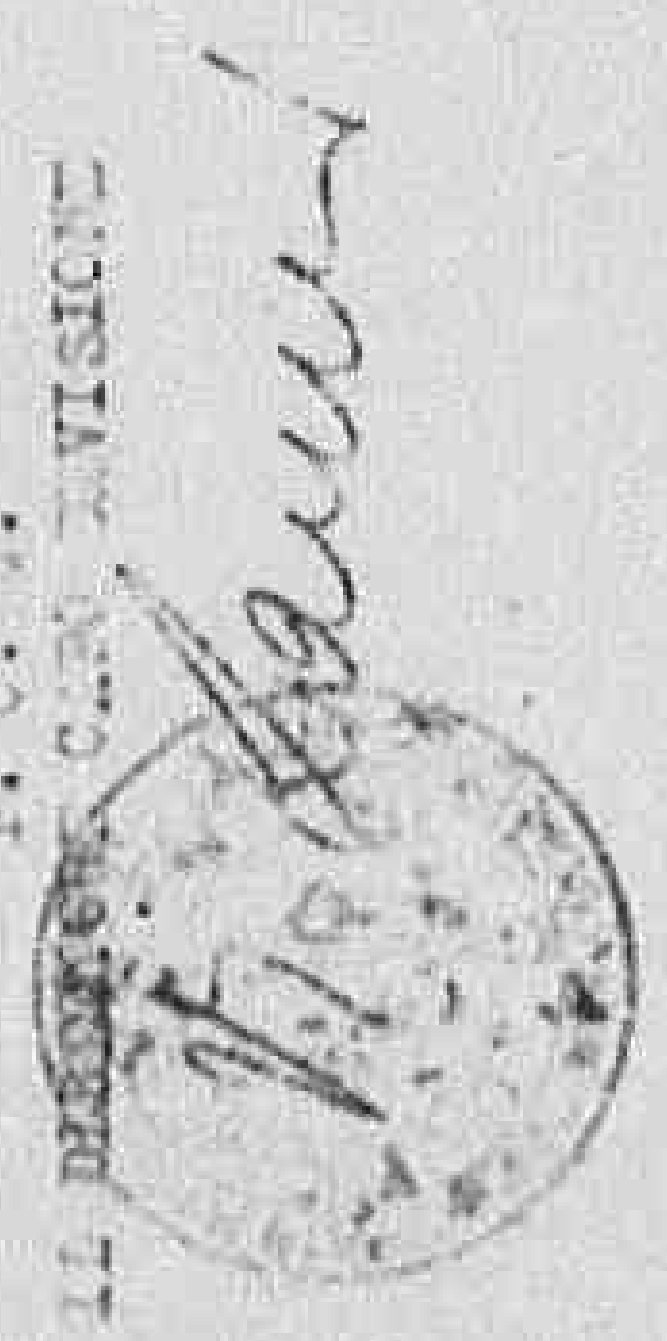

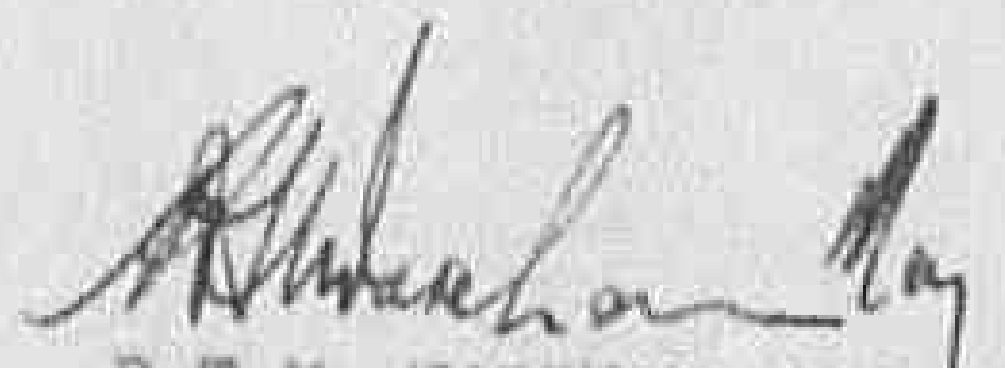

Suggest that AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No.2, dated 10 January 1944, is not being complied with in the Milan area in that it appears that Italian military are being rationed at transit American messes. On June 14, 1945, I ate at the Hotel Nord in Milan and out of 12 officers in the dining room, six of them were Italian officers. Italian military should eat the Italian military ration which is provided for them. It is recognized that certain Italian individuals such as Liaison officers, attached to Allied installations, may be rationed at Allied or American messes when it is more appropriate to do so but it is considered that the six officers referred to did not fall in that category. Italian Army messes are operating in that area and transit officers can be rationed there which would permit the rations consumed to be put on an ST/d and charged to the Italian Government.

