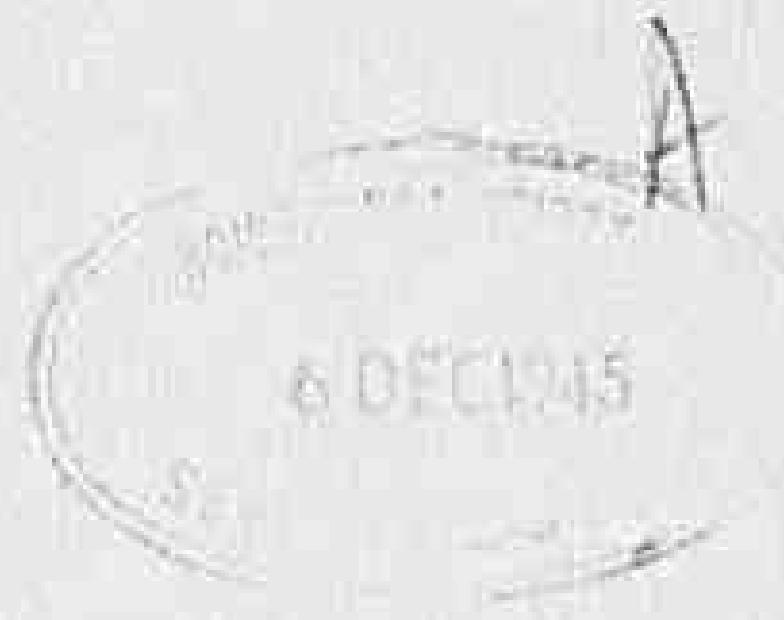

Prisoners will be processed and moved in accordance with the provisions of War Department Memorandum No. 580-45, 13 August 1945, subject: Procedure for Processing and Moving German and Italian Prisoners of War and Protected Personnel from United States to Oversea Destinations, with the following modifications:

- a. Paragraph 7d. Winter clothing only will be provided prisoners.
- b. Paragraph 7e. One (1) comforter may be substituted for two (2) blankets, wool, od.
- c. Paragraph 7m. Make final settlement of each prisoner's account as of the readiness date for the PW detachment by means of Military Payment Orders in accordance with Section IV, WD Circular 287, 20 September 1945.
- d. Paragraph 10j. Also air mail one (1) copy of passenger list to the Allied Commission, c/o APO 394, Rome, Italy.
- e. Paragraph 12f. Prisoners who do not possess a foot locker or suitcase are authorized one (1) extra barracks bag.

On the 30th of October the S.S. Kameronia arrived at Taranto with 550 officers and 3035 warrant officers and soldiers onboard, from Kenya and South Africa, who belonged to the 4th category, all men over 50 years of age.

The personnel in question on arriving at Suez were put in camps 304 and 310 on the canal.

Their baggage, composed of 9742 pieces was put on rail cars at Suez on the 24th of the month and filled 14 cars for the compressive weight of 75 tons.

The personnel left the camps on the 24th and the 25th and were put onboard the Kameronia the morning of the 25th and 26th. The ship sailed on the 27th without taking onboard the baggage. 140;

At Suez the only baggage put onboard was that of 400 very ill Veterans on the 26th. The greater part of the baggage left at Suez should all be sent to Taranto.

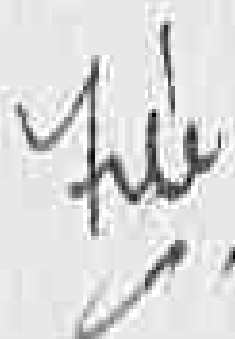
