Subject : Allotment of common soap containing 60-62% acid fats.

This Ministry instructs that, w.e.f. 1st November 45, no changes will be made in the allotments of :

-250 grammes of soap, per man, per month, to soldiers of the Italian Army, of all ranks, who are part of the authorised W.E., of whatever category and wherever they might be located;

-200 grammes of soap, per month, to all animals who are part of the authorised W.E.;

and that, to the said allotments, there will be added the following supplements:-

- a) Military Hospitals (on military rationing) : 200 grammes per month, for every bed space occupied;
- b) Auxiliary Camp hospitals : 60 Kilogrammes per hospital, per month;
- c) Medical Sections: 4 Kilogrammes per section, per month;
- d) Field Surgical units : 2 Kilogrammes per unit, per month;
- e) Medical officers on duty with medical establishments as described above, and also with troop units: 600 grammes per officer, per month;
- f) Veterinary officers : on duty with animal infirmaries, and also troop units: 600 grammes per officer, per month;
- g) Military personnel belonging to the following categories: Mechanics, drivers, cooks, stable-hands, ^{per man} on duty in the sorting of salvage materials or the distribution of rations, also to those whose duties lead to the accumulation of excessive personal dirt: 100 grammes, per man, per month.

Whenever there exists the availability, a piece of toilet soap weighing 100 grammes may be issued in lieu of a piece of common soap of equal weight.

and that, to the said allotments, there will be added the following supplements:-

- a) Military Hospitals (on military rationing) : 200 grammes per month, for every bed space occupied;
- b) Auxiliary Camp hospitals : 60 Kilogrammes per hospital, per month;
- c) Medical Sections: 4 Kilogrammes per section, per month;
- d) Field Surgical units : 2 Kilogrammes per unit, per month;
- e) Medical officers on duty with medical establishments as described above, and also with troop units: 600 grammes per officer, per month;
- f) Veterinary officers : on duty with animal infirmaries, and also troop units: 600 grammes per officer, per month;
- g) Military personnel belonging to the following categories: Mechanics, drivers, cooks, stable-hands, ^{personnel} on duty in the sorting of salvage materials or the distribution of rations, also to those whose duties lead to the accumulation of excessive personal dirt: 100 grammes, per man, per month.

Whenever there exists the availability, a piece of toilet soap weighing 100 grammes may be issued in lieu of a piece of common soap of equal weight.

The individual allotment of 250 grammes of soap will be distributed in its entirety, only to military who do their own washing; however, it will be reduced to 100 grammes for those personnel who make advantage of the laundry service provided.

Quantities to be assigned to the laundries must be measured, as follows:

- soap to the amount of 1% of the weight of the articles to be washed, if the employment of soap in the washing is necessary;

- 2% of the weight of above, if the washing is performed by hand only, at the laundries.

The soap will be supplied by the formations or units consigning the articles for washing; ~~xxx~~ it will be drawn from the quantities of cleaning materials drawn from the allotments to military personnel under command, or in the case of hospitals from the allotments made to patients.

It is still forbidden to distribute soap to personnel recalled or recruits for the very short periods which they spend with the districts or the formations which act as districts, and to which Circular No. 8566/S/1 dtd 21 April 45, refers.

No drawing of soap, on payment, is permitted.

The present instructions cancel all previous orders on the subject.

The H.Q.'s addressed above will take steps to make the contents of this circular known to all formations and units under command, or ~~however~~ however, located in their respective territories.

SUBJECT:- Unification of Soap Ration.

With effect from 1 Sept 45 the individual soap ration will be unified and established at 250 grams a month for all Italian troops included in the authorised War Establishment, whatever category and wherever located. Therefore, with effect from the above date, as a partial amendment to this Ministry's 4420/S/1 dated 20 Feb (subject "ration scales"), the 50 grams of soap will be withdrawn, which were given to the Combat Groups and troops to the North of the Allied Army Boundary. This troops will in future receive 250 grams per month.

