Ref. Q/2/29-80 dated 18 Mar. 45.

Several errors appearing in the making out of Forms K (MMIA Form ST/8) for drawing rations and bread, compelled this office to carry out a continuous and complete control of these forms.

However, in agreement with MMIA, this office with signal No. 1258 dated 27 Mar. 45 addressed to Naples, Palermo, Bari HQ's and Calabria S.I. Div, and with phone message (same reference number and date) addressed to GHQ CC.RR and Rome Territorial HQ, issued instructions so that, as from the 1st. inst., Form K for drawing rations and bread, be made out in 4 copies instead of three.

To complete instructions already issued, the following is pointed out:-

1. The first three copies of Form K will be distributed as under:-

One copy to MMIA	
" " " the receiving unit	
" " " the Distribution Depot.	2837

The fourth copy will be sent to this Ministry by the Comm. Office concerned within the 5th. day following the withdrawal.

2. Forms K must be made out properly and must show all details as well as any other information which may be requested.

3. These forms must be checked first by the Territorial Comm. Officer concerned (not counting the checking carried out by the Distribution Depot) Therefore, it is pointed out that also the copy to be sent to this office, must be countersigned by an officer of the Comm. Office concerned.

4. All forms dealing with issues carried out by Ration Depots and Territorial Bakeries and only these must be sent to this Ministry. Territorial Bakeries includes also civilian Bakeries which work for the Commissariat. One excluded from Territorial Bakeries, civilian bakeries baking bread for single units even if these bakeries have a contract for all the units of one or more areas, because these bakeries get the flour from the units which drew same from Mil. Ration Depot.

3 - Un prime controllo sui buoni (oltre quelle di competenza del magazzino distributore) deve essere eseguito dall'ufficio di commissariato territorialmente competente; a tal fine si prescrive che la copia dei buoni da inviarsi alle scrivente venga controfirmata anche da un ufficiale commissario dell'ufficio anzidetto.

4 - A questo ministero devono essere trasmessi tutti e solo i buoni relativi alle distribuzioni che effettuano i magazzini viveri ed i panifici territoriali. In questi ultimi sono compresi i panifici privati che lavorano per conto del commissariato militare, mentre sono esclusi i panifici privati che producono il pane per conto dei singoli reparti (anche se il contratto di appalto è riferito a tutti gli enti di uno o più presidi), lavorando farina che i reparti stessi prelevano presso un magazzino militare viveri.

British Increment, with full concurrence of 15 Army Group, has authorized the withdrawal from the line of our Pioneer Labour Coy's by turns for a short rest period which is spent at CASTELFRANCO.

This rest area is always referred to loosely as the "Italian Pioneer Rest Camp" and hence the wrong designation on the O/L's in question. What appeared on the O/L's as the "Italian Pioneer Rest Camp" should in fact, have been designated "X" Coy, I.P.L. and "Y" Coy, I.P.L.

I explained all this verbally to Col. HOAKER on his last visit to this H.Q.

SUBJECT: Issue of unauthorized rations in SARDINIA

148

Further to letter 6158/S/1 dated 17 March 1945.

As a result of the inspection that has taken place in SARDEGNA it appears that an erroneous issue of rations, due to misinterpretation of orders issued by this Ministry, was made to the personnel of the Italian Red Cross.

The main responsibility falls upon Major PITZALIS, now dead, but who was head of the rations section of the SARDEGNA Commissariat Directorate.

However, the following disciplinary action has been taken as regards this matter.

a. Reprimanded: Col. GIULIANI PIETRO since as Head of the SARDEGNA Military Commissariat failed to insure that the important orders issued by the M. of W were complied with as regards the cessation of issue of rations to the personnel that had to be fed otherwise.

b. 5 days close arrest to Lt. Col. ALECCI ANGELO since as 2nd. I/C and Head of the Ration Section of said Comm. while he should have ascertained the actual withdrawal situation according to the amendments made by the M. of W and by MMIA Hq. gave erroneous statements, which in turn caused the Higher authorities to give out completely false reports.

The calling in of what has been erroneously issued is already being carried out according to the rules established by MMIA.

SUBJECT: Rations issued to C.R.I. units.

M.M.I.A. has notified us that the 57 Ration Store of Ortona, during the period 1st. to the 5th. inst., issued 25 rations to the 82 Mobile C.C.S. of the Italian Red Cross. ( Voucher ST/8 enclosed).

Since, as has been pointed out many times, units of the Italian Red cross are not entitled to draw military rations, that H.Q. is requested to make the necessary enquiries in order to establish the reason for which the issue referred to was made, and to ascertain the individual responsible for the unauthorized issue.

