and the date of their own evacuation from ITALY.

It is known that AF Coy RASC in 3 ADNA will desire
to retain the services of thirteen POW/ALI until 'R' plus 30, and
it is thought that other authorities may desire to retain POW/ALI,
particularly officers of 861 MID Pool, for varying periods up to
'R' + 90.

In these circumstances it would be much appreciated
if you could agree to POW/ALI units or individuals remaining at duty
up to 'R' + 90 if so required. It is not anticipated that any
substantial number would be retained.
