The source of condition requested are estimates for 1000 men for a ten day period and will provide four different diets i.e. Mourishing, Normal, Light and very light. On the 15 March the total number of hospital beds in Italy, Sardinia and Sicily was 21,000 and the number of patients 13,000.

1. It is noted that difficulties are being experienced in transporting existing stocks of tobacco in the SUIRAN and LORRAI road to the AMI factory.
2. Will you please therefore apply through internal transportation Sub-Commission for this matter to be brought up at the next AGI meeting when this HQ will endeavor to see that this is accepted. The meetings are held each Thurs at 0930 hrs at this HQ.
3. It appears from AMI letter 48/2 dated 5 Mar 48 that weekly production of cigarettes is at present 25,000 Nos (17,000 AMI and 8,000 LORRAI).
4. As the Italian military requirements will not exceed 21,000 Nos per week it is considered that the Italian Ministry of Finance should be pressed to meet this requirement.
5. In the meantime instructions have been issued for the issue of tobacco to Italian Armed Forces in the forward areas only to continue Allied sources.

Since the 15 Feb and for all Italian Forces fighting on the 5 and 8 Armies Areas the foodstuff ration shown in Appendix "A" of letter AG/400-1 (Italy) GDS-AGM dated 9 Jan is being issued.

From reports received from the Italian H.Q. concerned it results that the change of ration is considered unsatisfactory by the men who can compare it to the ration issued to Allied Troops.

This is also confirmed by Memo 55-184 from the 5 Army (as per copy attached) Authorising a supplementary issue of meat and milk.

We would like to see the MMIA approaching the Superior Allied auth to obtain that the Italian Operating Force be issued with the same ration as Allied Troops.

Until decisions which might be taken in this connection it would be advisable if the supplement of meat and milk issued to the troops on the 5 Army Area be extended to those on the 8 Army Area in order to avoid possible repercussions which can arise from the different issues.

Supplementary Rations for The Italian Troops.

1. The foodstuff ration established by the AFHQ and published in our Adm Orders No.29 dated 13 Feb is considered unsatisfactory for the Italian Fighting Forces.

2. In conformity with authority as per circular 14 from NATOUS dated 4 Feb it is agreed that the ration be increased as an operational necessity. The increase will consist in an extra daily issue of meat and milk (20 Tins of 14 1/2 oz each) per 100 men and will only be issued to troops beyond the boundaries.

SUBJECT: Issue of Tobacco Cigarettes to Italian Forces

TO : WE AF (adm. Ref.)

1. Reference your 25/4/41 of 8 March, this sub-commission is taking immediate and urgent steps to arrange for adequate provision of cigarettes to the Italian Armed Forces.

2. A representative of this sub-commission yesterday discussed this matter at considerable length with H.E. the Minister of Finance, Italian Government, Salerno.

3. We can confirm there are adequate stocks of tobacco in Italy to meet requirements.

4. The supply of tobacco is a monopoly of the Italian Government and therefore the whole industry is under the immediate control of the Ministry of Finance.

5. With reference to the demand for 21,000 Kgs. per week by the Army Sub-Commission in their letter 40/2 of 5 Mar. 44, the Minister of Finance was unable to confirm this demand, and, at our request, in taking up the matter with the Minister of War, Italian Government. He expressed the opinion that this was probably double the quantity that it was practicable to distribute per week to the Italian Armed Forces. The Minister of Finance has undertaken to provide us forthwith with a detailed schedule of priorities and amounts to be provided to the various interested parties on the following basis:

- a. Italian fighting forces in the combat zone.
- b. Actively engaged troops in the rear area.
- c. Italian troops employed at docks.
- d. Italian air forces.
- e. Royal Italian Navy.
- f. Italian troops in Sardinia.
- g. Italian troops in Sicily.

6. On receipt of this information, every effort will be made to implement his entire program.

7. The main difficulties in the way of completion of this program are:

a. An acute shortage of cigarette paper. The present supply will be exhausted in 4 weeks. Despite cigarette paper having been requisitioned last December and many urgent representations by this sub-commission, so far we have failed to get any definite date for arrival of fresh supplies out of Combined Chiefs of Staff, Washington.

b. The difficulty of transporting existing stocks of tobacco at present in the Salerno and Lecce areas to the Bari factory. Bids have been made for railway trucks in order to get the necessary quantities of tobacco, but so far, unsuccessfully. This sub-commission is making urgent representations to try and ensure that the necessary stocks are moved within the next 10 days.

c. We will keep you fully informed of further developments.

