That in execution of orders given by the Military Direzione Commissariato of Naples, the undersigned Committee has met this day in the premises of the Special Military Food Depot (Ponti Rossi) to proceed to the ascertainment and shortages of foodstuff coming from SS "ISLAND STANFORD".

The weight of the pasta recovered from the said parcels amounted to 240 Kg. which compared to the original weight shows a shortage of 99,750 Kg.

Having weighted them, the total was 38.891 Kg representing a deficiency of 1481 Kgs.

That, until the time of unloading the vehicles, from the whole quantity received, 261 sacks were kept separate because torn and losing flour.

Those 261 sacks were poured in 218 new sacks and weighted, the total was 9813 Kgs. instead of 11823.300 Kgs. Deficiency is 2010.300 Kgs.

--That it was come to compute the parcels finding that instead of 2055 bags of sugar, 50 lbs each, as informed by sender, there are 2050 because the truck # 663 escorted by the soldier Giuseppe Filippo instead to carry # 207 bags carried only 302.

--That in the whole stock there are # 14 bags which showed tears and had lost part of its content; on weighing it resulted a shortage of comprehensive Kg. 29,300.

--That the above premises, the charge to the depot is ascertained as follows:
