comments after such informal discussion requested soonest possible with view to agreeing immediate repatriation and subsequent disposition to and by Italian Govt.

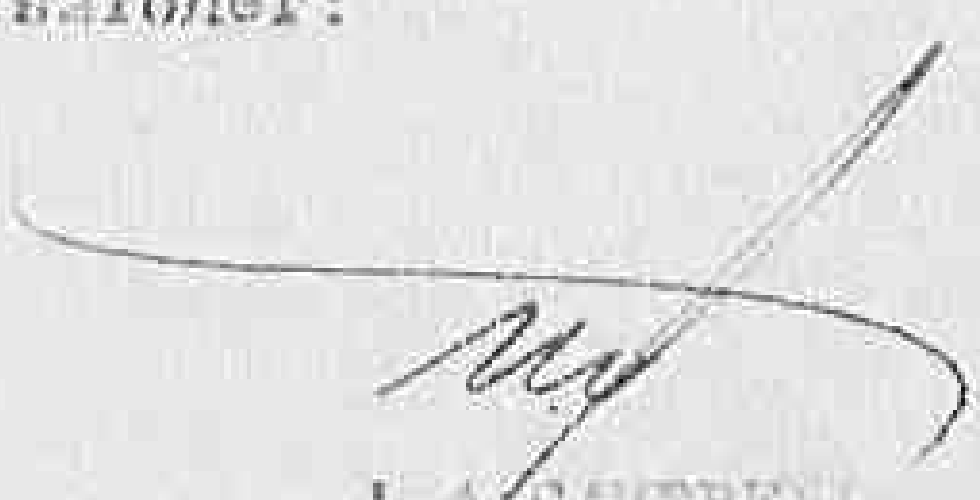

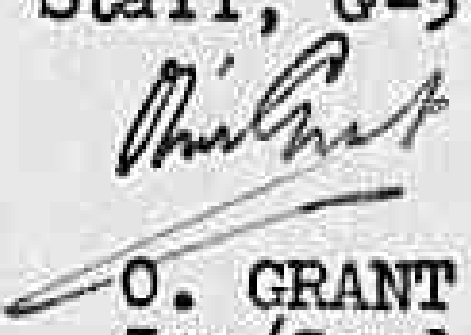

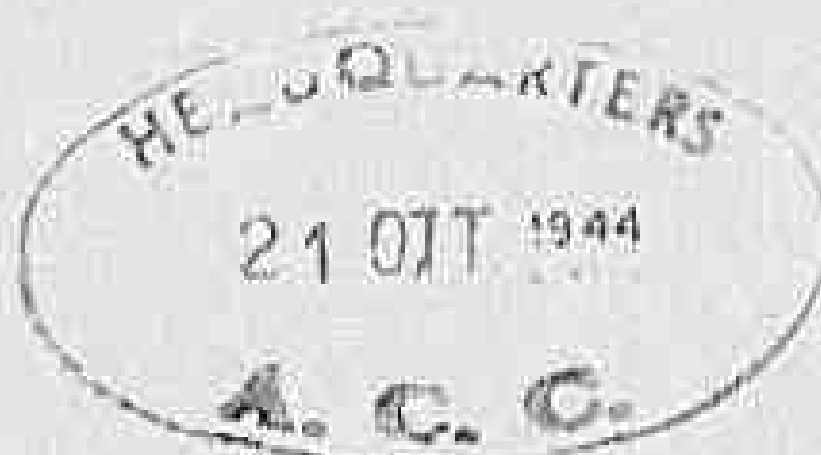
