

1. By authority of Letter Order, dated 8 November 1944, Hq 2675th Regiment, Allied Commission, (Overhead), and pursuant to the provisions of AR 25-20 and Circular No.74, MATOUSA, dated 23 May 1944, the following report is submitted of damage arising out of motor vehicle accident involving GMC 2½ ton 6x6 cargo truck USA No.4118292, and a US government tank.

2. Facts:

a. The driver's accident report form No.26, with reference to this case was found in the files of the Engineering Section, Region IV, Allied Commission. They were placed in this file by AMG 5th Army ICU Division. This driver's accident report along with a number of others, were found not to have been investigated. What we have with reference to this case is very vague. The driver of the vehicle, LAUDATI, Armando, who was with the 1005 Truck Co., Transportation Sub-Commission, Allied Commission, is no longer with the Italian Army and his whereabouts is not known.

On 18 June 1944, Italian Military Driver LAUDATI, Armando, was driving GMC 2½ ton 6x6 Cargo Truck USA No.4118292 south on highway No.7. At about 0900 hours when in the vicinity of Albano Laziale, driver LAUDATI, Armando, was involved in a motor vehicle accident. He was proceeding at a fast rate of speed and he passed another vehicle that was travelling in his same direction and as he passed this vehicle he lost control of his truck and started to skid, running head-on into an oncoming tank. The accident report was made out on a standard form No.26, rather than the Form in Lieu of Standard Form No.26, in that at that time the translated type form evidently was not available.

b. Property Damage:

(1) GMC 2½ ton 6x6 cargo truck USA No.4118292, was very badly damaged as a result of this accident and was turned in to the 3488 Ord. MAM Co. (See salvage Certificate - Exhibit C)

(2) No damage was done to the US government tank.

c. Casualties or Injuries:

(1) There were no casualties or injuries as a result of this accident.

d. Visibility and Road Conditions:

(1) The day was clear, however, the highway was wet due to previous rains.

e. Mechanical Condition of Vehicle:

(1) US government truck was in reasonably good mechanical condition at the time of the accident. (See signed statement of 1st Lt. M.R. VERBURG, Exhibit B)

f. Witnesses:

(1) There are no known witnesses to the accident.

3. Conclusions:

a. Italian Military Driver LAUBALI, Armando, was travelling at an excessive rate of speed on a wet pavement and was not exercising reasonable care when he attempted to pass another vehicle with oncoming traffic approaching from the opposite direction.

4. Findings:

a. That Italian military driver LAUBALI, Armando, was not exercising reasonable care and the cause of the accident was through fault and neglect on his part.

b. Italian military driver LAUBALI, Armando is no longer with the Italian army and his whereabouts is not known.

c. The only information available regarding this accident is the driver's Accident Report Form No. 26, and a letter written by 1st Lt. M.R. VERBURG, to the director of the TCU division, with reference to the accident. (See - Exhibit B).

4. Recommendations:

a. The cause of the accident was through neglect on the part of Italian military personnel and that three copies be forwarded to MTOUSA, in compliance with para. 7E, Circular 74, MATCUSA, dated 23 May, 1944. 7327

b. GAO 23 ton 6x6, cargo truck USA No. 4118292, was badly damaged as a result of this accident and was turned in to the 3488 Ord. A&A Company. (See Salvage Certificate - Exhibit C)

c. That the accountable and responsible officer be relieved of accountability and responsibility.