The Ortona Ration Store has already been ~~informed~~ instructed to suspend any issue of rations whatsoever to the above mentioned C.C.S., by means of telegram 7665/S/1, which has been sent to that H.Q. for information, and of which we enclose a copy for M.M.I.A.

We await information as to the result of the enquiries which must be carried out urgently.

1. We are inclosing herewith MMIA Forms ST/8's shown as Inclosures No. 1 through 215, covering issues to the Italian Military from British depots.
2. It can readily be seen that the rations issued are not issued according to scale, nor is the complete ration issued to the unit in all cases. To point this out, we invite your attention to Incl. No. 1. The unit shown thereon requests 120 rations for two days which would make a total of 240 rations. The only items issued were Meat 45 lbs., and Tomato Paste 3 lbs. Another instance where over-issue occurred was on Incl. No. 6, which shows an issue of 630 lbs of flour for 240 rations. Incl. No. 12 shows the unit requested 600 rations, and the depot issued 1,969 lbs. of flour.
3. To enable us to control the issue of rations to Italian units, all issuing depots will have to abide by the scale laid down by the Combined Chiefs of Staff for the Italian Military, issuing the full scale each time a unit demands rations. If the unit demanding the rations does not desire to draw all the items on the scale, they should not be given credit for the items to be drawn at a later date.
4. I feel sure that you understand the situation and will issue instructions immediately to your depots to correct this irregularity. Please give us copy of your instructions concerning same, and return these inclosures to our office to enable us to charge the Italian Military and give due credit to the British Government.



Ref. letter Q/2/29-75 dated Mar. 12, 1945.

Further to telegrams 6055 and 6339 dated 16th. & 20th. inst.

In violation of regulations in force, 11,476 rations were issued by Subsistence Warehouses to Italian Red Cross in SARDINIA for the period Oct. 11, 1944 - Feb. 20, 1945.

As military rations are for authorized personnel only, the unauthorized issue made to Italian Red Cross must be considered as a loss to said authorized personnel.

Consequently, in order to make up said loss MMIA has directed that the rations, which were wrongfully distributed, are to be made good by means of an effective savings which will be attained through the reduction of the daily ration, and it has decided that for twenty-three successive days, starting April, the rations which are to be issued to units fed by the Cagliari Garrison (less the Carabinieri) and that is approximately 5,000 daily rations, will be reduced by 10%  
 $500 \times 23 = 11,500$

The reductions will be carried out in the following manner:

1. Rations will be issued to each unit only on presentation of a certificate signed by the Military Commander of SARDINIA clearly showing the effective strength and strength fed.

Said certificate will be attached to Form ST/8 which is given to the distributing warehouse by the unit.

2. The warehouse will issue rations on the basis of 90% of the strength fed.

3. Each evening, the Independent Commissariat Section of CAGLIARI will send all of the forms ST/8 together with the certificates showing the strength, to MMIA's Liaison Officer, in order that at the end of the 23 days, MMIA Headquarters may make sure that the set number of rations have been saved.



1. A check of ration issue vouchers has revealed that Italian Army rations have been issued to Italian Red Cross units in Sardinia from Italian Army depots. For the period 11 October 1944 to 27 February 1948, the issues to XIV Red Cross Center and Red Cross Hospital "Carlo Felice" amounted to 11,875 rations. Records for the period prior to 11 October 1944 are not yet available, but it must be presumed that rations were also issued prior to 11 October 1944.
2. The issues were stopped on 21 February 1948 on instructions from this Headquarters.
3.
  - a. The Director of Commissary in Sardinia has stated to the SPA AC that the issues were made to civilian hospitals caring for military patients who could not be accommodated in authorized Army hospitals. Never more than 50% of the bed space in authorized Army hospitals has been utilized during the period in question, therefore all military patients should have been cared for in authorized military hospitals.
  - b. The Director of Commissary in Sardinia also stated that the issues were made in accordance with War <sup>1726</sup> dispatch 11070/s/1 of 15 October 1944. Some of the issues were made prior to the date of the dispatch.
4.
  - a. This Red Cross hospital has never been shown on any Army return. It is not included in the list of authorized military hospitals (see A4/7 of 2 Oct and 2 Dec 1944).
  - b. The issue of Army rations to Italian Red Cross hospitals has never been authorized, but on the contrary has been specifically prohibited.
5. The responsibility for the unauthorized issue of these rations rests on the Commanding General in Sardinia. The fact that the issues continued over a long period indicates that no

adequate check of Commissary operations was made by the Commanding General, or the prohibition of such issue was deliberately and intentionally disregarded.