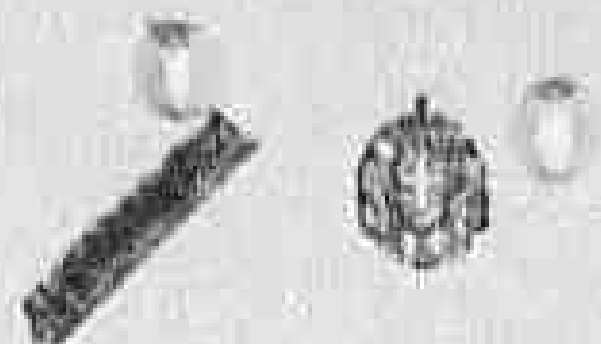

Attached is digest of correspondence which has been forwarded from Naval Sub-Commission to Chief Commissioner. Secretary General has returned it to me presumably for noting before dealing with it.

Correspondence shows conclusively that in spite of the Navy issuing all rations asked for in Naples area, both for shore and sea, Italian Navy have been drawing also from Italian Army.

I note that the Admiral states (a) that Army issues have been far in excess in numbers required (b) that an investigation should be set on foot.

As I have not got sufficient data on amounts issued by Army in the period under reference (only correspondence noted in digest is in possession) perhaps you will forward me a note on the matter, or deal with, when you come up for the Parliament on the 3rd. In the meantime I am going to forward documents again to Secretary General with a note that I have represented the matter to you for amplification from our point of view.

Dear Admiral Casarini

Purview to my letter No. 464 of 6th February, 1944, and with effect from 1st March, 1944, all supplies for the Italian Navy should be drawn from the 14th R.P.O. Your demands, which cover the requirements of all shore-based staff in the area (including Ischia), and which should allow a margin for issues to Italian ships requiring replenishment at Naples, should be lodged at the Royal Naval Victualling Depot five days before supplies are required. The demand should distinguish which rations are required for base personnel and which are for sea-going ships as the latter are entitled to a larger combat ration.

2. Subsequent demands made under this arrangement should be accompanied by a detailed statement set out as follows:-

The position would therefore appear to be that until further steps are taken to increase the BARI factory to its maximum capacity by means of further supplies of power, tobacco and cigarette paper it is NOT possible to make arrangements for maintaining the Armed Forces with the correct cigarette ration.

The H.Q. GARIBOLDI Division informed us that they are meeting some difficulties on the regular supply of food to the troops as the local resources which were the basis of their supplies are nearly exhausted.

Then in agreement with the 2nd Yugoslav Corps, a/m H.Q. requested from Italy our urgent supply of certain items, while the H.Q. 2nd Yugoslav Corps was informing the Allies of the request.

In order to organise despatch by air of supplies we need a provision of foodstuffs for at least 2 months and on the basis of the Division Strength which is nearly 8,000 men.

Could you please ask the Allied Authorities concerned to supply the following items in addition to those already being issued to the Italian Army:-

420,000	lbs.	Flour.
105,000	"	Macaroni or Rice (or a corresponding amount of flour)
15,000	"	Tomatoe Sauce.

The above mentioned foodstuffs will be stored in LEGGI from where we will arrange their further despatch by Air.

Further to letter 1619/11 dated 13th instant.

With reference and further to the talk held yesterday with Brig. Buckeene, I would like to point out the significant and political reason which has urged me to want to give a proof of our feelings for those far from home and country by sending a gift to P.W. in N. Africa.

I believe that the necessity for and urgency of such action is fully appreciated by the Allies so that such propaganda will lead to uniting the thoughts and feelings of our fellow-countrymen towards a decisive and workable co-operation with the Allied Nations.

I feel it is now necessary to give details on the procedure with which my plan can be put into effect.

(i) The despatch, in time for Easter of a small parcel for each P.W. in N. Africa. The details of contents will be found in Appx.1. These have been reduced in view of shortages of goods and transport difficulties. I would like to mention that many civilians as well as officers and men have willingly volunteered to give a liberal part of their daily ration to help in the making of the contents. The request made to the A.S.O. with regard to making sweetmeats etc could be reduced by one half i.e. 500 quintals of flour and 500 quintals of sugar.

(ii) The despatch, to each P/W camp, of a number of books in order to form small libraries (about a total of 10,000 books). The choice of books will be made in a way which I will explain in Appx.2. with the proposed method of despatching. In case of transport difficulties this plan might be put off to a later date.

(iii) The despatch, to each P/W camp, of a fortnightly newspaper in order to keep our fellow-countrymen in the picture of current events together with pamphlets of specially prepared anti-German propaganda. The paper in question will be a special edition of the newspaper "Italia" now being issued to Italian troops.

As far as the controlling of all material to be despatched is concerned it will be necessary for the Allied authorities to lay down a method which should be forwarded to us as quick as possible in order that we may make arrangements for it to be put into effect. The newspapers will also be censored by Allied authorities.

For the transport to Africa, owing to the limited time available, the reduction in weight of the parcels and the distances between ports and destination together with possible risks involved, it would be better to send everything by air instead of by sea. This can be done after arrangements to be reached with the Air Ministry, by Italian S.82 planes.

The number of trips involved are the following :-

I feel it is now necessary to give details on the procedure with which my plan can be put into effect.

(i) The despatch, in time for Easter of a small parcel for each P.W. in N. Africa. The details of contents will be found in Appx. 1. These have been reduced in view of shortages of goods and transport difficulties. I would like to mention that many civilians as well as officers and men have willingly volunteered to give a liberal part of their daily ration to help in the making of the contents. The request made to the A.S.C. with regard to making sweetmeats etc could be reduced by one half i.e. 500 quintals of flour and 500 quintals of sugar.

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The number of trips involved are the following :-

The trips should be started not later than April 1st and the number will depend on number of planes available.

The localities from which planes could leave might be the following :-

Salerno	- For the papers, books, and parcels prepared in Lecce.
Crotone	- For parcels prepared by XII Corps.
Bari	- For the parcels prepared by IX and III Corps.

Allied authorities should inform us on which airfields the planes should land, taking the location of camps into consideration. Allied authorities should also provide necessary transport from the airfields to the camps.

In order to increase the loading capacity of the planes it would be convenient if these could re-fuel in Africa for the return trip, when they could be used for the transportation of any necessary Allied equipment or personnel back to Italy.

The distribution of parcels will be supervised and organized by Italian Officers of the Italian Mission in Algiers and from the camps. If considered necessary Allied Officers and International Red Cross representatives might also be present.

In order that the scope of my intentions might be reached and that agreements may be made with the Air Ministry, I will ask you to try and obtain a quick authorisation for this to be put into effect.

Finally in order to discuss the transport question in Africa, I will ask you to authorize an Officer from this Ministry to proceed to the Italian Mission in Algiers where he will also be able to contact the Allied H.Qs. He will remain there until all parcels are delivered.

OTHER ISSUE OF RATIONS TO THE ITALIAN ARMY

It has been ascertained that bulk issues have been made from the British Army (through 14 RPO) to the Italian Army on a considerable scale for re-issue to the Italian Navy.

2. All co-operating personnel of the Italian Navy in the Naples area have been supplied with rations by the Royal Navy since the first days of occupation and this arrangement has been taken into account when drawing down the provisions from the Army. The total number of rations issued to date is as follows:-

To shore-based and depot personnel	- 76,652
To seagoing ships	- 52,574

A detailed statement is attached.

3. The disposal of the rations drawn by the Italian Army is not known, and neither is it known on what basis the numbers for which issues were made was calculated. The ration strength quoted by the Italian Army is very far in excess of the greatest number of actively serving Italian naval personnel in this area.

4. It is suggested that the matter be investigated, and meanwhile it is intended to supply actively co-operating Italian personnel only in the Naples area.

5. In accordance with Med. 0060/7 of 24th January 1944, forwarding Allied Force Headquarters Administrative Memorandum No. 2 of 19th January, it is proposed that basic and combat rations should in future be drawn direct from Army stores on presentation of a demand countersigned by an officer on behalf of the Royal Navy. My representative will be pleased to call on stores and transport to confirm these arrangements.
