SUBJECT:- Volunteer OLIVA Gioacchino, son of Antonino,  
class 1927, from Milazzo.

The a/m youth offered, in April 1944, to voluntarily take part to the liberation war in Italy, in cooperation with the Allied troops.

He was, in fact, enlisted in the 898 Battery 4 A of the 5th American Army, taking part subsequently in actions for the liberation of Rome and Tuscany.

As he felt sick, he was then admitted by the Americans to the hospital of "S. Lorenzo" at Colle Val D'Elsa (Siena), where he died on the 27th September 1944. His body was buried in the cemetery of Colle Alta (Castellini), wearing the Allied uniform.

As the family of a/m youth has approached this Ministry in order to obtain recognition of the qualification of fighting volunteer for their son, and as the class of OLIVA (1927) had not yet called up at the time of his death, we beg you to kindly confirm the circumstances of his death and to issue a statement on his active collaboration, for the economical benefits which his family could derive from it.

1. Italian civilian inhabitant Galleni, Luigi, in Aug 46 intimated a claim to this office based on the following described situation.
2. Galleni, asserted that on 4 Oct 44 he joined in the capacity of interpreter, guide and organizer and chief of civilians who transported supplies and ammunition to advanced posts in the mountains, the 2nd Bn, 370th Inf Regt, 1st Bn, 370th Inf. Regt, 1st Bn, 371st Inf Regt, 3rd Bn, 71st Inf Regt, and finally a battalion of the 32nd Inf Regt. He claimed he remained with said organizations from that date to 7 April 45 on which date he was wounded at a mule post, Cavala, Monte S. Giorgio, north of Vallecchia, Italy.
3. He has presented several documents indicating that on 7 Apr 45 he was wounded in the stomach while in the company of a Major of the 371st Inf. Bn and that he was evacuated and treated in United States Army Field Hospital.
4. It is apparent that this man was not a member of the US Forces but probably a partisan volunteer fighting alongside US Forces.
5. Inquiry was made in the past by this office of the then Patriots Sub-Commission, Allied Commission, in the similar case of BUTARELLI, Vincenzo (DOCCO Case #478). The undersigned was then advised that said man's services as a Partisan would be recognized and accorded credit by the Italian Government (with consequent disability pension and the like) if a statement were forthcoming from this office certifying he had served with the US Forces and had been wounded in the course of such service.
6. Evidence in the file in this case discloses as follows:
  - a. That Galleri, Luigi, served as organizer and leader of civilians, interpreter and guide with the 2nd Bn, 270th Inf Regt 1st Bn, 370th Inf Regt, 1st Bn, 371st Inf Regt, and finally with a

battalion, of the 442nd Inf Regt, 92nd Div.

b. That he was wounded by enemy fire in the course of such service on 7 April 45 at a mule post at Cavala, Monte San Giorgio, north of Vallecchia, and treated in US Army Field Hospital.

c. That he was not a US soldier and was at no time enlisted in the US Army. He was not an American citizen. He was an Italian partisan volunteer.

7. It is therefore requested that you take such action as may be necessary on his behalf with the appropriate Italian authorities to the end that this man may receive such recognition and compensation from the Italian Government as he may be entitled to.

8. This Office has found that he has no valid claim against US Forces but has a valid claim for recognition by and such compensation from the Italian Government for his services as a partisan and for the consequent injuries or disability suffered, as Italian law may provide.

9. It is requested that this office be advised of action taken.







1. An extensive search of British Army records has failed to reveal any trace whatsoever of a British Hospital or Medical Unit having been located at ROCCASECCA or ALATRI.