6. a. No additional Allied rations will be furnished the Italian Army to make up for the loss incurred by these unauthorized issues, and in order to have sufficient rations to feed the Army it is necessary that a physical saving be accomplished. This can be done only by a reduction of the ration scale.

b. Therefore, beginning on 1 April 1945, and continuing for twenty-two days thereafter, the rations issued the authorized Army garrison units (less 20,000) in Sardinia (approximately 8,000 ration strength) will be reduced 10% per day (500 x 22 equals 11,000).

✓ c. This reduction will be accomplished as follows:

(1) Rations will be issued only on written certificates signed by the Commanding General, Sardinia, showing (1) effective strength and (2) ration strength. This certificate will be attached to the R/R submitted by the unit to the Commissary.

(2) The Commissary will issue rations to the unit based on 90% of the ration strength.

(3) The Commissary will deliver all of the R/R's, with the certificate of strength attached, to the NIA 10 Sardinia at the close of business each day.

(4) At the end of 22 days, N4 NIA will conduct 1755  
 checks all ration returns for the period to insure that the required number of rations have been actually saved.

7. You will issue necessary instructions to the Commanding General, Sardinia as outlined above, and send a copy of the instructions you issue to this Headquarters.

8. Attention is again directed to the fact that issue of rations furnished by the Allies must be strictly controlled and made only to effective personnel of authorized units. No additional Allied rations will be made available to cover losses incurred by thefts, misappropriation, or unauthorized issues.

In order to ration the entire IRI-IRI category with the food available, it may become necessary to reduce the scale to compensate for loss by theft, misappropriation or unauthorized issues. The situation will be reviewed periodically, and reduction of scale will be ordered where necessary. You should therefore inform all concerned that a reduction of scale will be made as a result of loss of rations through negligence, over-issue, unauthorized issue, misappropriation or theft.

1. In reply to MIA cable AQ 9886 of 28 January 1945, issues to unauthorized units have been stopped. No further military rations have been issued to these units after the period 6-20 February 1945, changing from military rations to civilian rations caused some delay.

2. Director of Commissary states that issues to the Civilian Hospital of Ittiri were only for Italian Military cared for by this hospital, who could not be taken care of in military hospitals. Director of Commissary also states that issues to Italian Red Cross personnel were made in accordance with MIA letter AQ/2 of 1 July and War Ministry despatch 11020/S/1 of 15 October 1944.

3. The Italian officers permitting these unauthorized issues are General Brunetti who was Commanding General of Italian Forces in Sardinia and Colonel Giuliani, Director of Commissary. The Allied officer permitting these unauthorized issues is Colonel F. L. Simmons, Senior Liaison Officer Sardinia.

4. With reference to statement to effect that it is the responsibility of this office "to allow only authorized units to draw", the undersigned agrees. However, compliance with the next phase, "strict depot supervision imperative", is impossible under existing circumstances. MIA Administration Instruction Number 3 dated 4 June 1944 provides for a staff of four officers and eight enlisted men to provide supervision considered necessary. At no time has such personnel exceeded one officer and four enlisted men. Furthermore, with responsibility for evacuating stores from depots and assembling in Cagliari for shipment, added to the supervision of reception and distribution of rations, it would seem obvious that supervision of a "strict" nature is out of the question.

1. The explanation of the overissue of rations, as set out in your letter is considered unsatisfactory, especially as you were instructed to stop the issues on 27 January 1945 (Signal 2688 of 28 January) and the issues were not stopped until 20 February, resulting in a loss of 1872 rations.

2. The statements of the Director of Commissary should not have been forwarded to this Headquarters. You should have known that such statements have no basis in fact.

3. It is desired that the records be checked and this Headquarters be advised promptly the total number of rations issued to unauthorized units in Sardinia.

4. Strict depot supervision will be exercised by you, through a daily check of ration issue vouchers as compared with the Order of Battle, and sufficiently frequent physical inspections of depots and records, to insure that:

- a. Only authorized units draw rations for the strength actually present and not in excess of that prescribed.
- b. Any unauthorized issues are corrected immediately, and on the spot.
- c. Instructions from this Headquarters are complied with promptly.

5. It is considered that sufficient personnel is available to you for all purposes, considering the reduced troop strength under your supervision.

Reference your 4/2/59-44 dated 31 Jan 59, regarding IMIA Form SF/3, (1 through 82).