- HQ Supply Unit. The denomination is not correct: The units of Commissariat authorized in the CATANZARO Area are 64 District Food Depot 12th Depot for Italian material for repairs - 13 Barrack Stores Depot-Northern Nucleus.

Supply unit. The heading is not correct, the only commissariat unit in COSENZA is the 67 Food Distribution Depot authorized strength 20 rations.

Besides the strength data prescribed in paragraph 2 no. 4 of circular 9080/S/1 dated April 30 (a copy of which has been enclosed only for the Mil. Terr. Commands of Bolzano (IV) and Udine (V) to whom said circular was not sent) the Mil. Terr. Commands are requested to report, to the dependent Commissariat Directorates, the category to which the unit belongs, and the category to which the men eventually attached belong, in order to permit the checking of the forms by the issue depots.

We call your attention again to what was ordered with circular 1606/Sit. dated April 18, in regard to the procedure with which the ration withdrawal voucher is to be filled out as regards the subdivision of the strength into: effective strength of the unit, attached strength, ration strength.

The a/m orders must be carried out immediately.

The addressee Hqs. are requested to issue the necessary instructions to the effect that dependent depots will not accept vouchers that have not been filled out according to the a/m procedure.

By means of circular 4290/S/1 of February 22, 1945 this Ministry instructed Terr. Commands to transmit to Q.M. Directorates on or before the 20th. of each month a complete list of all units stationed in their territory and to be rationed by depots in such territory, indicating for each unit the maximum authorized strength and the issuing depot.

The following difficulties were reported in connection with the enactment of these instructions.

a. Territorial Commands cannot report the strength as of the 20th of each month, since the data concerning the strength of subordinate units are being reported on the 9th. and 24th of each month, in accordance with the instructions issued by S.M.R.L. to whom these reports are addressed.

b. Territorial Commands are not familiar with the strength of units stationed in their territory and not directly under their command.

c. The strength reported to Territorial Commands by the units on the 9th and 24th concerns the rationed strength in the previous 15 day period.

d. The data to be reported on the 20th of each month to QM Directorates would if the report of the 9th by the units to the Territorial Command could be taken as a basis - concerns the rationed strength during the second 15 day period of the preceding month.

e. The report cannot always reach the QM Directorates on or before the 20th, so as to make it possible for them to distribute the information to issuing depots.

In order that the difficulties encountered may be overcome promptly and the control may be made fully effective, this Ministry specifies herein below the rules to be followed in carrying out said control:

I The prescribed control over the drawing of food rations must be carried out in two distinct phases: the first, preliminary, the second, subsequent. The former must be based on the War establishment strength, the second on the rationed strength.

II In order to carry on the preliminary control, Territorial Military Commands are requested:

1. To report the following not later than the 20th of each month to the subordinate QM Directorates:

The war establishment strength of subordinate units, indicating the depot at which rations are to be drawn.

Any later changes occurring during the month.

For each authorized organization, a list, classified by units, of outgoing military personnel to be attached to other units and incoming military personnel attached to the unit in question.

2. To direct that among organizations under the same command the attachment - or attachment for rations - of personnel should be avoided.

3. To direct that, in accordance with current regulations, the drawing of rations be made always only for the strength actually present and not for the authorized strength.

4. To direct that the information under No. 1 include also the data concerning:

Royal Carabinieri units, to be requested of the respective Carabinieri legions.

Units not under the direct command of the Territorial Military Command, after an understanding with the Commands to whom the units in question are subordinated.