Scales for medical units and personnel and for animals will remain as fixed in the above letter, as well as the general ruling concerning the use of the ration and the need for economy so as to be able to provide for the greater needs of military personnel working in kitchens or workshops etc, as established in 4420/S/1.

1. The soap ration has been established by the Ministry of War, in agreement with this HQ, at 250 grams per man per month which is considered adequate.
2. It is known that in the manufacture of soap there is a shrinkage; however, it has been our understanding that the provisions of Ministry of War contracts with civil factories is that the soap is not purchased until the soap is completely dried (normally a seven to ten day process).
3. It would appear from your letter that the soap when issued to troops, has not been dried. This does not appear to be consistent with the Ministry of War instructions to its respective Commissariats.

1. Soap for units of 231 Div is supplied through RASC channels to depots of Fifth Army British Increment along with other items of the Italian component of the ration.
2. ST Fifth Army Br. Iner. submitted a demand for 30,181 lbs of soap, which was handed over in full to 14 GRASC for onward transmission forward by 15 April. If 231 Division reported that soap was not being issued to units, ST Fifth Army Br. Iner. should have been requested to take action.
3. Distribution of soap, or any Italian components of the ration, is the responsibility of Fifth Army Br. Iner. to make in whatever manner desired. If 231 Div. desires to distribute soap for all units of Fifth Army Br. Iner., it is a decision for the latter HQ to make, and not this HQ.

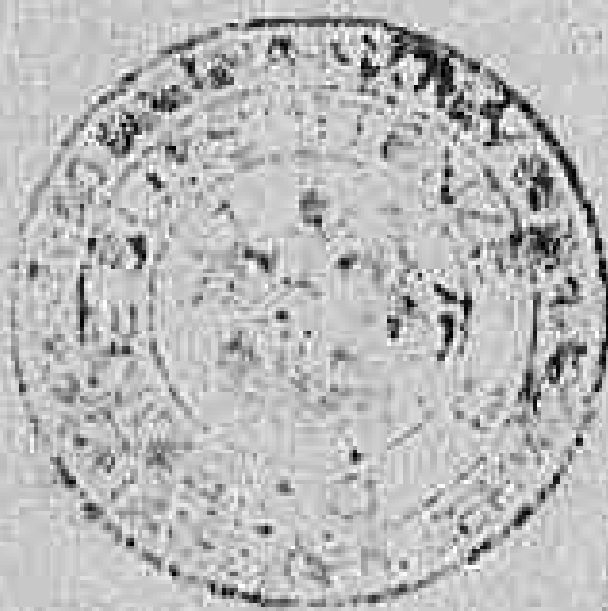

1. Appendix D of Administrative Instruction No. 12 is relative to para 11 (h) of the instruction and is in regard to Medical Supplies, not Medical Stores.
2. Disinfectants are despatched forward to, in the case of 5 Army (Br Incr), the San Gallo Italian Military Hospital, Florence in bulk as obviously we cannot arrange distribution to hospitals, etc., from this end.
3. If DDST 5 Army (Br Incr) will agree, then I see no reason why ADMS at that HQ should not work out a distribution and the disinfectants be picked up from San Gallo and held in D.I.D's to meet ADMS's distribution. Units would then draw on ST/8's in the same way as for rations and hospital diet items. Alternatively DID's could issue and obtain physical repayment from San Gallo.
I feel that internal distribution arrangements must be worked out on the spot and cannot rightly come within our scope.
4. AFHQ will perhaps agree to my suggestion that forward requirements be offset against the bulk releases at Base and give AAI authority to issue disinfectants from D.I.D's, as is now done for hospital diet items.
But it does represent an additional commitment for C.R.A.S.C. and eases the administrative burden on the Italians.
So AFHQ may object. Such a procedure is further complicated by the fact that certain disinfectants come from Italian stocks.