The several replies to your observations are as follows:-

- 1. The number lines of the units remaining have been omitted in every case. These have now been completed.
- 2. The number lines of unit inventories have been completed in every case.
- 3. The destination of authorized Italian units as far as SA teams, has now been completed.
- 4. In accordance with instructions given to the 99th AFSG regarding for small units awarded to enemy, inventories of the units will, as they appear to be empty, the inventory has now been stopped until further orders are received.
- 5. In every case, the unit during the mission is a British unit, and to have complete units of transport and equipment, these units have called attention for the small inventories of Italian military. In some cases the inventory has been kept so small that there is no Italian officer. Therefore Italian Officer's signatures cannot always be obtained.
- 6. This is now being completed with.
- 7. Data returns are from this have been completed in every case.

In several cases there are no signatures of Officers of the unit 1728. This is regretted, but at the time, unavoidable.

The instructions and SF/3 Form were revised, which stated that the unit copies would continue immediately, therefore IMIA Form SF/3 were completed by this date, and the old type of inventories, showing signatures were destroyed.

Enclosed the black copy of the IMIA Form SF/3 for 21 units, the unit inventories sent 4 copies instead of 3, so it is suggested that the 4th copy was included in error. This copy may, therefore, be destroyed.

Subject: Distribution of rations to Italian Red Cross units.

Further to letter 1334/3/1 - 15 Feb. 1945.

As soon as we received letter AQ/2/29/31 - 4 Feb. we telegraphed Military Territorial HQ Naples ordering an immediate inquiry into the irregularities that had taken place.

It has resulted that the camp hospital No. 1 of C.R.I. was made ready at Naples, and departed for the 8th. Army on 3/6/44.

The said hospital was stationed at Venafro, successively at Fuggi, and eventually at Roccasucca, they drew rations from the English Food Depot of Roccasucca, and the Indian Depot of Venafro in accordance with instructions from the American Medical Major PING. Towards the end of Aug. 1944 the Allied Depots suspended the issuing of rations to the said hospital, stating that the food rations should have been drawn from Italian Depots.

The Director of the hospital presented himself to the Military HQ of Naples, requesting authorization to draw from the food depot of Caserta.

During the absence of the head of the services office, Capt. PERO the officer in command who was not aware of the regulations in force, issued the authorization by error.

The issued authorization was not within his jurisdiction. The said officer failed to notify the Head Office and as no revocation of the concession was received, the drawing of rations continued.

It appears to me that no responsibility can be put on the Directorate of the Commissariate, or the food depot of Caserta who had received precise orders from their superiors. I thought it advisable not to take action against the officers of a/m units.

Capt. PERO however has been punished with 7 days confinement, for having with neglect issued an authorization outside his jurisdiction, and having failed to notify his Head Office.

The chief of Adm. Office of Naples has been reprimanded because he checked the vouchers without noting that the authority granted was irregular.

(K)

I will inform you of the disciplinary action that will be taken against the director of the hospital, who failed to inform Capt. PERO that his hospital belonged to the Italian Red Cross. If this fact had been known the a/m inconveniences would not have occurred.

Moreover, I have arranged that the Italian Red Cross will be debited for these rations. It is my opinion that with the instructions on controls, that have been issued in agreement with MMIA the a/m inconveniences will be avoided.

I beg you kindly to inform me if the vouchers ST/8 concerning a/m issues, should be forwarded to MMIA.



SUBJECT: Issues to Unauthorized Units.

TO : Commanding General, Land Forces Sub Commission, AC. (MMIA), Rome.

1. In reply to MMIA cable AQ 2686 of 28 January 1945, issues to unauthorized units have been stopped. No further military rations have been issued to these units after the period 6-20 February 1945. Changing from military rations to civilian rations caused some delay.

2. Director of Commissary states that issues to the Civilian Hospital of Ittiri were only for Italian Military cared for by this hospital, who could not be taken care of in military hospitals. Director of Commissary also states that issues to Italian Red Cross personnel were made in accordance with MMIA letter AQ/2 of 1 July and War Ministry despatch 11020/S/1 of 15 October 1944.

3. The Italian officers permitting these unauthorized issues are General Brunnetti who was Commanding General of Italian Forces in Sardinia and Colonel Giuliani, Director of Commissary. The Allied officer permitting these unauthorized issues is Colonel F.L. Simmons, Senior Liaison Officer Sardinia.

4. With reference to statement to effect that it is the responsibility of this office "to allow only authorized units to draw", the undersigned agrees. However, compliance with the next phase, "strict depot supervision imperative", is impossible under existing circumstances. MMIA Administration Instruction Number 3 dated 4 June 1944 provides for a staff of four officers and eight enlisted men to provide supervision considered necessary. At no time has such personnel exceeded one officer and four enlisted men. Furthermore, with responsibility for evacuating stores from depots and assembling in Cagliari for shipment, added to the supervision of reception and distribution of rations, it would seem obvious that supervision of a "strict" nature is out of the question.
