4. In view of above it is recommended that the loss of the conveyor belt be charged to the Italian Government, because of gross negligence of duty by its Military personnel.

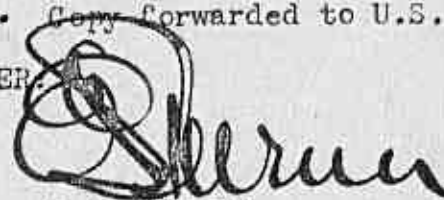

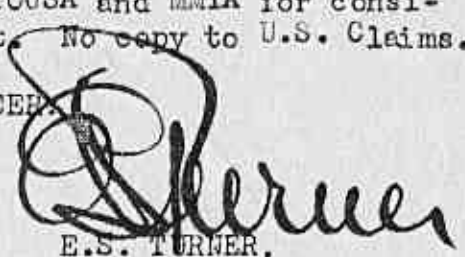

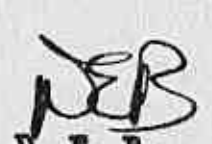