1. The Disinfectants position in this Sector is now partially cleared up. Appendix A sets out the position to date.
2. Columns 2 - 4 of the Appendix are the amounts originally authorized for withdrawal by the Italian medical service.
3. Column 5 shows the amounts actually withdrawn by Comando Campania to end August. (A cross-check of these figures is being prepared by 14 CRASC and will be forwarded when received). It will be noted the figures correspond fairly closely with the amounts originally authorized for Sardinia for May/June. The reason is that these quantities were actually withdrawn from the British depot concerned with a view to shipment to Sardinia and were transported directly from depot to dockside (this occurred in the latter part of June). However with the exception of the small amounts marked with an asterisk in Column 6 the whole consignment was shut out owing to higher priority cargo. In the event the balance shut out was back-hauled to Caserma Garibaldi in Naples. The multiple handling thus incurred reduced a large part of the stock to poor condition.
4. At Caserma Garibaldi the stock was partly used for Naples Sector issues (particularly the damaged portions). When first inspected some three weeks ago, the Caserma Garibaldi depot was in a disorderly condition. Possible lines of improvement were indicated to the office in charge (a pharmacist not a warehouse manager) and in a relatively short time he secured considerable improvement. The Garibaldi premises though not ideal are reasonably suitable for a Disinfectants store when allowance is made for the difficulty of securing premises in Naples, including a fair space of covered outdoor accommodation suitable for liquids.
5. Meanwhile attempts to secure shipping space to Sardinia continued. The Caleb Strong was promised but nothing resulted. Eventually on the evening of 16 August 44 the consignment was called forward by PBS Water Division for immediate loading on S.S. Joseph Hollister. Labour and transport arrangements were

made (not without difficulty) and the British ORs of MMIA Port Detachment screened the stock refitness for shipment on withdrawal from Caserma Garibaldi while at the same time endeavouring to get as much as possible of the important items actually shipped to Sardinia. Quantities shipped to Sardinia as a result are the non asterisk figures in Column 6.

6. For future reference the question of drill for of ~~the~~ ing shipping space for Disinfectants to Sardinia requires further consideration. Paras 6 - 7 - 8 - 9 - 10 of attachment to your AQ/2/2 of 12 August 44 do not entirely cover the position since Medical Ministry of War and for SMME have no means of readily ascertaining for each consignment the number and type of packages and the cubage. Moreover the definition of agencies who will act in paras 8 - 9 quoted is not precise and it was due to this that the procedure broke down formerly. (Freight Form 3 undated reference file S/A/1 created by Movements MMIA HQ for the last consignment and forwarded to Mov Naples copy to Mov AAI was in itself not sufficient to secure shipment).

7. It is therefore recommended that the procedure in future should be for MMIA Naples to advise nett weights, gross weights no of packages, cubage and location where lying to MMIA HQ after ~~the~~ 3 consignment for Sardinia has been completely with drawn by the Italians from ~~the~~ British depot. MMIA HQ (Movements 10) then arranges for Movements AAI to request SOS Matousa for corresponding shipping space and latter in turn instruct PBS Transportation (Water Division) PBS Transportation call forward the cargo by communicating with MMIA Naples.

8. It will finally be noted that there is at present a balance undrawn by the Italians against previous authorities (May/June/July) corresponding to the amounts in Column 2 and in addition a programme for August withdrawals has been issued under date 18 August 44 (MMIA HQ letter ST/17/1).

9. In order to square up the position in a practical manner, it is recommended that the undrawn balances as at end August (approximately Column 2) be wiped out and the August programmes as per ST/17/1 of 18 August 44 be re-named the September programmes (which in present transport conditions here they are bound in any case to become). As soon as transport conditions allow the next Sardinia parcel (Column 3) to be transported completely to Caserma Garibaldi, details as per para 7 foregoing will be communicated to you.

10. Your instructions in reply to paras 7 and 9 are ~~av44c-~~ ed. Meanwhile withdrawal of the August programmes will be inaugurated for storage in Caserma Garibaldi.
