That, until the time of unloading the vehicles, from the whole quantity received, 281 sacks were kept separate because torn and losing flour.

Those 281 sacks were poured in 218 new sacks and weighted, the total was 9813 Kgs. instead of 11823.300 Kgs. Deficiency is 2010.300 Kgs.

COMING FROM ALLIED DEPOT NO. 374 NAPLES.

The year 1944, the 7th of October, in Naples.

BE IT KNOWN

--That the undersigned, by order of Direzione Com-Issariato Militare of Naples, have met today on the premises of Special Military Food Depot, Naples, to proceed to the introduction of a stock of sugar that arrived during the day by trucks and coming from Allied Depot # 374.

--That it was come to compute the parcels finding that instead of 2035 bags of sugar, 50 lbs each, as informed by sender, there are 2030 because the truck # 563 escorted by the soldier Giuseppe Filippo instead to carry # 207 bags carried only 302.

--That in the whole stock there are # 14 bags which showed tears and had lost part of its content; on weighing it resulted a shortage of comprehensive Kg. 29,200.

--That the above premises, the charge to the depot is ascertained as follows :

Sugar bags, 50 lbs each	2034 equal to Kg. 101700,400
Sugar bags, broken	14 equal to Kg. 351,250
Total bags	2030 equal to Kg. 102051,650

--That considering the above, it is proposed that the Special Military Depot of Naples take in charge the above quantity of sugar.

--That the undersigned, by order of Military Direction Commissariat of Naples, have today met in the premises of Special Military Food Depot of Naples to ascertain the goods introduced during the day and coming from the Allied Depot S. W. 575 of Marollesse.

--That, proceeding to conscientious verification and calculations of the goods, it is found that the total number of parcels corresponds to that indicated by consignees, but the stock of waste is not made up by 369 cartboards of spaghetti, 40 lbs. each and by 377 cartboards of maccheroni, 30 lbs each, as per delivery's specifications, but, instead by 374 cartboards of spaghetti, 352 of maccheroni, and of wood wast each of 35 lbs.

--That, amongst the maccheroni's cartboards there are 4 which present strong indications of damages and is visited.

--That, it was proceeded to the weighing of the visited cartboards, finding a total net weight of 45. 180, which compared to the original 40, shows a difference of 5. 180.

--That, that problem, the goods taken by Depot is described as follows:

the goods, it is found that the total number of parcels corresponds to that indicated by consignee, but the stock of paste is not made up by 359 cartboards of spaghetti, 40 lbs. each and by 377 cartboards of maccheroni 30 lbs each, as per delivery's specifications, but, instead by 373 cartboards of spaghetti, 352 of maccheroni, and 27 wood wast each of 34 lbs.

That, amongst the maccheroni's cartboards there are 4 which present various indications of damage and is violated.

That, it was proceeded to the weighing of the violated cartboards, finding a total net weight of Kg. 120, which compared to the original net, showed a shortage of 20.000 Kg.
