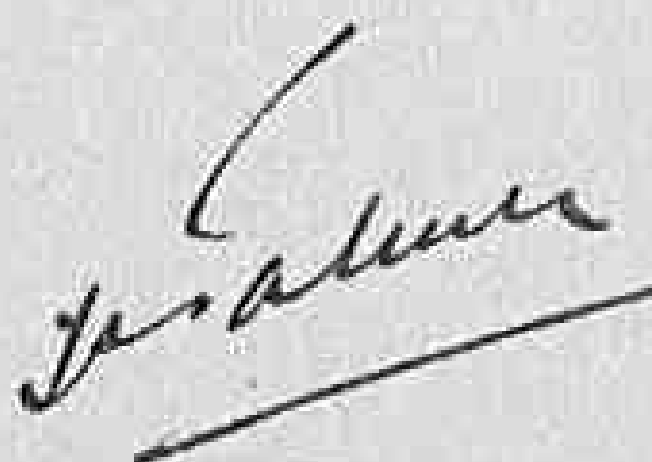

1. Paras 7 and 9 your letter HQ AAI and AFHQ division of the Italian Armed Forces into categories places ALL the I.A.F. as either US-ITIS or BR-ITIS. There are NO ITL-ITIS in the I.A.F. in the recommendation put forward by AFHQ to the Combined Chiefs of Staff. (LYMMA)

No provision has been made for the supply of rations to the I.A.F. after 1 Dec. 44 when the full responsibility for feeding BR-ITIS and US-ITIS is taken over by the nations concerned.

2. The Ration Scale is laid down by the Combined Chiefs of Staff for ALL Italian Armed Forces. An amendment for a portion of the I.A.F. would be a matter for the Theatre Comd in conjunction with the CGS.

Reverting to M.M.I.A. letter AQ/2/7A-I dated 16th September 1944, and this Sub Commission's letter of even reference dated 18th September. Figures as at the 1st August have now been obtained from the Italian Air Ministry.

2. Enclosed herewith copy of return received from the Italian Air Ministry showing the name of each Italian Unit and the name of the Allied Unit with which it is serving. The return has been divided into two sections, (1) British, (2) American.
 3. Upon close examination one or two mistakes are revealed and certain Units stated to be with British are with the Americans and vice-versa.
 4. On page one of the American section of the return No 87 Nucleo Guards totally 87 men are actually employed by the British Army at Terlizzi, and must therefore be deducted from the total.
 5. Again on page one of the British section of the return the 21st, 22nd and 23rd Anti-Malaria Companies comprising 33, 63 and 31 men each respectively, are actually employed by the American Forces. Incidentally these companies are in the process of being disbanded and the personnel are to be transferred to other Units working with the Americans. AFSC/MCO have promised to furnish details when the transfer has been completed.
 6. The net result of these adjustments gives the British total at 30641, and the American total at 4077

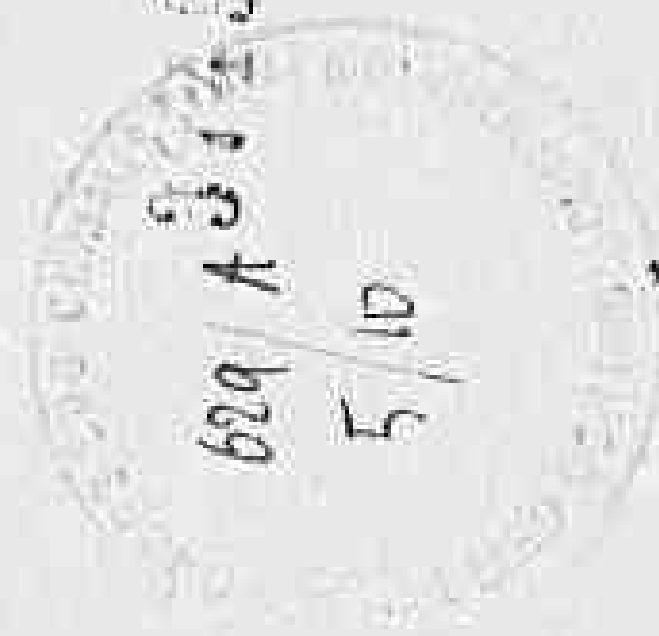

To : The Public Safety Sub Commission, Hq AGC

1. Urgent requests have been made to you in the last sixty days for a ration return for the CC.RR showing the exact number of personnel to be authorized rations from various Italian Army depots. A list of the Italian Army depots was furnished you, in order to enable you to have such a ration return completed.
2. Due to the fact that Italian Army depots are being reorganized and will now be authorized to issue only a specified number of rations, it is absolutely essential that this office have a completed ration return for the CC.RR, in order to authorize the issue of rations.
3. Effective 15 September, no further rations will be issued to any Italian Army units, including the CC.RR, by any Italian Army depot except on specific authority issued by NSIA; and for this reason I must request that the return for which we have been asking for the last two months be furnished. Otherwise, it will be impossible for NSIA to authorize rations for CC.RR on the basis we have been ordered to adopt.
