
1. Authority is granted to the Naples Military Hospital for the withdrawal from the special ration depot at Naples of 100 kgs sugar.

Subject: Increase in Ration

To : General Officer in Charge, Army Sub Commission, ACC (MMIA) APO 394

1. For some time past, the Italian Army truck drivers and mechanics of the 2nd Provisional Group have been working the night shift, beginning at 1800 hours daily. Such night employment must continue for an indefinite period. During the night period these Italians receive no midnight snack or other subsistence for the reason that neither the quantity nor the composition of the Italian ration permit a "break-down" which would provide this snack without an increased allowance, which is not necessary in the case of the U.S. Army ration.

2. The fact that U.S. troops and Italian civilians do receive a midnight meal has had a very adverse effect on the morale, and consequently the efficiency, of the Italian Army drivers and mechanics. This decreased efficiency could be overcome by a slight increase in the ration to permit the serving of a midnight meal comparable to, but slightly less than that served the Italian civilian as a mid-shift meal. The additional food would be drawn on the basis of the number of men who worked the previous night.

3. It is urgently requested that there be an increase amounting to three or four ounces of bread and six ounces of soup, or two ounces of canned meat or fish in lieu of the soup, in the ration for personnel working the night shifts.

FOLLOWING IS PARAPHRASE FROM RADIO MMIA TO PENBASE REFERENCE NUMBER A21651. "ITALIAN RATION DUMPS OPERATED BY 212 DIVISION (ITALIAN) WILL NOT BE CONCERNED WITH ISSUING RATIONS TO ANY ITALIAN UNITS OTHER THAN THOSE OF 212 DIVISION (SERVING PENBASE). IF OTHER ITALIAN UNITS REQUEST RATIONS FROM 212 DIVISION DUMPS, THEY SHOULD BE INFORMED TO DRAW THEIR RATIONS DIRECT FROM ITALIAN DUMPS AT NAPLES END". MODIFYING THE ABOVE BY AGREEMENT WITH MMIA THIS DATE ADVISE THAT ITALIAN UNITS SERVING 5 ARMY (AND ASSIGNED TO 2210 DIVISION) WILL BE ISSUED RATIONS FROM 212 DIVISION DUMP AT CIVITAVECCHIA ON PRESENTING REQUISITIONS CERTIFIED BY 5 ARMY. THESE DUMPS ARE STOCKED ONLY TO FURNISH STANDARD BASIC RATION COMPONENTS AND ARE NOT STOCKED WITH ADDITIONAL COMBAT RATION COMPONENTS. THIS ARRANGEMENT MERELY TEMPORARY PENDING ABILITY OF MMIA TO ESTABLISH RATION DUMPS AT CIVITAVECCHIA TO SERVE ALL ITALIAN UNITS AT AREA AT WHICH TIME THE 212 DIVISION DUMP THEREAT WILL BE MOVED FORWARD AND CONTINUE TO SERVE FORWARD COMPONENTS OF BOTH 212 AND 210 DIVISION. ITALIAN ARMY UNITS ASSIGNED TO OTHER THAN 210 OR 212 DIVISION WILL BE REFUSED RATIONS AT ANY DUMPS OPERATED BY 212 DIVISION UNDER PENBASE SUPERVISION. PARAGRAPH FOR 5 ARMY: PLEASE ADVISE AND INSTRUCT YOUR ITALIAN COMPONENTS ACCORDINGLY AND FACILITATE THEIR TRANSPORT TO CIVITAVECCHIA DUMPS. FOR PENBASE FORWARD ECHELON ONLY: API ABOVE STRICTLY BUT NOTIFY MMIA CARE OF ACC ROME OF ANY OTHER ITALIAN APPLICANTS WHICH MUST BE REFUSED RATIONS UNDER THESE INSTRUCTIONS. ALSO ADVISE THIS HEADQUARTERS WHEN MMIA RATION DUMPS START OPERATION AT CIVITAVECCHIA.

1. The extra ration of 2 ozs canned meat is only authorised when Italian military are performing heavy manual labour. This term "heavy manual labour" is interpreted as meaning, the felling of trees, road and rail repairs, the moving of heavy cases etc.
2. It is not considered that searchlight crews come into this category and it is regretted that authority cannot be given for them to be issued with the extra 2 ozs of canned meat.
3. The Basic Ration Scale is to be substantially increased on 1 Aug 44, and this should satisfy the needs of these searchlight crews.

1. A very small number of ITI troops are employed on such duties as train guards where it is necessary to issue a "travelling type" ration as personnel are away for periods up to ten days and cannot leave their duties in order to obtain cooking facilities.

2. It is therefore proposed to issue, in lieu of the complete Allied part of the ration, a travelling ration of

400 grams biscuit (or 425 ozs flour to be made into
400 grams biscuit before departure).

2 tins of meat (12 ozs) every 3 days.

3. The small number of such rations issued will not dislocate any provision action taken by S.O.S. Natousa. The accountancy system about to be set up will record all details of this ration and enable the number issued to be carefully checked.
