- 1/. Further to letter 11/15/76 dated 8 Oct 76, copy attached.
- 2/. On 4 Oct 76 a cable was received in the Division from the Italian Government concerning the arrival of a ship from the Italian Government. This information was received on 29 September with 741 Italian on board. This information was passed to the Italian Government who informed us that the ship had docked at Genoa on 5 October.

- 3/. It is not possible for this Division to function efficiently with the type of information being received at present. The maximum number of arrivals at ports should be given, and a minimum of 48 hrs working is imperative in order that accommodation may be arranged. Information received should contain:

- a) Port of arrival
- b) Estimated time of arrival
- c) Number of live on board
- d) From what country

- 4/. Accommodation for the reception of requisitioned live is not available at all ports. Therefore when this Division is notified of the port of arrival the ship must not be diverted to other ports without sufficient notice being given.
- 5/. Any steps taken to ensure that, in future, correct information is sent in sufficient time for necessary action to be taken.

2/. On 4 Oct 65 a cable was received in 123 Division from the Italian Base Section Commission informing that "... the ship had called for help on 29 September with 701 Italians on board. This information was passed to the Italian Government who informed us that ... Italian 123 had located it ... on 5 October.

3/. It is not possible for this Division to function efficiently with the type of information being received at present. The minimum number of arrivals at ports should be given, and a minimum of 40 hrs working is imperative in order that accommodation may be arranged. Information received should contain:

- a) Port of arrival
- b) Estimated time of arrival
- c) Number of 123 on board
- d) Press that country

4/. Accommodation for the reception of repatriated 123 is not available at all ports. Therefore when this Division is notified of the port of arrival the ship must not be diverted to other ports without sufficient notice being given.

5/. Very much plans be taken to ensure that, in future, correct information is sent in sufficient time for necessary action to be taken.

- 1/. a) In the cable reference 01701 dated 13 Sept 45 the Division was notified that the ship "KORONA" was expected to arrive at Naples from LBA on or about 30 Sept 45, carrying 357 POWs.
b) No further news of the movement of this ship was received until a long distance call (thought to be from Ancona) to the Division. At 2 Oct 45 informed that the ship "KORONA" had arrived at Ancona and was en route for Venice.
c) Arrangements had been made by the Italian Government to receive these 357 POWs at Venice.
In accordance with the above for that in the Ancona Venice area.
The vessel "KORONA" was scheduled to arrive at Naples on 2 Oct 45. This vessel was scheduled at 10:00 AM, no indication of this change of destination was received by this Division.
Our letter 100/10/176 dated 2 Oct refers.
- 2/. a) At about 1300 hours on 3 Oct a telephone call was received from Capt. J. J. G., Transportation Officer, ANNA, informing us that 60 officers and 3500 men were due to arrive at Naples on the ship "KORONA" at 0730 hrs on 3 Oct 45.
b) Previous information of this ship was had been received.
c) As is known a serious shortage of tonnage exists in the area in Naples and Taranto port areas. This tonnage is supplied by the US Navy and the ANNA ship at Naples will need have accommodations for 10,000.

c) Arrangements had been made by the Italian Government to receive them 357 1/2 U.S. dollars at Naples.
No admission is available for them in the American version press.

2/. The vessel "Union No. 17" was ordered to arrive at Saigon on 11th Sept 47. This vessel is suspected at Saigon, to notification of this change of destination was received by this Division. Can letter 12/6/47 dated 2 Oct return.

3/. a) At about 1500 hours on 3 Oct a telephone call was received from Capt. AUGUST, Transportation Division, AFQ, informing us that 60 officers 1PW and 3008 OIA 1PW from USA were due to arrive at Hamlet on the ship "General Santos" at 0730 hrs on 5 Oct 48.

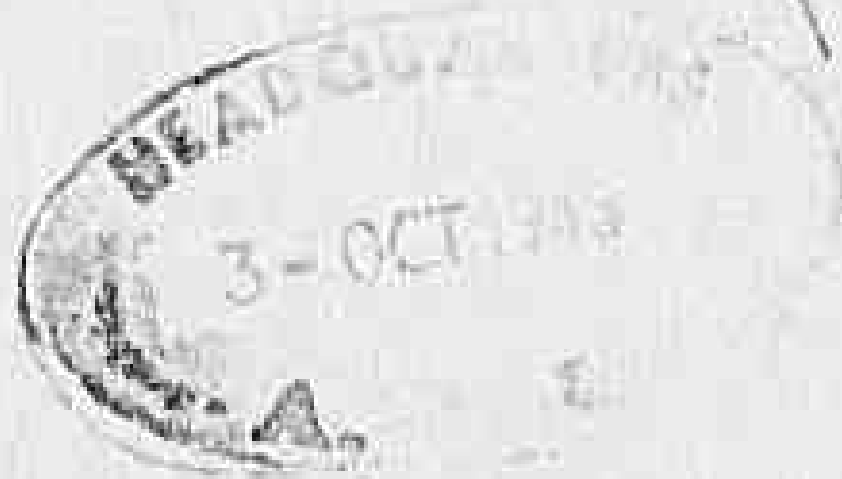

3. On 27 Sep. the vessel MERION HOWARD arrived at LEGHORN and disembarked the IPW at the port. No arrangements for accommodation and hospital had been made at this port.
4. IPW arriving through Northern ITALY and from EUROPE are normally sent to LEGHORN and FLORENCE areas for accommodation for this reason it will be seen that such confusion is caused by vessels from NORTH AFRICA arriving at LEGHORN.
5. May steps please be taken to avoid a recurrence of this mistake.

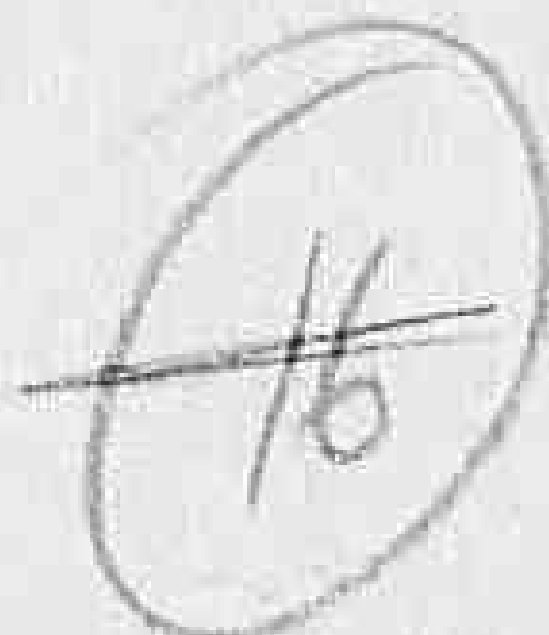

MEMORANDUM FOR THE ALLIED COMMISSION

Subject: Repatriation of Italian p.o.w., members of Service Units.

1. As the Allied Commission are aware, the British and U.S. Governments have decided, on principle, to grant priority in repatriation to those prisoners of war who have served in "cooperating" units, amongst which the Service Units employed in the rear echelons of the American Armies in France and Germany deserve particular consideration.

2. Consequent ~~to~~ the end of hostilities, the Italian Government do not believe that there are any reasons to further detain the aforesaid units as the tasks with which they were charged may now be carried out by German p.o.w.

3. It is also pointed out that while transport difficulties may justifiably delay the repatriation of Service Units deployed abroad, such difficulties do not appear to exist in the case of the aforesaid p.o.w., who have the possibility of returning to Italy by land.

4. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs will be very grateful if the Allied Commission will kindly interest the proper Authorities in the ques-