III Concerning the subsequent control, Territorial Military Commands are requested:

1. To inform the subordinate QM Directorate of the rationed strength of all units in the territory, as per para II, No. 1, reported to S.M.R.E. on the 9th and 24th of each month, in order to enable QM Directorates to exercise the proper control over the issues of food rations by depots under their command.

To this end, QM Directorates will direct that the list of units rationed by the depots be forwarded to them every 15 days and not every month, as in the past.

A like list (to be) forwarded to this Ministry as per letter 1600/S/1 of January 26 should, therefore, be transmitted every 15 days and should refer to the following 15 day periods:

Control of rationed strengths.

Further to letter 4430/S/1 dated 5/5/44.

As a result of accounts check up it appears that some units have withdrawn a number of rations exceeding their present authorized ration strength.

Since in the case the charging of cost of the rations drawn in surplus has proved inefficient and that it is necessary to eliminate the possibility of further irregularity of this sort we order that:

The Military Command to whom this letter is addressed will on the 20th. of each month send the their Commissariat Directorate a complete list of all ITI-ITI units located in their territories which will have to be supplied by the food depots of the area.

Beside the name of each unit the following will be shown.

- a. The maximum authorized strength.
- b. The food depot from which issues are made.

The Commissariat Directorates on receipt of those list will communicate them to each depot and make clear that in future only the units listed thus will be able to draw rations from the depots and only up to the authorized limit as shown.

The territorial Military Commands will communicate to Commissariat Directorates eventual variation which will take place during the course of the month this to enable alteration of lists.

For the CCRK the sending of the lists will also be made by Terr. Milit. Command after contacts have been with Legion HQs.

All the Territorial Military Commands will, with frequent inspections of the Depots and units, insure that:

- a. The depots only issue rations to authorized units in the limits of the authorized strength.
- b. The units only authorized to draw rations for the personnel present as shown on the accountancy report this as already arranged in letters 4430/S/1 and 11858/S/1 dated respectively 5 May and 31st. Oct. 44.

A monthly report on such control activities will be sent to this Ministry. This report will show the depots and units which have been visited and any eventual breach of the rules and action taken as regards such cases.

The Commissariate Directorates and the Autonome Commissariat office of TARANTO will send to this Ministry the list requested with letter 1600/S/1 dated 26 Jan. before the 15th. of each month, showing for ITI-ITI units the strength authorized by Military Commands.

We point out that thus 2 control systems come into force, one preventive the other ensuring compliance to the rules.

The first will apply to the maximum authorized strength by providing the depot with a complete list of units to be supplied thus avoiding issue of non-authorized rations and withdrawal of ration by units not recognized by allied authorities.

The second will apply to the present strength of each unit so as to ensure that the units authorized to draw up to a maximum number do only draw the rations necessary for the present strength of the unit this control to be carried out by the commando from which the units depends will apply also to BR-ITI and US-ITI UNITS EVENTUALLY RATIONED FROM Italian depots and also to units directly supplied by the allies.

For the ITI-ITI units in advanced areas this control will be done by 'T' delegation of SMRE.

For the ROME Food Depot the necessary information as regards the strength will be sent as before by the Ministry of War.

We point out that the s/m Commands will be held responsible for any breach of the rules.

This ministry would be grateful to know of any obstacle to the immediate enforcing of the above rules and of any means to over-come such difficulties as may be encountered.

The 500 rations of bread drawn by the 9th Sussistenza Unit on the 11th of March were issued to the 488 soldiers that were present on that day. During the month 12 rations were drawn less to cover the 12 that were over drawn.

The 1050 rations of bread drawn by the Bari Presidio on the 3rd of March were issued as per attached list.

The 500 rations of bread drawn by the Bari Military District were issued to 482 recruits.

Of the 4500 traveling rations drawn by the Barletta Military District, 2143 were issued to recruits and 2357 were returned to the Depot that issued them because they proved to be surplus. *U. p. m. d. a. l. a. f.*

Some units have informed us that it is not always possible to tell the exact number of rations needed because the vouchers are turned in at the Depots 3 days before drawing.

We will inform you at a later date about what happened to the 280 rations drawn on the 5th of March by the Detached Artillery Section of Bari because this unit has turned its accounting books over to the Artillery Directorate in Taranto.

We assure that we have issued instructions concerning the rations drawn above the authorized strength and they will be explained on the reverse of the voucher.
