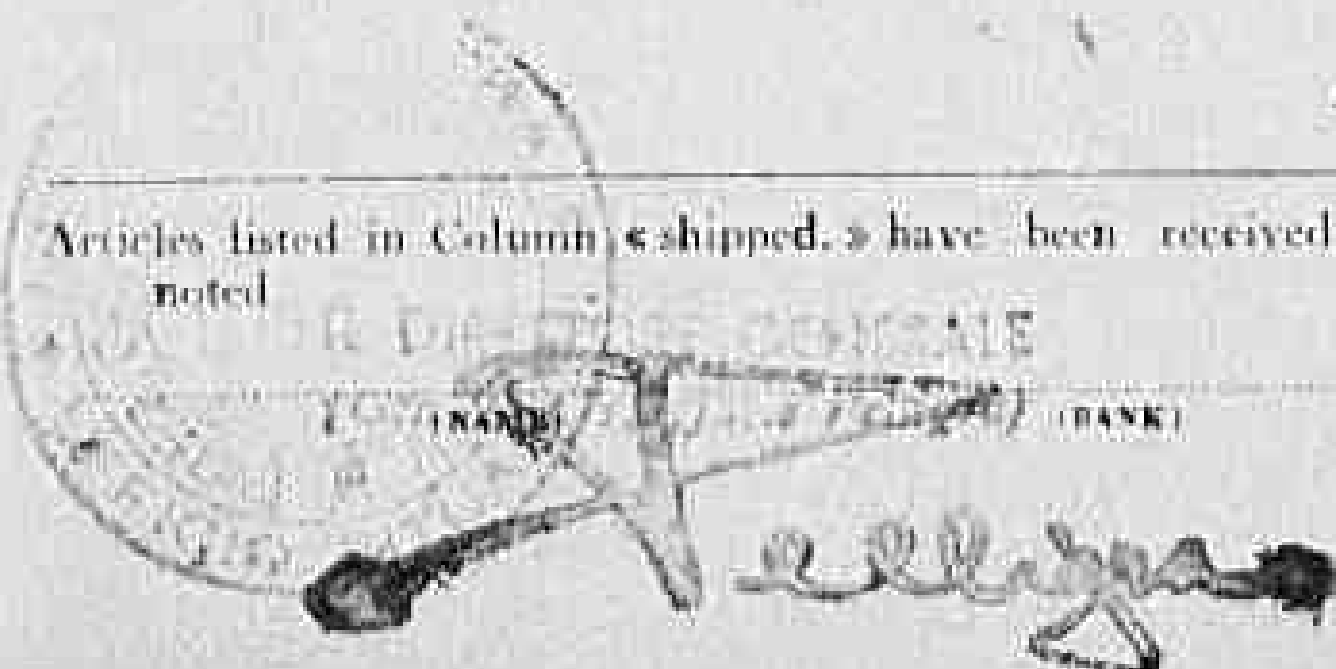

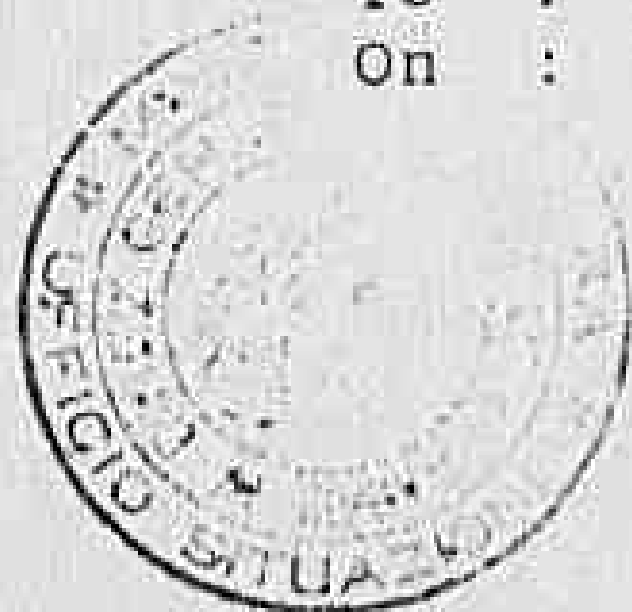



SUBJECT: Investigation of Loss of Government Property.

TO: Commanding Officer, 2695th Technical Supervision
Regiment (Ovhd), APO 464, US Army.

1. In compliance with Special Order #101, paragraph #3, dated 1 August 1945, Headquarters, 2695th Technical Supervision Regiment Ovhd appointing the undersigned to investigate the loss of 40 Army flashlights, TL#122, the following report is submitted: See Exhibit "A".

2. Findings.

a. On the 28th March 1945, eighty (80) flashlights TL-122 were loaned to the 103d Italian Engineer Combat Battalion by the 2695th Technical Supervision Regiment. These items were duly issued and the 103d Italian Engineer Combat Battalion assumed the responsibility to maintain and safeguard this equipment. See Exhibit "B".

b. The 103d Italian Engineer Combat Battalion further loaned this equipment to the following companies of the 103d Italian Engineer Combat Battalion:

Headquarters Company received 20 flashlights and of that number 16 have not been turned in. See Exhibit "C".

4th Company received 20 flashlights of that number 2 have not been turned in. See Exhibit "D".

5th Company received 20 flashlights and of that number 7 have not been turned in. See Exhibit "E".

6th Company received 20 flashlights and of that number 13 have not been turned in. See Exhibit "F".

This is a total of forty (40) flashlights.

c. When U.S. equipment was turned in by these companies a total of eleven (11) flashlights were in the possession of officers on leave. See Exhibits "C" and "F".

d. A total of 29 flashlights have been lost. See Exhibits "C", "D", "E" and "F".

e. These companies have now been released from US/ITI control, reorganized and shipped to distant locations in Italy which are not known. Consequently it is not possible to contact the personnel that now have in their possession eleven (11) of the flashlights.

3. Recommendations.

a. That the cost of Forty flashlights which amounts to a total of forty dollars (\$40.00) be charged against the Italian Ministry of War. Fifth Army Signal Section advised this office that the price of one (1) flashlight T1-122 costs one dollar (\$1.00).
