a) Rank of Commander - Order of Crown of Italy.

I have personally examined the files at the Royal House - Decorations Office - and, as stated also by the Director, we could not trace any document proving the a/m award.

The same I did at the Order of the Crown of Italy (Via Vicenza 7) with the same result. I contacted also Col Gallo (M.of D.) who told me that if he can have details about the authority who requested to MTOUSA the clearance (ref. and date) the investigation will be facilitated.

b) Cross of War for military valor X

No trace in the files of the Royal House.

On the contrary, at the M.of D. I found that the cross of war for military valor was awarded to him with Decree n. 102 dated 15 Sept. 1945.

Col Pedretti is at present finding out if the certificate and the decoration have been sent out to 5 Army.

The file, in possession of M. of D. (Lt Col Podretti) testifies that the a/m certificate was forwarded to the office of the Aide - de - Camp to the King (Gen, Infante) on 18 Oct. 45 ref 16785.

The Office of the Aide - de - Camp to the King was disbanded later and the archive still existing at the Liquidation Office (Ufficio Liquidazione Casa Reale) contain the files of awards of many American officers but Lt Col Saurel's file is completely missing.
